

AMENDMENT
To the City of Prosser

This amendment, to that certain agreement entitled EMERGENCY DISPATCH AGREEMENT FOR LAW SERVICE dated November 27, 2012, is hereby entered into under the terms of said agreement by and between the Benton County Emergency Services and the City of Prosser.

1. AUTHORITY

The parties are hereby authorized to enter into an amendment of the original agreement based upon Section 6.4 of that agreement.

2. PURPOSE

The parties agree that it is necessary to enter into an amendment of the original agreement because of a request for additional service from the Prosser Police Department.

3. AMENDMENTS


The following specific amendment shall be in addition to the original payment sections of that agreement dated November 27, 2012:

- A. In accordance with Paragraph 6.4 the AGENCY agrees to pay SECOMM \$100.00 per month for SECOMM to monitor ACCESS on a 24 hour basis.
- B. The \$100.00 per month is a cost to establish this new service. In successive years this cost will be reviewed and adjusted based on usage for the applicable budget year.
- C. City of Prosser will pay this fee prior to January 31, 2013. In future years this will be an annual fee paid effective January 1st of each year.

4. REMAINING TERMS

All terms and conditions of the original agreement, except as amended or modified in Section 3 above, shall remain in full force and effect during the duration of the original agreement.






