ACTIVITY LOG

WEEK OF January 06, 2022 to January 12, 2023

January 06 (21 Calls for Service)

- Non-injury accident in the area of 6th Street and Wine Country Road, a vehicle rear-ended the vehicle in front of them because the driver advised he tried to stop but due slippery roads he was unable to. Both parties received infractions for following too closely and for driving without insurance. Officers also assisted with the collision report.
- Order violation reported on the 1000 block of Alexander Court, the RP advised she has a no-contact order in place against a male, who was banging at her door intoxicated. Officers made contact with the male, who was arrested after it was confirmed there was a current no contact order in place. The male was transported to Benton County Jail.

January 07 (18 Calls for Service)

- Suspicious activity at the train depot, the RP advised he had seen two vehicles in the parking lot, and noticed a third vehicle in the parking lot that had its gas cap on the ground and was unsure if a theft of gas had occurred. Officers are investigating this incident.
- Traffic stop conducted in the area of Grant Ave and 10th Street, the vehicle was seen driving without any license plates. The driver advised he had just purchased the vehicle from an individual in Oregon, who had taken the license plates off the vehicle. The driver was given a verbal warning for driving with no license plates.

January 08 (16 Calls for Service)

- Information reported at the Police Department, the RP advised he and his daughter heard from a third party that a few boys were threatening to assault the RP's daughter. Officers advised the RP to contact the school so they could also be aware of this information and to contact dispatch if the female feels unsafe or endangered.
- Disturbance on the 700 block of Main Street, a male and female were arguing with each other in the front yard over another female being at the residence. The female advised she wanted the second female trespassing from the property. Officers assisted with trespassing the female.
- Suspicious activity on the 1100 block of Sherman Ave, the RP advised a juvenile male had been seen knocking on his door and running away. The RP advised he wanted officers to be aware of this incident because it had happened in the past.
- Traffic stop in the area of Chardonnay Ave and Wine Country Road, officers initiated a traffic stop due to the registered owner of vehicle having a suspended or revoked license. Officers made contact with the driver who was registered owner. The driver received a criminal citation for driving with a suspended or revoked license and an infraction for not having insurance for the vehicle.
- Disturbance reported on the 500 block of 6th Street, RP reported seeing a couple in the area arguing and advised the female had asked for a ride. Officers made contact with the male and female involved who only had a verbal argument. Officers provided a courtesy transport for the female. No further issues arose.

January 09 (12 Calls for Service)

- Civil assist on the 100 block of Old Inland Empire, the RP advised he was renting a room but stopped paying rent and moved out of state a few months ago. The RP advised the homeowner allegedly had turned in his firearm to a police department in the area, and requested officers to standby so he could retrieve belongings from the residence. The RP was advised officers are unable to assist with civil standby, the male was referred to the Benton County Sheriff's Office civil division. Officers also advised the RP, the Prosser PD did not have his firearm.
- Assistance requested in the area of 7th Street and Stacy Ave, the RP advised he is a transient male, and was looking for services that assisted the homeless. Officers advised the RP of assistance available in the area. The male was also given information regarding CRISIS.
- Arson reported on the 400 block of North River Road, the RP advised someone had set the interior of his vehicle on fire. Officers are investigating this incident.
- Noise complaint reported on the 900 block of Alexander Court, the RP advised her neighbor has been creating loud noises and could hear a loud television, thumping and was possibly having a party. Officers made contact with the alleged noisy apartment. Officers were unable to hear any of the noises the RP reported hearing.

January 10 (21 Calls for Service)

- Suspicious activity reported at Red Pawn, the RP advised he saw two females at the location going through the trash and the items loaded on trailers. Officers checked the area and were unable to locate the females.
- Information received from the Housel Middle School, the RP advised there had been a fight between two students, where one student struck the other student with their hydro flask water bottle and was taken to Prosser Memorial Hospital. The school advised they would notify the parents of this incident and let them decide if they wanted to press charges. Staff advised they wanted officers to be aware of this incident.
- Traffic complaint reported in the area of Concord Street and Market Street, the RP advised she wanted officers to be aware of vehicles running the stop sign in the area when children are awaiting in the area for the bus. The RP advised she had seen a vehicle accelerate when children were crossing the street, nearly striking them.

January 11 (20 Calls for Service)

- Suspicious vehicle on the 900 block of Court Street, the RP advised a vehicle was parked in front of her back gate of her residence, and it bothered her. Officers located the vehicle which was unoccupied, and legally parked on the side of the road. Officers advised the RP of this information.
- Welfare check requested at the Prosser Rest Area, the RP advised a driver in the area appeared to be under the influence of narcotics, the female driver was seen dancing outside of her vehicle, and later was seen passed out in her vehicle. Officers made contact with the female who was found asleep with her vehicle running. The female advised she did not need medical assistance. The female was found to not have a license and advised she could not drive the vehicle.
- Suspicious activity reported on the 900 block of Lilian Street, the RP stated she heard someone open and close the screen door several times but was unable to see who it was. Officers checked the area and did not locate any suspicious persons.

January 12 (22 Calls for Service)

- Information reported from Housel Middle School, the RP advised a student answered a phone call during class and advised it was his brother, who is also a student was on the line and had made

threats. The student was spoken to by school officials and interviewed and had not made any statements of that nature and the student's brother had made false claims. Staff advised officers they didn't not believe there was any imminent threat and believed it was just a student messing around. Staff wanted officers to be aware of this information.

- Welfare check requested at the Prosser Post Office, the RP advised someone was inside the post office laying in the middle of the floor and believed the male was asleep. Officers contacted the male, who was moved along.
