Prosser Announces Newly Appointed City Administrator

At the January 26, 2016, City Council meeting, Mayor Randy Taylor announced his appointment of David Stockdale from Eugene, Oregon, as the successful candidate to fill the vacant City Administrator position. The City Council voted to confirm Mayor's appointment of Mr. Stockdale and directed staff to bring back an Employment Agreement at the February 2nd, City Council meeting for consideration and action.

City staff and Council Members participated in a two day interview process along with a public meet and greet with the three finalists Tony Graff, Joe Hannan and Dave Stockdale, earlier this month.

When asked about the opportunity as the next top leader for Prosser, Stockdale stated, "I was so moved and impressed as I briefly experienced the love and passion the Mayor, Council Members, staff, and citizens have for Prosser. I am very excited for the opportunity to work with such great people and for a citizenry that cares so deeply for their community. I look forward to working together to carry out the goals and programs that will continue to make Prosser a great place to live, work, volunteer, play, and visit."

Mr. Stockdale is leaving his job at Lane County, Oregon, where he has been employed since 2007, to join the City of Prosser beginning February 22, 2016. He has a Bachelor of Science in Political Science from Brigham Young University, Hawaii, a Graduate Certificate in Not-For-Profit Management and a Master of Public Administration from the University of Oregon.

Mayor Taylor said, "the process was very thorough and I know that Dave is the best choice for our City. We are all excited for him to get started and become a part of our community."
