## ACTIVITY LOG

**WEEK OF January 13, 2022 to January 19, 2023**

### **January 13 (20 Calls for Service)**

- Assistance requested on the 1400 block of Meade Ave, the RP advised the elevator was broken and requested officers call management or the elevator company to fix it. Officers advised it was not a criminal matter and the RP could contact the city's building department since it is a building code violation.
- Suspicious activity reported Farm Supply, the RP advised a male and female were at the closed business and were looking through the windows of the store. Officers checked the area and were unable to locate the suspects.
- Civil on the 800 block of 7<sup>th</sup> Street, the RP advised she was moving out of her boyfriend's parents' house, and was worried her boyfriend's sister would cause issues while she moved out of the residence. Officers advised they are unable to assist with the civil standby that had been requested. Officers spoke with the RP's boyfriend who advised he did not believe his sister would cause a disturbance. Officers gave the RP and her boyfriend suggestions on how to avoid escalating the situation.

### **January 14 (22 Calls for Service)**

- Suspicious circumstance reported in the area of 7<sup>th</sup> Street and Stacy Ave, the RP stated he believed he was being followed by two vehicles and was concerned he was the target of a drive-by. Officers checked the area and did not see any suspicious vehicle as had been described by the RP.
- Disturbance reported on the 800 block of Market Street, the RP advised there was a couple in the area that were arguing. Officers contacted the couple who advised they were not arguing but the female had been crying loudly because she had injured her knee. The female declined EMS and continued on their travels.
- Suspicious persons reported in the area of 5<sup>th</sup> Street and Sherman Ave, the RP advised he saw two teenagers and thought they were casing the area because they had been seen in the area previously and advised they were looking for the owner of the dog that was with them but it was late to be looking for the dog's owner. Officers checked the area and were unable to locate the teens.
- Traffic stop in the area of Wine Country Road and Old Inland Empire, a vehicle was seen speeding and had failed to stop at a stop sign and was unable to maintain their lane. Officers attempted to stop the vehicle but the vehicle eluded and later stopped. Officers made contact with the male who appeared to be under the influence and failed to have a required ignition interlock. The male was arrested for DUI, and received a citation for failure to have an ignition interlock. The male was transported to Benton County Jail.

### **January 15 (16 Calls for Service)**

- Disturbance in the area of Market Street and Yakima Ave, the RP advised a male and female were in the area and were arguing and yelling. Officers checked the area and did not locate the couple that had been seen arguing.

- Traffic stop in the area of SR221, a traffic stop was conducted due to a vehicle seen speeding at a high speed. The driver became and aggressive and agitated upon contact. The driver received a citation for speeding and no insurance.

## January 16 (16 Calls for Service)

- Suspicious activity reported at the Boys and Girls club, the RP advised a male had knocked on the back door on the Boys and Girls Club and believed he had seen the male urinate outside of the building. Officers contacted the male who advised he had knocked on the door of the building to see if he could use the bathroom, but stated he did not urinate on the side of the building. The RP advised he did not actually see the male urinate but thought he did urinate. No further contact was made.
- Disturbance reported on the 300 block of Nunn Road, the RP advised he wanted his brother removed from his residence because he was verbal and was refusing to leave. The RP while calling advised that his brother's girlfriend had fainted. Officers contacted the RP and his brother and medics checked on the female. The RP's brother and the female decided to leave the residence, no further issues arose.

## January 17 (14 Calls for Service)

- Lewd conduct reported in the area of Stacy Ave and 7<sup>th</sup> Street, the RP advised she and another person had seen a male expose himself and urinated in public. Officers contacted the witnesses and the transient male who was waiting for the bus. The witnesses decided to not press charges against the male. The male got on the bus and left the area.
- Welfare check on the 1000 block of Alexander Court, the RP advised a male appeared to be slumped over the steering wheel of his vehicle. Officers made contact with the female who advised he was fine and was having dinner in her vehicle.

## January 18 (16 Calls for Service)

- Burglary reported on the 1600 block of Wine Country Road, the RP advised there were holes cut into the fence and items had been taken. Officer are investigating this incident.
- Disturbance at Cottage Court Market, officers were traveling westbound on the 1800 block of Wine Country Road, when they observed two males fighting in the parking lot of the business. Officers separated the males and spoke with them. Neither party wanted to be a victim nor press charges, and left the area.
- Assault reported on the 100 block of Max Benitz Road, the RP advised dispatch his co-worker had been shot and he was transporting the victim to the hospital, he also advised the suspect fled from the scene. Officers made contact with witnesses and the victim regarding the incident. Officers are currently investigating this incident.

## January 19 (24 Calls for Service)

- Disturbance reported on the 900 block of Florence Street, the RP advised she was having an issue with someone at the location. Officers made contact with the female at the location who was having a mental health episode and advised she did not want any assistance and left the residence to avoid further issues.
- Suspicious circumstances reported on the 900 block of Campbell, the RP advised she believed someone was outside of her residence because she believed she heard people talking. Officers checked the area and did not locate anyone.
