Flash Alert for City Updates Now Available

Residents, neighbors, business owners, and other interested parties can now register to receive emails and text alerts from the City of Prosser during major emergencies, outages, and other service impacts/interruptions.

The City has contracted with Flash Alert to help communicate important information during urgent situations. Many residents already may be familiar with the application and program, as the Prosser School District also uses the program to alert families about delays, closures, and emergency information.

As of June, people can register with Flash Alert at www.flashalert.net for email notifications. Download the app in either the Android or Apple stores on your smart devices for real time notifications. Existing users need only log into their account and add the City of Prosser to their list of

requested notifications.

“We take our efforts to notify the public of emergency situations very seriously,” said City Administrator Dave Stockdale. “This notification system will be another valuable tool in helping our community during crisis.” We are excited about this new service and are positive it will be a great benefit to all in the community.

From the Desk of the Public Works Director -

Irrigation Season

The Prosser Irrigation distribution system serves the majority of the residences in our community that receive irrigation water. The system is gravity fed, which means that it is not pressurized and relies upon the amount of water available to support the system. During the irrigation season, we receive a significant amount of calls regarding low/no pressure. If you are experiencing low/no pressure it is most likely due to everyone watering at once, while on occasion it may be due to repairs or maintenance.

Sometimes we get phone calls asking for Sunnyside Valley Irrigation District's (SVID) phone number. While SVID supplies us with our irrigation water, they do not maintain the City of Prosser's irrigation infrastructure. If you have a private irrigation box the City does not maintain those lines, however, should you need to make repairs to those lines you would still call the City to have your box turned off or on. The City then follows a procedure set in place by SVID to request those changes to private boxes.

Prosser Municipal Code states in Chapter 9.92.030 that "The owner or occupant of a residence which has a street address number ending in an even

number may use irrigation water only on even-numbered days. The owner or occupant of a residence which has a street address number ending in an odd number may use irrigation water only on odd-numbered days." Here are some additional ideas which can help everyone support the irrigation system and your neighbors:

- Water in the early morning or late evening.
- Water for 20-30 minutes at a time.
- Water with only one or two sprinklers at a time.

Also, each year citizens and City staff notice many residences that are allowing their irrigation water to run continuously causing it to flood surrounding properties and/or run down roadways to storm drains that are lengthy distances from the property. This practice can affect irrigation pressure and accessibility, as well as damage our roadways. 
