## ACTIVITY LOG

### WEEK OF February 24, 2022 to March 02, 2023

#### February 24 (15 Calls for Service)

- Threats at Housel Middle School, dispatch advised they had received a two reports of an active shooter threat. Prosser PD and Benton County Sheriffs responded, with the assistance of school officials, the juvenile who had been placing the calls regarding the active shooter and bomb threat was located. The juvenile was arrested and transported by Benton County Sheriffs to the Benton County Juvenile Detention Center.
- Traffic stop in the area of Meade Ave and 7<sup>th</sup> Street, an officer observed a vehicle with defective brake lights, the driver was given a verbal warning, during this traffic stop it was discovered the driver was speaking with a female who has a no-contact order against him. The driver received a criminal citation for violating the no-contact order.
- Assault reported at the Mustang Roller Rink, the RP advised a female at the location shoved his child. Officers made contact with the RP's wife and children, who advised the children were playing with a little girl when the little girl's aunt became upset and shoved the RP's children several times. This case will be sent to the city prosecutor for review.

#### February 25 (22 Calls for Service)

- Welfare check requested on the 900 block of Ellen, the RP advised a friend had made suicidal threats and the RP had been unable to reach the male. The RP advised he was fine and had made those statements as revenge because he and the RP had been in an argument. Officers advised the RP of this information.
- Civil assist on the 900 block of Anna Street, the RP advised dispatch that her vehicle had been stolen again by someone else. Officers made contact with the RP who advised she had let someone borrow her vehicle and entered in an agreement but the female had not returned the vehicle, and she was upset because she believes the female who borrowed it is allowing the RP's son to also use it. Officers advised the RP that since an agreement was made with the female, the incident does not meet the requirements to enter the vehicle as stolen.

#### February 26 (13 Calls for Service)

- Disturbance reported at Horse Heaven Saloon, staff advised a male was yelling profanities at employees and customers, the male had gotten into several arguments over politics. The male left the business before officers arrived. The business advised they wanted the male trespasses from the business.
- Assistance requested at Golden Yan, the RP advised her vehicle stopped on SR-14 because she ran out of gas, the RP wanted to know how to get back to her vehicle. The RP was belligerent and uncooperative with officer. An employee from the restaurant also requested the RP leave, officers advised the RP she had to leave the premises.

## February 27 (25 Calls for Service)

- Suspicious activity reported on the 200 block of Merlot Drive, the RP advised a phone number called advising they are the owner of the business and was requesting information and codes pertaining to the business. The RP advised she thought it was odd after the caller requested a video call from the RP's personal phone number and requested to see the business' safe. Officers advised the RP, the phone number that called was from a different country and was a scammer attempting to obtain information.
- Welfare check requested in the area of 6<sup>th</sup> Street and Bennett Ave, the RP advised he observed an elderly male drive down the rail road tracks. Officers made contact with the RP who was with the elder male, the male advised he was confused and lost. The male denied assistance from medics. The male was escorted to the rest area to spend the night.

## February 28 (18 Calls for Service)

- Lewd conduct reported at Shy's Pizza Connection, report received of a transient male urinating in public. Officers made contact with the RP, who advised they did not see the male urinate but noticed him in the area and noticed a cardboard box behind the business had been urinated on. Officers spoke with the transient male regarding this incident.
- Assistance at Prosser Memorial Hospital, dispatch advised a male had arrived at the hospital with multiple stab wounds. Officers determined the assault had occurred outside of the city of Prosser, Benton County Sheriffs took over the investigation.
- Narcotics complaint received on the 100 block of Wamba Road, RP advised she believed there might be narcotics that were taken from the facility and are being destroyed improperly. Officers are investigating this incident.
- Suspicious activity reported at the Old High School, staff advised a male and female went into the school requesting a tour but smelled of alcohol. Staff advised they wanted officers to be aware of this incident.

## March 01 (21 Calls for Service)

- Assault reported in the area of Benson and Kinney Way, report received about two children fighting with each other. Officers spoke with one of the juveniles who advised that the other child had been talking about him and his mom so he hit the other child. Officers advised the child to not be hitting other children, both children were advised to stay away from each other.
- Disturbance reported on the 1500 block of Paterson Road, the RP advised a bald male on a scooter was recording him with a camera and also spit on the RP. Officers were unable to locate the male.
- Nuisance phone contact reported on the 1200 block of Playfield Ave, the RP advised his girlfriend had been receiving various threats from her ex-boyfriend and had mentioned he would be back in town soon, to fulfill said threats. Officers advised the RP to block the male, and petition the court for a no-contact order.

## March 02 (22 Calls for Service)

- Civil complaint reported on the 100 block of Old Inland Empire, the RP wanted information on obtaining his property back from his old roommate and how to obtain his firearm that was turned

into the police department for safekeeping by his past roommate. Officers assisted with answering the RP's questions.

- Nuisance phone contact reported on the 800 block of Alexander Court, the RP advised she had received various calls from a juvenile leaving obscene messages. Officers contacted the juvenile and advised him to stop called the RP, the juvenile advised he had found the number written on the playground and had been calling the number. The juvenile advised he would stop contacting the RP.
- Welfare check requested on the 1800 block of Benson, the RP advised she tried to deliver a meal to an elderly male but he didn't answer his door and was unable to reach him. Officers contacted the male at his residence who advised he had gone to run a few errands, the male was in good spirits and advised he was doing fine.
