

**CITY OF PROSSER, WASHINGTON**

**SPECIAL JOINT WORK SESSION  
WITH THE CITY COUNCILS OF  
GRANDVIEW, PROSSER, AND SUNNYSIDE  
MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 29, 2008**

A Special Joint Work Session was held at The Vineyard in Grandview, WA at 5:30 p.m. to discuss possible regional partnerships with various city functions and services.

**WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS**

The Mayors, Council Members, City Administrators, and City Clerks from all three cities were present. Prosser City Council Members in attendance were Becken, Chambers, Everett, Rainer, Taylor and Troemel.

**SUGGESTED TOPICS FOR REGIONAL PARTNERSHIPS**

The following topics were openly discussed among the three cities: Animal Control; Building Department Services; Civil Service Testing; Economic Development; Master Agreement for Shared Equipment and Personnel; Information Services; Legislative Advocacy; Online Services; Purchasing; and Recreation Services.

A consensus was reached to take the various topics back to the city department heads and staff to determine what items could be implemented on a reasonable time/cost schedule. Proposed implementation would be brought back to the City Councils for approval.

**CLOSING COMMENTS**

Representatives from the cities of Grandview, Prosser, and Sunnyside all stated the idea of regional partnerships was long overdue and were eager to continue dialogue on other topics in the future.
