WEEK OF February 03, 2022 to February 09, 2023

February 03 (28 Calls for Service)

- Theft reported at Denchel Ford, the RP advised he took his vehicle to be serviced and left his firearm secured in the trunk of the vehicle. The RP later went to retrieve his vehicle but he could no longer locate the firearm that he had left in the trunk. Officers are investigating this incident.
- Welfare check on the 500 block of Cascade Court, the RP advised an elderly female went to the RP's door and advised the RP that she was lost. Officers made contact with the RP and the female. The female was transported to her residence and released to a staff member.
- Theft reported at Ameristar, employees advised a male had stolen a biscuit from the frozen food section. Officers are investigating this incident.

February 04 (22 Calls for Service)

- Suspicious activity reported on the 300 block of Wine Country Road, the RP advised two males were on his property, the RP advised the subjects did not take anything from the property. Officers made contact with the males and advised them to stay off of private property.
- Parking complaint received on the 500 block of Cascade Court, the RP advised there were vehicles parked on both sides of the street and there wasn't much room for vehicles to drive through. Officers checked the area and found all the parked vehicles to be within one foot from the curb and all parked in the legal direction. Officers advised the RP of this information, no vehicles were obstructing traffic.

February 05 (17 Calls for Service)

- Welfare check requested at Loves, the RP advised her husband had made statements of self-harm and was concerned for his wellbeing. Officers contacted the male in his truck, sleeping. The male stated he did not want to harm himself, and just wanted to be left alone. The male denied resources for CRISIS.
- Information requested on the 1300 block of Sheridan Ave, the RP advised she wanted to know if a male had any active warrants. Officers advised the RP, the male has to check himself because that information would not be disclosed to a third party.

February 06 (18 Calls for Service)

- Assault on the 800 block of Main Street, the RP stated her daughter had been assaulted in front of their residence. An officer made contact with the victim who was crying and appeared visibly shaken up. The victim stated she had told her boyfriend to go to his mother's house to obtain her belongings, when the male became upset and punched her multiple times. The female alleged she fell while being punched and the male began dragging her. Medics were requested to evaluate the victim and another officer arrested the suspect for assault. The suspect was transported to Benton County Jail.

- Order violation reported on the 1300 block of Sheridan Ave, the RP advised a person who she had a no contact order against was at the location. Officers checked and advised the RP there currently was not an order in place. Officers assisted the RP with her question regarding obtaining a no contact order.
- Disturbance reported on the 800 block of Main Street, the RP advised her daughter had been staying with her for a few days but they had been arguing and wanted the female out of her residence. Officers made contact with the RP's daughter and advised her she had to leave the property. The female gathered her belongings and departed from the residence.
- Disturbance at the 800 block of Main Street, the RP advised she found her daughter sneaking into her home through a window after being asked to leave the residence. The RP advised the female was refusing to leave the residence. Officers made contact with the female who agreed to leave the residence with her grandmother who had arrived to pick up the female.

February 07 (21 Calls for Service)

- Welfare check requested in the area of Wine Country Road and Old Inland Empire, the RP advised he heard screaming outside for help. The RP advised he went to see what was going on and found a male screaming because the female he was with was struck in a concrete box. Officers made contact with the male and female, who both advised that the female had sat on the edge of the concrete box and fell backwards into the concrete box. Medics and firefighters assisted with getting the female out of the box. The female was transported by medics to Prosser Memorial Hospital.
- Information received from Loves, the RP advised she is a truck driver and was at the location for a few days and wanted officers to be aware that her gas cap was off and was unsure if someone had taken it off. The RP wanted to notify officers in case other similar reports were made.
- Assistance requested at Super 8, the RP advised he had been arrested and left his property in the hotel room. The RP advised the hotel won't return his property until he pays the money he owes to the business. The RP requested officers go take back his property. Officers denied the RP request since it is a civil matter, the RP became verbal with officers and ended contact.

February 08 (11 Calls for Service)

- Fire assistance on the 1000 block of Park Ave, report received of a chimney fire. Firefighters assisted with the fire, while officers assisted with traffic control for the scene.
- Traffic stop in the area of Wine Country Road and SR22, a traffic stop was conducted after observing a vehicle had an expired registration. The officer made contact with the driver, who was a juvenile. The driver was cited for being in violation of an instruction permit.

February 09 (13 Calls for Service)

- Theft at Sister to Sister, the RP advised a female went into the store and stole over \$200 of merchandise. The female slipped the items in her purse and took a single item to the counter and then asked to use the restroom, staff advised the female that the business did not have a public restroom. The female placed the item on the counter and advised she'd be back, the female never went back. Officers are investigating this incident.
- Disturbance reported at Amber Hills, report received regarding an elderly male who was upset and threatening staff. Officers made contact with the male who advised he was upset because staff wouldn't let him out of the facility to hitch hike to Walla Walla. Officers assisted in calming the male, and medics transported the male to Prosser Memorial Hospital.
