## ACTIVITY LOG WEEK OF MARCH 20, 2020 TO MARCH 26, 2020

### **MARCH 20** (16 calls for service)

- Officer responded to a parking complaint in the 1800 block of Benson Ave. Reporting Party (RP) advised of a vehicle blocking their irrigation sprinkler box that they wanted moved. Officer determined it was not blocking the right of way and attempts to reach the registered owner were not successful.
- Request for a welfare check received in the 400 block of Wine Country Road. RP requesting officers check on an elderly male. Officers determined the male was no longer at the location and advised the RP of such.
- Officers responded to a domestic disturbance in the 900 block of Roza Vista Drive. It was determined that a verbal only argument had occurred.
- Barking dog complaint received in the 700 block of Myrtle Street. RP advised of an ongoing issue with their neighbors dogs. Officer made contact with the dog's owner who advised they would work on correcting the issue.
- Officers assisted Washington State Patrol with locating and detaining a suspect who fled from a fatal hit and run accident that occurred in the area of W 80000 PR SW and Carter Road. Male was captured and booked into the Benton County Jail.
- Request for a welfare check received at Love's. RP concerned for a juvenile female seen getting into a semi-truck. Officers made contact with the semi-truck driver. No problems were found, juvenile was accompanying her father on a delivery.
- Male known to have a felony warrant was contacted at the Rest Area and taken into custody.
- Officers responded to a possible explosion or gunshot heard in the 900 block of Campbell Drive. It was determined a juvenile had shot off a firework. Juvenile was released to their parent.

### **MARCH 21** (13 calls for service)

- Parking complaint received in the 1800 block of Benson Ave. Issue with a vehicle parked blocking an irrigation box. Notice was left with the vehicle advising it needed to be moved.
- Non-injury accident reported at US Bank. Officer assisted with exchange of information.
- Medical assist in the area of SR22 and Wine Country Road. RP concerned for a disoriented elderly male parked on the side of the road. Medics transported the male to PMH.
- Reckless traffic complaint received in the area of Hoisington Road. Report of a semi-truck driving on the bike path. Officers checked the area, but did not locate the semi.
- Non-reportable accident at Love's involving two semi-trucks. Information was exchanged.

### **MARCH 22** (11 calls for service)

- Male served with a no trespass order at Dutch Bros. Male trespassed for one year at business' request.
- Animal complaint received near Prosser Airport. RP advised a dog had been left in a vehicle unattended for an hour and they were concerned because of the heat. Vehicle owner returned prior to officer arrival and the RP requested the call be cancelled.

### **MARCH 23** (13 calls for service)

- Officer responded to a vehicle accident in the 600 block of Court Street. One vehicle had struck two parked vehicles. Driver was cited for Negligent Driving 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree.
- Civil issue, RP requested an officer accompany her to retrieve vehicles from individuals who were refusing to hand them over. RP stated she had court paperwork allowing her to retrieve them. Officer advised RP the issue was civil and law enforcement could not get involved.
- Officers responded to a verbal disturbance in the 1200 block of Stacy Ave. Disturbance was determined to be verbal only, male half agreed to leave the location to avoid further issues.

## **MARCH 24** (15 calls for service)

- Officers assisted BCSO with a DOC warrant contact in the area of N Gap Road and I-82.
- Request for a welfare check received at Love's. Trucking company hadn't been able to get in touch with one of their drivers. Officer made contact with the driver at Love's and he advised he was okay.
- Disturbance reported in the 700 block of 6<sup>th</sup> Street. RP advised a male had come into the business and caused a disturbance. RP wanted to know what they could do to keep the subject from returning. RP was given information on trespass orders and how to seek a protection order.
- Malicious mischief reported in the 1400 block of Riverside Drive. RP advised her ex-boyfriend had come to the residence to talk. She stated he became upset and proceeded to break a couple of picture frames. Case was forwarded to the Prosecutor for review.
- Lobby contact regarding a fraud. RP advised he had called a phone number that he thought was for Amazon Prime. Male stated he was trying to set up free service and provided his debit card information and account numbers to an unknown person. RP then stated multiple transactions occurred and a total of \$1,100 had been deducted from his account.

## **MARCH 25** (16 calls for service)

- Residential burglary reported in the 900 block of Sheridan Ave. RP advised two people had just tried to break into his garage, but had been scared off. Officers located two juveniles in the area and determined they were involved. The juveniles were released to their parents and charges of Attempted Burglary will be forwarded to the Prosecutor's Office.
- Disturbance reported in the 1800 block of Wine Country Road. Officer contacted parties involved and determined they had a verbal only disagreement over where a vehicle can park.
- Counterfeit report received at Prosser Mini Mart. RP advised of a person attempting to use a fake \$100 bill. Officer arrived and contacted a male who was attempting to purchase ice cream and soda with the counterfeit bill. Male was transported to the PD to be interviewed. Charges will be forwarded to the Prosecutor's office.
- Vehicle prowl reported in the 300 block of Nunn Road. RP stated it appeared as if someone used a large screwdriver of some sort to pry open the rear passenger window to their vehicle causing it to shatter. Nothing was reported missing from the vehicle.
- Found property turned into the PD. RP found a set of keys in the roadway near Housel Middle School.
- Non-injury accident reported in the 1100 block of Yakima Ave. RP advised an RV had hit her parked vehicle. Officer determined the RV had struck two parked vehicles while backing out of a driveway. All parties involved were given an exchange of information and the driver of the RV was issued a citation for Improper Backing and No Insurance.

## **MARCH 26** (13 calls for service)

- Barking dog complaint received in the 1000 block of Park Ave. Officer was not able to locate the barking dog.
- Suspicious circumstances reported in the 900 block of Court Street. RP advised an unknown person had put garbage in her trashcan during the night, just before morning pick up.
- Request for an assist received at Prosser Food Depot. RP advising of a juvenile riding his skateboard on the property. RP requested officer ask the juvenile to leave. Officer made contact with the juvenile and advised him that the store did not want him skateboarding in the parking lot. He advised he understood.
- Suspicious activity reported in the 1000 block of Hemlock Street. RP was concerned because her neighbor's dog was growling and barking in a different manner than it normally growls and barks. Dog owner on Larch Street was contacted, it was determined the dog was barking at another dog in the area.
