ACTIVITY LOG WEEK OF APRIL 03, 2020 TO APRIL 09, 2020

APRIL 03 (7 calls for service)

- A Disturbance call was made on Campbell Dr. the suspect was arrested.
- A suspicious person was reported walking in the street, in the area of Sheridan and Wine Country Rd. The suspect stated he just wanted to get home. He was asked to stay out of traffic.
- A noise complaint call came in for loud music coming from the 900 block of Alexander Ct. An officer made contact and the music was turned down.
