## ACTIVITY LOG

### WEEK OF FEBRUARY 07, 2020 TO FEBRUARY 13, 2020

#### **FEBRUARY 07** (17 calls for service)

- Traffic stop in the 800 block of Wine Country Road. Driver was cited and released for No Valid Operator License, Speeding, and Operating a Motor Vehicle w/o Insurance.
- Theft report at Prosser High School. Student admitting to stealing money from another student's backpack. Situation was handled by the school.
- Fraud report received at Love's, report of males using rewards card numbers that don't belong to them.
- Report of a missing child received from Prosser Height's Elementary. Child was found walking home instead of riding the bus by parent.
- Report of a suspicious person in the 800 block of Brown Street. Reporting Party (RP) stated a male had knocked on their door in the early morning hours asking for a tire.
- Warrant arrest in the 700 block of Wine Country Road, male taken into custody. Vehicle was seized for a search warrant and suspected narcotics and drug paraphernalia were located.

#### **FEBRUARY 08** (21 calls for service)

- Traffic hazard reported on Kinney Way near the Prosser Aquatic Center. Report of two subjects on skateboards going back and forth across the road, RP was concerned they may get hit by a vehicle. Officer checked the area, but did not locate the skateboarders.
- Officer found an open gate leading to the new high school construction site. The area was checked and nothing appeared to be out of place. The gate was secured and locked.
- Suspicious activity reported at Keene Riverview Elementary. RP advised they had seen three juveniles on the roof of the school. Officer contacted the three juveniles on the roof. Parents were contacted to retrieve their children and would handle their discipline.
- Theft report received in the 600 block of New Gate Drive. RP stated he was about to air up an air mattress and had plugged his air compressor in right outside of his front door. RP then stepped inside his house to retrieve the mattress and when he came back out, the air compressor was missing. Air compressor was described as a Central Pneumatic brand, 3-gallon and red and black in color.
- Harassment report received in the 300 block of Nunn Road. RP advised that subjects keep harassing her in person and through text messages. RP was advised to get a no contact/anti -harassment order.
- Suspicious vehicle reported in the 600 block of New Gate Drive. RP noticed a Ford F250 or F350 on his security camera. RP advised that he truck resembled the same truck that had stolen tools from the back of his truck on January 31<sup>st</sup>.

#### **FEBRUARY 09** (17 calls for service)

- Officer contacted a female in the area of 6<sup>th</sup> Street and Meade Ave who was found to have an active warrant. Upon arrest, female was found to be in possession of drug paraphernalia and a bottle full of unidentified pills.
- Traffic stop in the area of Alexander Ct and Wine Country Road. Driver was suspected of being under the influence and taken into custody for DUI.
- Barking dog complaint received in the 1900 block of Miller Ave. Officers checked the area, but did not locate any barking dogs.
- Fraud information, RP who resides in New York had someone claiming to be a Prosser resident try and scam her, but she was too smart for his tricks. Scammer was not a resident and likely not in the country.
- Traffic stop in the area of Bennett Ave and Kinney Way. Driver was cited and released for DWLS 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree and Operating a Motor Vehicle w/o Insurance.
- Reckless traffic complaint received in the area of 10th Street and Grant Ave. Report of a vehicle speeding and serving. Officer located the vehicle parked and unattended at a residence in the 1100 block of Grant Ave.

Assault report received in the Prosser area. Officers contacted the RP who stated he had been punched in the face by his ex when he was picking up his child. It was determined that the assault had occurred in the 8600 block of N Missimer Road. Due to the incident occurring in the county, information was forwarded to BCSO.

## **FEBRUARY 10** (27 calls for service)

- Request for a welfare check received at Food Depot. RP called saying there was a baby that was crying and had been left in a car. Upon Officers arrival, the mother had returned to the vehicle and was feeding the baby. She said she had just gone in to the store to get a money order. With the assistance of a Spanish speaking DOC Officer, the mother was informed of the severity of leaving a baby in a car.
- Civil issue in the 100 block of Walker Place. RP called and said his gravel driveway had been damaged when a vehicle was towed from his property. RP said a man that is living with him was buying a vehicle but had not made the final payments and the owner of vehicle came and had it towed. RP was advised that this is a civil matter and he would need counsel from a lawyer.
- Reckless traffic complaint received in the area of SR22 and Wine Country Road. RP said a small black vehicle traveling west on SR22 was skidding around other vehicles. Officers were unable to locate vehicle, information was passed on to WSP.
- Assist in the 500 block of Albro Road. Officers assisted BCSO Deputy with a reported disturbance until other County units could arrive.
- Suspicious vehicle reported in the 100 block of Old Inland Empire Hwy. RP was concerned about a vehicle that had been driving by very slowly and then parking up against the fence in their back yard. RP was advised to call right away if she sees the vehicle again and provide a direction of travel or plate number if she can and officers would try to find out why the vehicle has been in area.
- Traffic stop in the 900 block of Alexander Ct. Driver cited and released for DWLS 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree and Operating a Motor Vehicle w/o Insurance.
- Reckless traffic reported on Wine Country Road, report of a vehicle traveling in excess of 90 miles per hour coming off exit 82. Area was checked, but officers did not locate the vehicle.
- Traffic stop in the 700 block of Wine Country Road. Driver cited and released for DWLS 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree and Speeding.

