RESOLUTION NO. 11-1351**

**A RESOLUTION DECLARING CERTAIN PROPERTY OF THE
CITY OF PROSSER TO BE SURPLUSED**

WHEREAS, the City of Prosser owns certain property which has been used by the Mid Columbia Library District pursuant to an Interlocal Agreement between Mid Columbia Library and the City of Prosser; and

WHEREAS, the Mid Columbia Library District has determined that the property declared surplus below is no longer needed for use by the library; and

WHEREAS, the City of Prosser has no immediate need or use for the books and personal property declared surplus on the attached exhibit and does not envision that it will have a need for this property in the future; and

WHEREAS, if the value of the property is less than the cost of sale of such property, then it is in the best interest of the City of Prosser, if the Friends of the Library or the Benton County Jail is willing to take the property for use, sale or disposal, since it will save the City the cost of disposal of such property;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Prosser that the attached described property in EXHIBIT "A" is hereby declared surplus property; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor or his designee shall dispose of this property in a commercially reasonable manner and in the event that any such property is determined to have less value than the cost of sale of such property, then such property may be disposed of as junk which disposal shall include giving such property to the "Friends of the Library" or to the "Benton County Jail" for sale or use by inmates, or disposal.
