ACTIVITY LOG WEEK OF FEBRUARY 28, 2020 TO MARCH 05, 2020

FEBRUARY 28 (27 calls for service)

- Traffic stop in the area of Gap Road and Old Inland Empire Hwy. Driver was cited and released for DWLS 3rd Degree.
- Traffic hazard in the area of Meade Ave and Wine Country Road. Officer responded to a report of a disabled semi blocking traffic. Halls Towing was contacted to move the semi.
- Suspicious circumstances reported at Prosser City Park. Reporting Party (RP) thought she had witnessed a group of juveniles steal a cell phone. The area was checked, but the group of juveniles was not located. No one in the area was missing a cell phone either.
- Civil issue between landlord and tenant reported in the 200 block of 10th Street. RP advised her landlord had changed her locks and would not allow her to retrieve her items until she paid rent. RP was advised this was a civil issue and it was suggested that she contact an attorney.
- Narcotics complaint in the 800 block of 6th Street, report of juveniles smoking marijuana in the alleyway. Area was checked, but the juveniles were not located.
- Assault report received at Prosser Food Depot. RP advised that his ex-girlfriend had hit him in the face while they were exchanging their child. The female had already left the area. Female was cited for Assault 4th DV.
- Request for a welfare check at the VFW Hall. RP advised that a highly intoxicated male had shown up at the location, sat down and fell asleep. Male was not served alcohol at the location and RP wished for him to be taken home. Male was given a courtesy transport to his residence.
- Barking dogs complaint received in the 1000 block of Anna Street. Officer did not hear anything while patrolling the area.
- Officers responded to a disturbance at the Eagles, bartender wanted a disorderly female moved along. Upon arrival, officers heard yelling in the alleyway and observed multiple males about to fight. The males were encouraged not to fight and they complied. The crowd disbursed and the female was moved along.

FEBRUARY 29 (29 calls for service)

- Report of suspicious circumstances in the 1900 block of Highland Drive. RP was concerned because a tarp had been moved from some sheetrock and construction equipment, leading him to believe someone was trying to steal it. Officer checked the area and did not locate anyone. It was windy, which may have caused the tarp to blow off.
- Suspicious circumstances reported at the VFW. Employee observed a male wearing a black facemask trying to get into the back gate of the property. Officers were not able to locate the male.
- While searching for the above male, officers contacted a vehicle occupied by a male and female parked at Crawford Park. They advised they were just sleeping for the night. Officers advised them of the park hours and they moved along.
- Traffic stop conducted in the area of 7th Street and Meade Ave. Driver was found to have a suspended license and was cited and released for DWLS 3rd Degree as well as Operating a Motor Vehicle without Ignition Interlock.
- Traffic stop in the area of N Gap Road and Merlot Drive. Driver was cited and released for DWLS 2nd Degree.
- Officers responded to a residential alarm in the 900 block of Anna Street. Officers arrived on scene and observed the back patio door open and could see someone moving around inside. Officers announced their presence and told the individual to come outside. Officers determined the individual was allowed to be at the location and no problems were found.
- Traffic stop in the area of Market Street and SR 22. Driver was determined to be driving with a suspended license and was cited and released for DWLS 3rd Degree.
- Reckless traffic complaint received in the area of Old Inland Empire Hwy and Wine Country Road. RP advised a vehicle had ran several stop signs and was swerving. The vehicle had reportedly pulled into a driveway on OIE. Officers contacted the driver of the vehicle and advised him to be more attentive while driving.

MARCH 01 (12 calls for service)

- Report of a loose Pit Bull in the 900 block of Brown Street. RP advised it wasn't the first time the dog has come into his yard, but this time he was being aggressive. Officers were able to keep the dog contained until the Community Service Officer (CSO) came and took custody of it. The dog was transported to the Prosser Animal Shelter to be held until the owner could be located.
- Aggressive dogs reported in the 900 block of Florence Street. RP advised their neighbors dogs kept knocking down the fence. The CSO arrived and while attempting to secure the fence one of the dogs tried to bite his leg. The dog owner was cited for Dogs at Large and for not having a required dog license.
- Malicious mischief reported at Wine Country RV Park. RP stated they had rented out their meeting room and play yard for a birthday party. RP arrived to find the area trashed and the fence damaged. RP was advised that it was a civil matter and they should contact their attorney.
- Report of a hit and run received in the 1800 block of Benson Ave. Witnesses said they saw a silver Dodge pickup hit the curb and then hit a fence before taking off on Wine Country Road. Officers checked the area, but could not locate the vehicle. Homeowner was contacted and advised of the situation.
- Lobby contact, RP wanted to let officers know of a walking hazard on Bennet Ave near Court Street. RP said there was a snowmobile behind of the house and one of the skis was protruding out onto the sidewalk.
