ACTIVITY LOG WEEK OF MARCH 27, 2020 TO APRIL 02, 2020

MARCH 27 (14 calls for service)

- Complaint received in the area of 6th street and Bennet Ave. Reporting Party (RP) advised of a business still operating in violation of the Governor's order.
- Report of a suspicious male in the area of Bennet Ave and Anna St. RP advised male was walking around and talking to himself. Officer made contact and the male advised he was ok.
