



Public Safety Sales Tax Summary 2015

In 2015, the City of Prosser began collecting Public Safety Sales Tax Receipts. To ensure the controlled use and reporting of these funds, the Public Safety Sales Tax Fund (149) was established. The City of Prosser committed these to the appointment of a School Resource Officer and to hire a part-time police secretary.

In 2015, the City of Prosser received a total of \$141,767 in public safety sales tax revenue and expended \$104,336.98. Please find below a chart to illustrate these expenses.
