## ACTIVITY LOG

**WEEK OF March 03, 2022 to March 09, 2023**

### **March 03** (24 Calls for Service)

- Civil complaint reported on the 100 block of Old Inland Empire, the RP advised she had property that belongs to her old roommate and does not want him to go to the residence to pick up his items. The RP advised she wanted to drop off all the ex-roommate's belonging at the police department so an officer can release it to him. Officers advised the RP they are unable to do that since the issue is a civil matter.

### **March 04** (11 Calls for Service)

- Traffic complaint reported at the Prosser PD, the RP advised he came to the PD and advised he wanted to turn himself in for running a red light. Officers advised the RP he would not be arrested for running a red light but advised the RP about safe driving and advised the RP to ensure he is yielding for red lights.
- Suspicious activity at the Walter Clore building, officers found the front door unsecured. Officers assisted with securing the building and contacted an employee to advise them the doors were secured.

### **March 05** (14 Calls for Service)

- Welfare check requested Northwest Farm Supply, the RP requested a welfare for a female at the location. The RP stated the female was ordering food at the food truck, and appeared to be intoxicated and was barely able to stand, the RP was worried that the female would leave the location in that state. Officers arrived to the location and made contact with the female who was highly intoxicated and uncooperative. Officers provided the female with a courtesy ride to her residence.
- Welfare check requested on the 200 block of Old Inland Empire, the RP advised she was worried about her sister because she hadn't been able to get ahold of her, and advised the RP's mother had received a message from the RP's sister in code saying she needed help. Officers arrived at the location and spoke with the female, who advised she was fine.

### **March 06** (21 Calls for Service)

- Theft reported on the 700 block of 6<sup>th</sup> Street, the RP advised someone had stolen a historic window and frame from the location. The currently are no leads in this case.
- Non-injury collision in the area of Bennett and Lilian Street, report received of a collision. Officers spoke with both parties involved, and one of the parties advised the vehicle in front of her pulled over to the side, so she continued driving when the other vehicle pulled back into the road as if to turn into the other lane. Officers assisted with the collision report and exchange of information.
- Theft reported at Northwest Farm Supply, the RP advised multiple tools were stolen from the business. Officers are investigating this incident.

## March 07 (13 Calls for Service)

- Suspicious circumstance requested at Heights Elementary, the RP advised she believed someone was pounding on the roof of the school. Officers arrived and found the contractors working on the roof, no suspicious activity observed.
- Civil dispute reported at the police department, a male advised he had purchased a saw from a male, but the seller won't honor the warranty and is having issues with the seller. Officers advised the RP, that this was a civil issue.

## March 08 (18 Calls for Service)

- Disturbance reported on the 100 block of Wamba Road, a male was yelling in the hallways of the residence and entering into other residents rooms'. When officers arrived the male was in his room, no further assistance was requested.
- Theft reported at NW Farm Supply, the RP advised a male was at the business stealing and had stolen items a few days prior. Officers made contact with the male at his vehicle, the male admitted to stealing tools. Officers returned the stolen items to the store, and management advised they wished to file charges and trespass the male. Officers assisted with trespassing the male, and this case will be sent to the prosecutor's office.
- Vehicle complaint reported at Loves, an employee advised an intoxicated male was at the pumps and was unsure if he was driving. Officers located the vehicle and found the male party sitting in the passenger seat. A female inside the store advised she was the driver. The female advised she was concerned he'd get physical with her while intoxicated. The female stated she would stay in the area until the male sobered up. Officers advised the female to call 911 if the male becomes physical with her.

## March 09 (21 Calls for Service)

- Malicious mischief reported at Speck Chevrolet, report received of a female causing a disturbance at the business while attempting to serve an employee with paperwork. The female also threw a beverage at the male's vehicle. The business requested the female leave the premise and be trespassed. Officers assisted with trespassing the female, and officers are investigating this malicious mischief case.
- Disturbance on the 1400 block of Sunset Drive, report received of a male causing a disturbance because he was trying to see his child, but the female party advised she did not want him to see the child and did not want him at the residence. Both parties were informed to seek a parenting plan through the courts. The male was asked to leave the premises.
- Civil assistance requested on the 300 block of Wine Country Road, the RP advised he needed assistance obtaining his belonging from his girlfriend. Officers advised the RP they are unable to assist with civil matters.
