ACTIVITY LOG WEEK OF JANUARY 10, 2020 TO JANUARY 16, 2020

JANUARY 10 (30 calls for service)

- Report of a vehicle prowl received in the 1900 block of Benson Ave. Reporting Party (RP) advised that it appeared their vehicle had been gone through as they found papers strewn throughout, but it did not appear that anything was missing.
- Vehicle prowl report in the 1900 block of Benson Ave. RP stated that two vehicles had been broken into and a car stereo along with various tools had been stolen.
- Report of a loose dog in the 800 block of Park Ave. RP was concerned for children in the area. Community Service Officer located a brown Pitt Bull/Shepard mix and impounded it.
- Community Service Officer was contacted regarding a found dog in the 700 block of Main Street. A white Husky was impounded.
- Found property report in the 1000 block of Alice Street. RP located a red bike in their bushes.
- Traffic complaints received at Prosser High School. Vehicles found improperly parked, using handicap spots without placards. Announcements were made and owners moved their vehicles.
- Traffic stop in the area of Gap Road and Merlot Drive. Driver was found to have a suspended license and was cited and released for DWLS 3rd Degree, Operating a Motor Vehicle w/o Insurance, and Failing to Renew Expired Registration.
- Report of a non-injury accident in the 100 block of Merlot Drive. Accident occurred on private property, information was exchanged.

JANUARY 11 (25 calls for service)

- Civil complaint regarding the construction site near Alice Street. RP was complaining that the wind was blowing plastic onto their property from the site. Officer attempted to locate contact information for the builder.
- Lost property report received. RP called to see if someone had turned in a briefcase that he believed he had lost somewhere in Prosser.
- Medic assist in the area of 6th Street and Meade Ave. for a report of an unresponsive male. Male was transported to Kadlec by ambulance.
- Traffic stop in the area of Benson Ave. and Meade Ave. Driver was cited and released for DWLS 3rd Degree.
- Harassment report, RP called to report that someone was harassing him by phone. RP did not know who it was nor did he have a number because it was blocked. RP was told to set his phone so that he cannot get calls from blocked numbers and advised to call BCSO if he finds out more information regarding the suspect since he lives out in the County.
- Request for a welfare check at the Ameristar. Employee was found passed out in the bathroom by a customer. Employee was conscious and alert when Officers arrived and no medics were needed.

JANUARY 12 (20 calls for service)

- Assault report received at Bern's. RP stated a male had grabbed her hair. Officer contacted the parties involved. The male stated he had just grabbed his hoodie that was behind the female and not her hair. No crime was found to have occurred and all parties separated for the night.
- Traffic stop in the 100 block of Merlot Drive. Officer stopped a vehicle for multiple traffic violations. Upon contact, Officer detected the odor of intoxicants coming from the vehicle. After conducting field sobriety tests the female driver was taken into custody and booked into the Benton County Jail for DUI.
- Report of a suspicious vehicle in the 700 block of Court Street. RP advised a grey Volkswagen pulled up near their residence where their children were playing in the yard and when they went out to check on it the vehicle took off. Officers searched the area, but were not able to locate the vehicle.
- Civil issue reported in the 100 block of Merlot Drive. RP was claiming that he did not receive the correct change after purchasing food at McDonald's. Male ended up returning the food and was given his money back.

Traffic hazard reported in the area of Market Street and Park Ave. RP advised that someone had removed the stop sign at the intersection. City crews were notified of the stolen sign.

- Traffic stop in the 700 block of Wine Country Road. Driver was cited and released for DWLS 3rd Degree and Operating a Vehicle w/o Insurance.
- Traffic stop in the area of N River Road and Wine Country Road. Driver was cited and released for DWLS 3rd Degree.
- Officers responded to a report of a disturbance in the 600 block of New Gate Drive. Son was upset that his parents would not let him use their vehicle. No crime was found to have occurred.
- Report of a vehicle driving recklessly received in the area of Bennett Ave and Gum Street. Officers located the vehicle and upon contact detected the obvious odor of intoxicants coming from the vehicle. After conducting field sobriety tests the male driver was taken into custody and booked for DUI and Operating a Vehicle w/o Ignition Interlock Device.

