## ACTIVITY LOG

**WEEK OF March 10, 2022 to March 16, 2023**

### **March 10** (29 Calls for Service)

- Threats reported at Elwood Staffing, the RP advised an employee was upset over a missing time card and told office staff that he would go to the location and they better have his paycheck. The RP advised if the male went to the business, they would like him trespassed. No further issues arose.
- Found item turned in at the Police Department, the RP dropped off a bank card and advised he had found it at castle car wash. Officers attempted to contact the owner.
- Theft reported at the Post Office, the RP advised a few packages were opened by an unknown person and the items inside were taken. There are currently no further information regarding this case, officers left the RP with a case number.
- Disturbance reported at Best Time Food Mart, the RP advised a male was at the store and became verbal with staff when his card was declined, the RP advised she was afraid the male was going to hit her. Officers located the male, and advised him per management's request the male was no longer able to return to store.
- Suspicious activity reported at Burger King, staff advised a female had been in the restroom for about half hour and was behaving erratically. The female was asked to move along by officers.

### **March 11** (16 Calls for Service)

- Disturbance reported in the 2100 block of East Gate, the RP reported to dispatch that his daughter had a knife with her and threatened the RP. Officers located the RP, his wife and his daughters who were separated and spoken to individually. The RP's wife and daughters advised the RP started arguing with his wife which upset one of the daughters when they started arguing each other, during the argument the RP called 911 and alleged that his daughter threatened to kill him with a knife. The RP advised he was in the kitchen when his daughter became aggressive and grabbed a kitchen knife and threatened to kill him, the RP then moved from the kitchen to garage and his daughter followed him. The daughter allegedly went and placed the knife back into the kitchen before officers arrived. Officers advised the RP there was no evidence to prove a knife was involved in the incident. The male agreed to leave the residence to prevent any further issues.
- Reckless traffic report received in the area of Sadie Street and Evans Ave, the RP advised a vehicle was seen swerving on the road, and was seen pulling over on the side of the road. An officer made contact with the driver who was parked on the side of the road, the driver was intoxicated and was advised to call someone to pick him up. A friend of the driver came to pick him up.

### **March 12** (19 Calls for Service)

- Welfare check requested in the 500 block of Cascade Court, the RP advised an elderly female arrived at his home and believed the female was lost. Officers made contact with the female and contacted her residence, the female was released to employees from Amber Hills.
- Animal complaint, report of a loose dog howling and barking in the 200 block of Canyon Drive. Information passed on to CSO.
- Multiple traffic stops with various verbal warnings given.

- EMS assist in the 1500 block of Sunset Drive, report of a child choking on a piece of food.

## March 13 (26 Calls for Service)

- Suspicious activity in the 800 block of Main Street, the RP stated a male was walking back and forth in the ally and later moved and was standing near the RP's yard and driveway, the RP was concerned of possible prowling. Officers contacted the transient male who was sleep walking, officers woke up the male and officers suggested to the male to nap in a public area instead of peoples lawns.
- Outside agency assist, at Prosser Memorial Hospital, staff advised a patient had been stabbed in the arm. Officers determined the incident had occurred outside of city limits. Benton County Sheriffs took over the investigation.
- Welfare check requested from Richland, the RP advised dispatch he was on a bus to Prosser, and believed someone was following him and trying to kill him. The male requested a call from officers. Officers contacted the male who advised he believes he was being followed by people who were going to kill him, the RP advised he had a big knife with him for protection and requested he be taken into protective custody and requested to speak with ICE. Officers advised the RP, they are unable to take him into custody.
- Welfare check requested in the area of 7<sup>th</sup> and Stacy St, the RP advised he fled from his home because someone wants to kill him, the RP stated he has thoughts of harming himself and thoughts of suicide. Officers responded and medics were contacted. Medics transported the RP to Prosser Memorial Hospital, and crisis was contacted.

## March 14 (15 Calls for Service)

- Trespass at the Prosser Memorial Clinic, the RP stated a male was attempting to open the doors at the location and force entry, the RP advised dispatch the male was leaving towards Harvest Foods. Officers made contact with the suspect, and advised him per management's request the male be trespassed from the location.
- Suspicious activity reported at Ace Hardware, the RP stated a male was staring into the windows of the business and was walking back and forth in front of the store. The RP requested the male be removed from the property. Officers made contact with the same male from the previous call, the male was advised to leave the property. The male advised he would go to bus stop and wait for the bus.
- Theft reported at Ameristar, a male entered the business and stole a chocolate bar and several individual Lindor chocolates. Officers are investigating this incident.
- Suspicious person reported in the area of 1100 Yakima Ave, the RP advised a male was at their residence and requested to use their restroom, the male stated he was from Texas and used to reside in the area. The RP advised the male also went and knocked on several doors in the neighborhood. Officers checked the area but did not locate the male.

## March 15 (14 Calls for Service)

- Parking complaint in the 200 block of Gap Road, RP advised of unauthorized drivers using the handicap parking during pre-school drop off and pick up. Request for extra patrols made.
- WSP assist with information on possible suspect.
