## ACTIVITY LOG

**WEEK OF February 17, 2022 to February 23, 2023**

### **February 17** (24 Calls for Service)

- Welfare check requested on the 900 block of Alexander Court, the RP advised he was supposed to pick up his child at the location but his daughter nor the mother of the child were answering their phone and was worried for the juvenile's wellbeing. Officers contacted the residence and spoke with the mother and juvenile, the juvenile advised she had made plans with a friend over the weekend and refused to go with the RP. Officers advised the RP to contact his attorney regarding this matter since it is a civil issue.

### **February 18** (16 Calls for Service)

- Runaway reported on the 1000 block of Burgundy Place, the RP advised her juvenile son ran away from the residence in the middle of the night. The juvenile was entered into the system as a runaway. The juvenile returned to the residence a few days later. No further issues arose
- Vehicle prowling reported on the 1000 block of Colena Street, the RP advised two of his vehicles had been prowled and approximately \$2000 dollars worth of property was taken. Officers are investigating this incident.
- Assault reported on the 900 of Florence Street, officers responded to assault call, when they arrived they found two family members holding down the juvenile suspect. The mother of the juvenile advised that the juvenile had assaulted her sister. Officers made contact with the victim, who stated she was walking out of the laundry room with a basket of clothes, when her sister noticed a pair of her pants in the basket. The victim advised the suspect became upset that she had her pants, and attacked her. The juvenile suspect was arrested for domestic violence assault and was transported to Benton County Juvenile Detention Center.
- Disturbance reported at Holiday Inn, report received of a male and female arguing in the parking lot. Officers arrived at the scene when the female stated that the male had hit her and threw her to the ground. The female also advised they had been arguing because the male wanted to see her phone and when she said no her pushed her down and hit her. The officer spoke with both parties and a few witnesses and determined an assault had occurred. The male was arrested and transported to Benton County Jail for domestic violence assault.

### **February 19** (7 Calls for Service)

- Assault on the 130000 block of North River Road, report received regarding a domestic violence assault. Officers made contact with the victim who advised the male was intoxicated and hit his son and dragged him by his hair, when the victim tried to stop the male he shoved her out of the way. The male was arrested for domestic violence assault and was transported to Benton County Jail.

- Information reported on the 1100 block of Prosser Ave, the RP advised his ex-girlfriend was saying mean things about him, and was wondering what do to about it. Officers advised the male it was a criminal matter and encouraged the RP to avoid contact with his ex.
- Welfare check reported on the 900 block of Anna Street, the RP advised her mother had not been answering the phone or the door and was worried. Officer's made contact with the RP's mother, who advised she was fine and spoke with the RP, no further issues arose.

## February 21 (27 Calls for Service)

- Information call on the 130000 block North River Road, the RP advised she had questions regarding a no contact order and a domestic violence incident. Officers assisted the RP with her questions.
- Assistance requested on the 130000 block of North River Road, the RP requested a phone call from officers. Officers contacted the male, who advised he wanted to go to the residence named in the no-contact order to collect his items. Officers advised the RP, he was not allowed at the residence and would be in violation of the order.
- Assistance requested on the 130000 block of North River Road, the RP advised his friend had a no-contact order and had questions about collecting a few items for his friend. Officers advised the RP about what could go wrong if they go to the property.

## February 22 (10 Calls for Service)

- Suspicious activity from Umatilla, the RP advised she saw two bright things in the sky and was unsure what it was and was unsure if it was in Prosser also. Officers advised the RP there was no unusual lights or balloons located or observed.
- Patrol at Heights Elementary, officers conducted patrol at Heights elementary and located an unsecured door. Officers checked the building and cleared it and contacted the school district,

## February 23 (13 Calls for Service)

- Bomb threat at Housel Middle School, dispatch received a call from an anonymous caller, stating that a friend had posted on social media that there was a bomb at the school. Staff were evacuated from the building and students arriving to the school were diverted to the high school. A Hanford bomb sniffing K9 conducted an extensive search, no suspicious items were located. The building was cleared and reopened.
- Theft reported at Loves, the RP advised a female was at the business and was seen shoplifting, the female was seen placing an electronic device in her purse and leaving the business without paying. Officers are investigating this incident.
- Theft reported at Loves, the RP advised he left his wallet in the men's restroom, and it was returned to him by maintenance, but no longer had the cash he had in his wallet. There are current suspects for this case.
