## PRESS RELEASE

On March 27, 2015 at approximately 9:00 p.m. the Prosser Police Department was dispatched to a call of shots being fired in the 100 block of OIE. Upon arrival, an adult Hispanic male was located and found to have suffered from what appeared to be a gunshot wound. Further investigation indicated that the perpetrator had left the scene prior to officers' arrival.

The initial investigation indicates that there were approximately eight shots fired at the scene by the perpetrator, with at least one shot appearing to have struck the victim. The victim was initially treated on scene by Prosser EMS, and subsequently transported to Kadlec Medical facility in Richland with what appeared to be non life threatening injuries.

The alleged perpetrator was subsequently located hiding at a residence in the 400 block of 5<sup>th</sup> street in Grandview, and was taken into custody with the assistance of the Tri-Cities Metro Swat team and the Grandview Police.

The individual taken into custody and initially charged with First Degree Assault is identified as Consaucion Rabadan-Medina, 35 yoa, who is a resident of Grandview.

The investigation indicates that the shooting was not gang related.

The Prosser Police Department was assisted in the investigation by the Benton County Sheriff's Office, Sunnyside Police Department, Grandview Police Department and the Tri-Cities Metro Swat Team.
