

**PROSSER TRANSPORTATION BENEFIT DISTRICT  
RESOLUTION NO 09-TBD-01**

A RESOLUTION OF THE PROSSER TRANSPORTATION BENEFIT DISTRICT, SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING TO TAKE PUBLIC TESTIMONY ON PROPOSED ORGANIZATIONAL RULES AND BYLAWS OF THE PROSSER TRANSPORTATION BENEFIT DISTRICT. THE RESOLUTION ALSO ENACTS A RULE FOR THE HEARING LIMITING PUBLIC TESTIMONY TO 3 MINUTES PER PERSON. THE RESOLUTION ALSO PROVIDES THAT NOTICE OF THE HEARING SHALL BE PUBLISHED IN THE PROSSER RECORD BULLETIN AND THE TRI-CITY HERALD AT LEAST ONCE, MORE THAN 10 DAYS BEFORE THE HEARING BY THE CITY CLERK.

**Whereas**, the Prosser Transportation Benefit District desires to hold a public hearing to consider the adoption of organizational rules and bylaws for the Prosser Transportation Benefit District;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of the Prosser Transportation Benefit District, as follows:

A public hearing is hereby set on Tuesday, March 3, 2009 at 6:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as may be heard, at the Prosser City Council Chambers located at 601 7<sup>th</sup> Street, Prosser, Washington. The purpose of the hearing is to take public testimony on the adoption of proposed organizational rules and bylaws for the Prosser Transportation Benefit District.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Board of the Prosser Transportation Benefit District, as follows:

Due to the number of public comments anticipated at such public hearing, the Board hereby passes a temporary rule limiting public testimony to three (3) minutes per person testifying at the above referenced public hearing.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Board of the Prosser Transportation Benefit District, as follows:

The City Clerk shall publish notice of this hearing in the Prosser Record Bulletin and the Tri-City Herald at least once, more than 10 days before the hearing.
