ACTIVITY LOG

WEEK OF January 27, 2022 to February 02, 2023

January 27 (13 Calls for Service)

- Suspicious circumstance reported on the 400 block of North River Road, the RP advised a male was running around behind the building and knocking on windows and was seen running off laughing. Officers checked the area and did not locate the male.
- Accident reported on the 1200 block of Dudley Ave, officers made contact with both parties who advised they were un-injured and did not need medics. One party advised she was traveling west bound when the other vehicle backed into her. The other driver also advised he was reversing and did not see the vehicle when the accident occurred. Officers assisted with the collision report and one of the drivers was cited for failure to yield.

January 28 (20 Calls for Service)

- Suspicious person reported on the 300 block of Wine Country Road, the RP advised he had seen a few transients riding their bicycles in the area looking in the parked vehicles. Officers made contact with the transient people regarding the issue.
- Fireworks complaint received, various phone called received regarding fireworks, one RP advised he believed he had heard gunshots going off. Officers checked the area and made contact with residents in the area and who also advised that it was fireworks that had gone off, no evidence of gunshots was found.
- Suspicious circumstance reported on the 100 block of Kinney Way, the RP advised he went into the business and noticed there was no employee in the store and thought it was odd since the business was open. Officers checked the store and knocked on the door to the attached residence and an employee excited and advised there were no problems.
- Suspicious activity reported at City Park, the RP advised she saw caution tape wrapped around a pole and there were teens messing with it. Officers made contact with juveniles who advised they had not placed the caution tape of the overhead wire.

January 29 (11 Calls for Service)

- Suicide threats reported at Bern's Tavern, the RP advised her daughter had been drinking and was making suicidal statements and also advised her husband was having a medical issue. EMS assisted the RP's husband and transported him to the Prosser Memorial Hospital. Officers made contact with the RP's daughter who advised she did not wish to harm herself and refused help from CRISIS.
- Welfare check requested at Loves, a trucking company requested an officer check on a driver who hadn't moved locations or contacted them in 64 hours. Officers made contact with the driver who advised she was fine, she was just waiting out the snow storm along her planned route. Officers advised her to contact the company to let them know.
- Malicious mischief reported at Crawford, the RP stated he parked his vehicle at Crawford Park and noticed a vehicle park behind him and later found his back window to be broken. The RP advised he believed someone from the vehicle threw something at his window. Officers provided the RP with a case number for the incident.

January 30 (18 Calls for Service)

- Scam call received at Best Western, an employee advised she had received a call from someone claiming to be a deputy advising her of a warrant she has. Officers spoke with the RP regarding this scam call.
- Assistance requested at Prosser PD, a female requested information on when she should or should not call 911. Officers assisted with answering her questions

January 31 (17 Calls for Service)

- Loitering reported at Horse Heaven Hills Brewery, the owners advised a male who appeared intoxicated was laying behind the business yelling and talking nonsense. Officers contacted the intoxicated male who was incoherent and rambling. The male was trespassed per request from the owners, and left the area.
- Field contact on the 1200 block of Bennett Ave, officers made contact with the same male from the previous call, the male was observed throwing trash in the parking lot. The male was told to pick up the trash and throw it in the trash can. Officers offered the male a courtesy transport, he advised he wanted to go to Hawaii, his request was denied and he was sent on his way.

February 01 (22 Calls for Service)

- Disturbance reported on the 800 block of Market St, the RP advised his ex-wife went to pick up their daughter but she didn't want to go with her and the RP's ex wouldn't leave the residence. Officers made contact with the RP's ex-wife and their daughter separately. The female was asked by officers to leave the residence, the female complied and left the area. No further issues arose.
- Welfare check on the 1100 block of Meade Ave, various reports were received regarding an intoxicated male roaming around the downtown area. Officers contacted the male who was found lying in an alleyway, incoherent and intoxicated. Officers contacted medics to assist the male, the male was transported to Prosser Memorial Hospital.
- Suspicious activity reported on the 1500 block of Bennett, the RP advised a vehicle had parked in front of his residence and saw two people walk up the RP's neighbor's driveway. The RP advised he could no longer see where the people were but thought it was suspicious. Officers contacted the residence, the owner advised they had sold some furniture and the people were there to pick it up.
- Suspicious activity reported on the 200 block of Witkopf Loop, the RP advised he was inside the residence when he saw lights of his vehicle turn on and off and believed someone was inside the vehicle. Officers checked the vehicle and did not locate anyone inside the vehicle, the vehicle did not appear rummaged through. Officers also checked the property and did not observe any suspicious activity.

February 02 (17 Calls for Service)

- Assistance requested at the Animal Hospital, staff advised the CSO, that a dog had been brought into the clinic had indications of possible neglect and abuse. The CSO spoke with staff regarding the issue, and it appeared the neglect occurred within Yakima County. The CSO contacted the Yakima County Animal control officer for further investigation.
- Civil issue on the 1300 block of Sheridan Ave, the RP advised she wanted her son's girlfriend to leave her residence. Officers advised the RP it was a civil issue and advised the RP she could petition the court for a no contact order. The RP's son and girlfriend decided to leave the residence to avoid further conflict.
