WEEK OF March 24, 2022 to March 30, 2023

March 24 (22 Calls for Service)

- Assist Pasco PD with officer involved shooting incident.
- Theft reported in the 30 block of Merlot Drive. Investigation ongoing.
- Suspicious person reported in the 800 block of Park Ave. RP advised of a female going through the school dumpster. Female was contacted, but refused any assistance from officers. She was warned against trespassing on other's property.
- Suspicious circumstances in the 800 block of Park Ave, the female contacted in the previous call was reported to have left a box on the Boys & Girls Club trash can.
- Request for a welfare check received in the 1900 block of Highland Drive Reporting Party (RP) advised of a male reclined back in a vehicle. Male was contacted and found to be taking a nap.
- Reckless traffic complaint in the 300 block of Wine Country Road. RP advised of a male screaming at people from his vehicle.
- Non injury, non-reportable collision in the 300 block of Wine Country Road. Involved parties exchanged information prior to officer arrival.
- Warrant service in the area of 6th Street and Sheridan Ave. Adult male taken into custody and booked into the Benton County Jail.
- Suspicious circumstances in the 1900 block of Miller Ave. RP advised their daughter had seen someone who was wearing all black look over their fence. Officers checked the area, but were unable to locate the described individual.

March 25 (10 Calls for Service)

- Citizen assist in the 900 block of Anna Street. RP advised officer that a large group of unwanted individuals may show up at the residence in order to visit a person who was there on hospice care. RP was advised to keep their doors and windows locked and to call 911 should there be any disturbances.
- Suspicious circumstances reported at the Rest Area. RP advised of a male and female who were asking for money. Officers checked the area, but the individuals were no longer in the area.
- Suspicious person reported in the 600 block of 6th Street. Report of a male on a bicycle who was looking into vehicles. The area was checked, but the male was not located.
- Sex offense reported, incident was determined to have occurred within the county and referred to the Sheriff's Office.

March 26 (8 Calls for Service)

- Officers assisted BCSO in the area of Missimer Road and County Route 12 with a report of a male and female physically fighting in the roadway. The area was checked, but officers were unable to locate the male and female.
- Private property collision reported in the Loves parking lot. RP was advised to exchange information with the other party involved.
- Officers responded to PMH for a report of a possible stabbing victim. Contact was made with a female who claimed she had been sharpening a knife when it accidentally slipped and she had stabbed herself in the abdomen. It was determined the incident occurred in the county and information was passed on to the Sheriff's Office.

- Threats report received in the 1200 block of Prosser Ave. It was determined no crime occurred, information on how to obtain a no contact order was provided.
- Suspicious circumstances reported in the 1000 block of Elm Street. Multiple RP's advised they had received strange letters to their residences regarding a male who does not reside in Prosser.
- Suspicious person reported in the 400 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated a male wearing a skull face mask was walking around. Officers checked the area, but were unable to locate the male.
- Disturbance reported in the 1000 block of Alexander Ct. RP stated they were worried for their mother believing her boyfriend may get physical. Upon officer arrival, RP stated all was okay between the parties involved and that the situation had remained verbal only.

- Agency assist in the 6000 block of N Gap Road. Officers assisted BCSO with an attempted arrest of a male who had active warrants and was driving with a suspended license.
- Disturbance reported at Loves. RP advised of a trucker who had yelled and threw a cup at staff after having issues with their debit card. Management requested the driver be asked to leave the property to which they complied upon officer request.
- Disturbance in the 900 block of Florence Street. Determined to be verbal only argument and no crime had occurred.
