WEEK OF March 17, 2022 to March 23, 2023

March 17 (33 Calls for Service)

- Malicious mischief report in the 1000 block of Gum Street. Reporting Party (RP) advised their juvenile child threw a chair at their vehicle causing damage.
- Theft report in the 900 block of Sheridan Ave. RP advised their license plate had been removed from their vehicle.
- Fraud reported in the 1700 block Highland Drive. RP advised she found a listing for her house on Craigslist.
- Assist at the PD. Report of a decades old sexual assault which was determined to have occurred in Grandview. Information referred to Grandview PD.
- Non-injury accident in the 1500 block of Grant Street. Driver found to have a suspended license and cited.
- Reckless traffic complaint on I-82. Area was checked, unable to locate.
- Agency assist, officers responded to the area of Lincoln Grade for a report of a disturbance involving a weapon. The victim reported while walking in the area when a male pulled a knife and brandished a firearm. The suspect also began yelling at the victim and then left the location in a vehicle. Officers attempted to stop the vehicle but discontinued when the vehicle fled from them. About an hour later deputies found the vehicle in the 900 block of Brown Street and the suspect was taken into custody. He was booked into the Benton County jail on allegations of brandishing weapons.
- Welfare check in the 600 block of 8th Street. Report of a half-naked male covered with a blanket in a wheelchair in the area. Officer made contact with the male who was found to be homeless. Male refused assistance, but did accept an additional blanket from officers.
- Disturbance reported in the 200 block of Merlot Drive. RP reported his girlfriend located him at the hotel as was causing a disturbance. The female departed prior to officer arrival, the incident was determined to be verbal only.

March 18 (8 Calls for Service)

- Multiple follow up calls and assists.
- Warrant arrest, male arrived at the PD to turn himself in on a DOC warrant. Male was taken into custody and transported to the Franklin County Jail.
- Reckless traffic complaint in the area of N Gap Road and Wine Country Road. RP advised of a semi driving all over the roadway. Area was checked, but the semi was not located.

March 19 (10 Calls for Service)

- Multiple follow up calls and traffic stops.
- Request for welfare check on a possible suicidal individual. Contact was made and the individual advised they were fine.
- Report of a suspicious male staring and yelling at children in the City Park. Male was gone upon officer arrival.
- WSP assist with a non-injury accident on I-82, officers stayed on scene until troopers arrived.
- Officers responded to a disturbance in the 900 block of Brown Street. It was determined to be a verbal only argument between mother and son.

- Malicious mischief in the 900 block of Campbell Drive. RP advised she had an argument with her boyfriend who then used a knife to cut the tire on her vehicle. Male left the location prior to officer arrival. He was located in the area and taken into custody. Male was booked into the Benton County Jail for Malicious Mischief DV.

March 20 (19 Calls for Service)

- Request for a welfare check in the area of 8th Street and Meade Ave. RP requested officers check on a male in a wheelchair who had been in the area over the weekend.
- 911 hang up in the 1800 block of Highland Drive. Officers made contact with residences in the area, all was fine.

- Assist PMH with locating a patient who left the location.
- Suspicious circumstances in the 1800 block of Benson Ave. RP advised an unknown female had entered her home, asked for a ride and then left. It was determined to be the patient who had left the hospital. Female was located and transported back to PMH.

- Assist at the PD, female wished to turn herself in on a book and release warrant. Female was advised she would need to go to the Benton County Jail in Kennewick.
