

**CITY OF PROSSER, WASHINGTON  
RESOLUTION NO. 12-1390**

**A RESOLUTION RATIFYING AND CONFIRMING THE ORDERS ISSUED IN  
CONNECTION WITH A STATE OF CIVIL EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Prosser declared and proclaimed a state of civil emergency in response to a 10" water main line that ruptured near the City's water treatment facility designated as a "critical area" on March 29, 2012, resulting in, or threatening to result in, an imminent threat to the health and safety of the citizens of the City of Prosser and the traveling public; and,

**WHEREAS**, certain Orders have been issued in respect thereto;


**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Prosser that it is the desire of the City Council that:

1. The City Council hereby ratifies and confirms the Order of the Mayor dated March 29, 2012, regarding:
  - a. An order waiving the public works competitive bidding requirements as necessary to address the emergency situation, and awarding contracts necessary to address the emergency situation, all in accordance with the Prosser Municipal Code and Chapters 38.52 and 39.04 RCW.
  - b. An order waiving the requirements of Prosser Municipal Code Titles 15 and 16, as necessary to respond to the emergency situation, provided however, the emergency provisions of those Chapters for remedial actions shall be followed.
  - c. An order allowing City Staff to close such public ways as may be necessary to address the emergency situation.
