ACTIVITY LOG WEEK OF MARCH 06, 2020 TO MARCH 12, 2020

MARCH 06 (21 calls for service)

- Suspicious circumstances reported in the 1400 block of Prosser Ave. Possible fraud and threats, ongoing investigation.
- Weapons complaint received in the 200 block of 3rd Street. Reporting Party (RP) claimed they heard gunshots coming from the area of a nearby trailer. The trailer and area were checked, but no issues were found.
- Officers recovered a vehicle reported stolen out of Seattle at Love's that resulted in three arrests being made. One adult female was arrested for Possession of a Stolen Vehicle and Theft 3rd Degree. Another female was arrested for Theft 3rd Degree and Possession of Controlled Substance. An adult male was arrested for an active warrant. During transport to the jail, one female passed out and required medical attention. Medical attention was due to consuming/swallowing narcotics prior to PD contact. Both females were transported to TRIOS where they were medically cleared before being booked into the Benton County Jail. The vehicle was impounded to the PD awaiting a search warrant.

MARCH 07 (25 calls for service)

- Request for a welfare check received at Love's for a report of an intoxicated female that appeared to be injured. Upon investigation it was determined there was no incident, just a highly intoxicated female. The female was checked by medics and then transported to the Prosser Hospital by ambulance.
- Non-reportable, non-injury accident reported at the Prosser Rest Area. Officer assisted in exchange of information.
- Verbal DV reported in the 100 block of Columbia Drive. Officers determined it to be verbal only and found no crimes had occurred. Female half was advised to get a no contact order, the male half was advised not to follow the female.
- Report of threats via Snapchat received in the 400 block of North River Road. RP advised their ex had sent pictures of a gun along with threats. RP was advised to obtain a no contact order.
- Vehicle prowl reported in the 800 block of Ford Street. A bag containing various items was reported missing. The bag was later located on 03/10 in a yard in the 700 block of Ford Street and returned to the owner.
- Vehicle prowl reported in the 900 block of Anna Street. RP advised their truck had been entered and a wheel lug lock, two wooden handled shovels and a broken bike frame had been taken.
- Commercial burglary reported in the 100 block of Merlot Drive. RP advised that over \$800 was taken from the business sometime after they closed the night prior. Ongoing investigation.
- Officers assisted BCSO with a reckless traffic complaint received in the area of the Viewpoint. Report of a dark colored older Mustang speeding around and almost hitting a parked vehicle. Officers staged within the City limits, but the vehicle was not observed coming into the area.

MARCH 08 (13 calls for service)

- Vehicle prowl reported in the 1000 block of Sadie Street. RP Stated a male approximately 5'07, slender build wearing a white ball cap and white tennis shoes was seen rummaging through their vehicle. The male took off when the RP's boyfriend went outside. A few dollars and some change were reported missing. Officers were in the area quickly, but were unable to locate the suspect.
- Malicious mischief reported at Eastside Market. RP stated the back window of a Mercedes SUV had been shot out with a bb gun.
- Male known to have active warrants was located in the 400 block of North River Road. Male was taken into custody and booked into the Benton County Jail.
- Vehicle prowl reported in the 300 block of Evans Ave. RP advised the prowl occurred on 03/06 and that his work issued iPhone 6 was taken from the vehicle. The RP's roommate also reported his truck was prowled and a 1-ton Bottle Jack was stolen along with zip ties and electrical tape.

Officers responded to a disturbance in the 900 block of Margaret Street, it was determined to be verbal only and no crimes had occurred.

- Civil dispute reported in the 1400 block of Sheridan Ave over a vehicle that was sold, exchanged, but had not been paid for. RP was advised it was a civil matter.
- Telephone harassment/ prank calls report received in the 100 block of 8th Street. RP stated they were continuously getting phone calls from an unknown number. Officer called the number, but was immediately hung up on. RP stated they would just ignore the calls.

MARCH 09 (24 calls for service)

- Traffic stop in the area of Gap Road and Merlot Drive. Driver was cited and released for DWLS 3rd Degree.
- Suspicious circumstances in the 1000 block of Park Ave. RP was concerned about a tree cutting company that was removing a tree next door. The Community Service Officer made contact with the company and found that they did not have adequate licenses to be conducting business in the City. Since the tree was already nearly completely cut through, they were permitted to finish, as it was unsafe to leave the tree in that condition. Further investigation to be conducted by the CSO into the company.
- Suspicious person reported in the 1200 block of Prosser Ave. RP called saying there was a man across from the high school singing very loudly, yelling, and waving his arms around. Officers checked the area but could not find the singing man.
- Assist in the 1300 block of Wine Country Road. RP is going through a divorce and wanted to know what she could do to keep her husband from following her and calling all the time. Officers advised her to apply for a no contact order.

MARCH 10 (30 calls for service)

- Animal complaint received in the area of SR-22 and SR-221. RP saw a calf on the side of roadway and was concerned it would go into traffic. The calf was located at mile marker 24 on SR-221 and BCSO was advised.
- Traffic stop in the 700 block of Wine Country Road. Driver was cited and released for DWLS 3rd Degree.
- Suspicious activity reported at the Prosser Library. RP stated two juveniles had been in the restroom for approximately 20 minutes and they thought they might be doing "inappropriate stuff". Juveniles were gone upon officers arrival.
- Loitering complaint received at the Best Western. RP stated a motorhome had been in the parking lot of the location for several days and management wanted it moved along. Officer made contact with the occupants of the motorhome and were told of managements wishes for them to move along.
- Report of custodial interference received in the 1400 block of Patterson Road. RP reported her ex-husband has been picking up their daughter when she has court ordered custody.
- Fraud report received at US Bank. RP's stolen checks were reportedly cashed at US Bank in town. Ongoing investigation.
- Threats reported in the 1000 block of Sadie Street. RP called saying that his mom's boyfriend has been making threats against him and his mother.
- Officers responded to a loud music complaint in the 300 block of Casi Court. Officers arrived to find a family listening to music in their back yard. They agreed to turn it off saying they were going inside since it was getting cold. No more problems were reported.

MARCH 11 (24 calls for service)

- Officers responded to a robbery in the 400 block of Wine Country Road. RP said he was walking back into town and was in front of the NW Farm Supply store when he was jumped and attacked by three unknown suspects. After they had punched and kicked him, they took his wallet, cell phone, and flashlight and then fled the area in an older model silver minivan. RP was checked by medics and released. Officers found the spot of attack and the flashlight that the RP said was taken. Surrounding areas were checked by Prosser Officers and Sheriff's Deputies, but they did not locate the suspects. Ongoing investigation.
- Officers responded to a disturbance turned into a theft report at Love's. Male was arrested for attempting to steal a can of beer. Male had been broken down and drinking at Love's/Holiday Inn for three days. Male was booked for Theft 3rd Degree.
- Suspicious circumstances reported in the 900 block of Lillian Street. Report of loud noises and a female sitting in the bushes in the alleyway. Officers checked the area, but did not locate a female. Noises were believed to be coming from a train that was being unloaded across the street.

- Suspicious vehicle reported at Love's. RP called because they found it was suspicious that a car had a police scanner and radar sitting inside. Officers determined the items to actually be a GO PRO and an ignition interlock device. No other problems were noted.

- Suspicious circumstances reported in the 800 block of Court Street. RP was concerned due to a truck that was slowly circling the block. Officer located the truck in the 900 block of Court Street and discovered they were just lost while looking for an address to make a delivery.