## **FEBRUARY 11** (30 calls for service)

- Suspicious person reported at the Holiday Inn. Employee advised a guest was acting paranoid and was stating he was seeing people. Male had returned to his room prior to officer arrival. Employee was advised to call back if there were any further problems.
- Officers assisted BCSO with a report of a wrong way vehicle on I-82. Officers were on the lookout, but did not locate the vehicle.
- Threats report received in the 300 block of Nunn Road. RP previously filed a report for threats and was advised to call if she received any further contact from the suspect. RP stated she received a text message from the suspect, which stated he was going to come over to her residence. Officers responded, but the male never showed up. RP said she would be obtaining a no contact order.
- Report of counterfeit money received at Prosser Mini Mart. RP said she took a \$100 bill for a \$13 dollar transaction and the bank called her and said it was counterfeit.
- Suspicious person reported at the Rest Area. Report of a male acting strange, kicking doors and yelling. Officers contacted the male and he said he had just gotten out of jail and was waiting to catch the bus to Yakima. Officers deescalated his attitude and told him where the bus stop was. He was encouraged to go there and wait.
- Report of malicious mischief at the Prosser Library. Juvenile was upset and kicked a window of the Boy Scout building, causing it to break. Report to be forwarded to the Juvenile Prosecutor for charges.
- Report of a suspicious person in the area of Housel Middle School. It was reported to the SRO that there was a male riding a bike back and forth in front of school while playing loud music.
- Animal complaint received in the 800 block of 7<sup>th</sup> Street. Report of malnourished dogs with ribs and hip bones protruding and exposed. CSO contacted the owner of the dogs who stated the dogs had worms, which was the reason for their appearance. Owner was advised he had a week to provide proper medical attention or relinquish the animals. Otherwise, he would be looking at charges of animal cruelty.
- Scam call received in the 1000 block of Gum Street. RP called in saying he keeps getting calls from someone saying they are with the Social Security Office. RP was afraid that if he kept hanging up on them he would get in trouble. Officer called the number provided by RP and spoke with a person who admitted it was just his job and he had to do it. Person would not give officer his personal number. Officer called the number numerous times until it was eventually disconnected.

Officers responded to a verbal domestic disturbance in the 1300 block of Wine Country Road. A male and female were contacted and both stated that there had been an argument only. Officers determined that no crimes had been committed.

## **FEBRUARY 12** (19 calls for service)

- Disturbance reported in the area of Highland Drive and Luther Lane. RP who is a cab driver out of Tri-Cities had picked up juvenile females and transported them home after a night of drinking. Once they arrived at their destination, the females stated they didn't have money to pay for the fare and took off. The father was eventually located and was able to pay the cab fee.
- Assault reported at Prosser High School. Student had been in an altercation with another student and assaulted staff members and Officers when they tried to intervene. Information will be forwarded to the Juvenile Prosecutor's Office for review.
- Malicious mischief reported in the 1000 block of Anna Street. RP believed someone had shot his vehicle with a BB gun causing damage.
- Noise complaint received in the 1800 block of Wine Country Road. Report of loud music. Officer contacted the residence with the music and they agreed to turn it down.
- Theft of beer reported at Love's. Unknown male came in and stole two 12 pack cases of Modelo beer before fleeing on foot. One case of beer was found in the parking lot. Images of the suspect were posted on Facebook for help in identifying the male.

## **FEBRUARY 13** (16 calls for service)

- Officer attempted to stop a vehicle for various traffic violations in the area of Merlot Drive near the Ameristar gas station. The vehicle failed to yield and led officers on a pursuit westbound on I-82. The vehicle exited at milepost 75 and took canal roads. The vehicle was eventually ditched in an orchard near Factory Rd in Sunnyside. Pasco K9 tracked the occupants of the vehicle, but was not able to locate them. The K9 indicated on the vehicle for narcotics and it was impounded for a search warrant.
- Residential burglary reported in the 1900 block of Miller Ave. Shed was broken into overnight and various items were stolen including tools, a TV, and an Xbox.
- Vehicle reported stolen out of Pasco was recovered in the 2000 block of Highland Drive. Vehicle was turned over to the registered owner.
- Trespass complaint received in the 1400 block of Sunset Drive. RP advised of several juveniles walking through her property even though the area is posted for no trespassing. RP stated this is an ongoing problem with students crossing her yard to access the ditch bank. SRO advised he would contact the middle school to have them put out a notice in their bulletin.
- Weapons complaint received in the 400 block of N River Road. RP advised of a male at their door whom they thought had a pistol. RP stated the male along with a female left in a white Tahoe. Officers stopped the suspect vehicle and contacted the occupants who advised of a verbal dispute with the RP over stolen jewelry. A consent to search the vehicle was granted and no weapons were located. The male was found to have an active warrant out of Sunnyside. He was taken into custody and transported to the Sunnyside Jail.