JANUARY 13 (23 calls for service)

- Noise complaint received in the 900 block of Alexander Court. Report of loud music. Officer contacted the residents and they agreed to turn the music down.
- Weapons complaint received in the area of the cemetery. RP advised they heard approximately 30 shots fired. Officer was in the area at the time and had not heard anything and nothing was located during an area check.
- Information report in the 2000 block of Highland Drive. The fence at the high school construction site appeared to have been knocked down. Nothing appeared out of place, but fence did not look like it fell naturally.
- Noise complaint received again in the 900 block of Alexander Court. Officer contacted the residents and advised if they received another complaint, it would result in a ticket.
- Report of malicious mischief received at the high school construction site. RP reported that overnight someone had gotten into the site and had spray-painted graffiti on the walls from the first to the third floor. RP was advised that it would be a good idea to put up lights or security cameras.
- Theft report received at Prosser Family Fitness. RP reported that a handicap parking sign had been stolen and that they had video and names of the two juvenile suspects. The juveniles were contacted and confessed to taking the sign at the fitness center and one from the high school. RP did not want to press charges, but just wanted the sign returned. The juveniles agreed to return the signs and the high school is handling their discipline.
- Citizen assist, RP called and said that he had traded a gun for a vehicle in the Loves Parking lot in June of last year and that the person had not put the gun in their name yet.
- Missing person report received in the 1900 block of Mountain View Drive. RP called and said that her mother and father had gotten into a verbal argument and that her father left and had not returned. RP was concerned because her father has dementia and does not know the area. Officers located the male in the Food Depot parking lot and transported him back to his residence.
- Request for a welfare check in the 900 block of Court Street. RP called and said her neighbor's door was wide open and snow was getting into the residence. Officers went to the location and found the door was open. Officers searched the premise, but no one was found inside. Upon leaving Officers tried to secure door but it would not latch and the wind kept blowing it open.

JANUARY 14 (14 calls for service)

- Officers received a report of a suicidal person in the Prosser area. A Counselor from Michigan called and reported that a student of hers had an online friend that said they were going to kill themselves. RP only had a first name and phone number. Officers were not able to determine who the person may be or where they may be located. The school was notified of the situation.
- Theft of stop signs reported in the area of Prosser Ave. and Main Street. City crews were notified of the missing signs.
- Information report at Housel Middle School. Student reported to have brought a knife to school. Student did not brandish the knife, but just had it in a folder. Student was emergency expelled.

JANUARY 15 (19 calls for service)

- Report of a suspicious vehicle in the 1300 block of Grant Ave. Vehicle was in the alleyway with the lights on. Officers checked the area, but the vehicle was not located.
- Officers assisted WSP with stopping a vehicle suspected to have been involved in a hit and run. Vehicle was stopped in the area of milepost 82 on I82 and held until WSP arrived to take over.

Community Service Officer contacted the RP and evaluated the dog who did appear to be under weight. It was determined that the owner did not live in Prosser, but Sunnyside. RP was advised to report the information to the Sunnyside Animal Control Officer for further investigation.

- Theft from vehicle reported in the 700 block of Wine Country Road. RP advised his laptop had been stolen from his truck while he was using the shower at Love's.
- Report of a vehicle Prowl in the 1000 block of Alexander Court. RP advised that no items appeared to have been taken from the vehicle, but that their door was left open and they observed footprints in the snow coming from their neighbor's door to their vehicle.
- Officers received a report of a DV assault in progress in the Prosser area. A juvenile had called dispatch because their parents were fighting. The line disconnected and Dispatch was unable to determine an exact location of the assault. Officers checked the 1800 block of Benson Ave and surround areas, but were not able to locate anything.
- Request for a welfare check received at the Chevron. RP advised they went to get gas and the building was open, but no one appeared to be inside. Officers determined the clerk was on site and there were no problems.
