WEEK OF April 14, 2022 to April 19, 2023

April 14 (20 Calls for Service)

- Welfare check in the 1800 block of Wine Country Road. Dispatch advised of a 911 hang up. Officer made contact with the caller who stated that her child had been playing with her cell phone which triggered the sos signal. Female stated no law enforcement assistance was needed.
- Citizen assist in the 900 block of Alexander Court. Reporting Party (RP) advised they felt their privacy was being invaded by their neighbor filming the parking lot and entrance area of the apartments. RP was advised the issue was civil and they would need to take it up with their management.
- Traffic complaint received at Keene Riverview. Crossing guard advised of a school zone violation. After review, officer could not find sufficient evidence of an infraction.
- Complaint received in the 1200 block of Bennett Ave. Report of an RV parked in the Depot parking lot leaking grey water. The registered owner (RO) was contacted and advised of the complaint. RO stated they were leaving the location and understood the area needed to be cleaned properly.
- Report of a verbal disturbance in the 700 block of Wine Country Road. RP advised of individuals yelling and cursing at customers filling up their gas tanks at Loves. Officers were unable to locate the reported individuals.
- Officers responded to a disturbance in the area of N Wamba Road and Johnson Road. Determined to be verbal only.
- Traffic complaint in the area of Colena Street and Market Street. RP advised of individuals driving ATV's in the area and causing excessive noise. Officers checked the area, but were unable to see or hear any ATV's.
- Neighbor dispute in the 100 block of Columbia Drive. RP advised her neighbor had come to her house and banged on her door yelling at her to secure her barking dog. RP was advised no crime had occurred and that it was a civil issue.

April 15 (16 Calls for Service)

- Hit and Run report received in the 1000 block of Sadie Street. RP advised an unknown vehicle had struck their parked vehicle.
- Animal complaint received at the Post Office. Report of a German shepherd hanging around the area. Information provided to the CSO for follow up.
- Parking complaint in the 200 block of Ladera Street. RP advised a Jeep that did not belong to them was parked in their driveway. Officer located the driver of the Jeep and advised them it needed to be moved.
- Officers responded to a disturbance report in the 1100 block of Bordeaux Street. RP was upset about an ongoing issue with juveniles hanging around his property and vandalizing it. Officers spoke with the RP and the juvenile's parent and all were educated as to the area of issue which is private property.
- Request for trespass at Brewminatti. RP wished to have an unwanted male trespassed from the location for harassing their employee.
- Traffic stop in the area of 7th Street and Wine Country Road. Male was found to have an active warrant out of Yakima and taken into custody.

April 16 (12 Calls for Service)

- Traffic hazard reported on I-82. Officers assisted WSP with contacting a stranded female walking along I-82. Female was given a curtesy ride to the Conoco in Benton City.
- Officers responded to a reported DV assault at Loves. RP advised of a male and female physically fighting near the shower area. The individuals were located at Burger King, but denied an assault had occurred.
- Multiple calls regarding a friendly dog hanging around the City Park. Owner was located and retrieved their dog. Information was passed on to the CSO for follow up.
- Suspicious circumstances reported in the 1300 block of Meade Ave. RP advised of a male slumped over in a vehicle parked in the Food Depot parking lot. Officer made contact and the individuals in the vehicle who agreed to move along from the location.
- Order violation reported in the area of Merlot Drive. RP who is currently homeless advised officers he thought his stepfather and mother with whom he has a protection order against, were driving around looking for him. It was determined no violation had occurred.
- Traffic hazard in the area of Meade Ave and Memorial Street. Officer made contact with a semi partially blocking the road. It was found that the driver had an injury, the truck was moved from the road and the driver was provided a courtesy ride to the hospital.
- Noise complaint received in the 800 block of Alexander Court. RP advised of hearing their neighbors running around and thought an assault may have occurred. Officers made contact with the residence who advised everything was okay and that they were simply having a girl's night in.

April 17 (18 Calls for Service)

- Suspicious circumstances at Loves. Officer conducted a welfare check on a driver who appeared to be slumped over at the wheel of a vehicle parked at the pumps. Driver was contacted and claimed she was just watching a video and was not in need of assistance.
- Lost property report in the area of Park Ave and Brown Street. RP advised they had left a pink scooter behind mistakenly and were hoping someone had turned it in.
- Burglary reported in the 400 block of 7th Street. Benton REA advised the locks had been cut on their fence and security footage showed subjects had arrived in a pickup truck, cut the locks and backed to a trailer at the location in an apparent attempt to take it. The subjects then appeared to get spooked by the motion sensor lights and took off, leaving their trailer behind. Investigation is ongoing.
- Assist in the 1000 block of Park Ave. RP punctured an irrigation line. City Water Department was dispatched to the location.
- Malicious mischief reported at Prosser Minnie Storage. RP advised the fence had been cut sometime within the last few days.
- Officers responded to a single vehicle non injury motor vehicle accident in the 900 block of Market Street. Driver slid into the canal, causing minor damage to the vehicle.

April 18 (22 Calls for Service)

- Officers assisted EMS with an individual who had OD'd on suspected fentanyl. Subject was revived after being given two doses of Narcan and transported to PMH for further treatment.
- Traffic stop in 700 block of Wine Country Road. Driver was found to have a suspended license and cited for DWLS 3rd Degree.

- Traffic stop in the area of W CR 12 and N Missimer Road. Driver was found to have an active felony warrant and taken into custody.
- Traffic complaint received in the area of Wine Country Road and Merlot Drive. Traffic was backed up due to construction in the area.
- Agency assist in the 600 block of Market Street. Male with active warrants fled court prior to officer arrival. Male was later located at his residence and taken into custody by BCSO.
- Suspicious circumstances reported at Best Western. RP believed her ex-boyfriend with whom she has an active no contact order with was stalking her while she was staying at the hotel. RP also advised she had been receiving emails which she thought to be from him. Officer checked with hotel staff and determined the male was not currently registered as a guest at the hotel. RP was advised to call if she sees him.
- Lost property report received at the Rest Area. RP stated they had left their purse on a trashcan and didn't realize until three hours later.
- Suspicious person reported in the area of Wine Country Road and Nunn Road. RP advised of a male subject who has been urinating on the walking path for the past few days. RP was told to call at the time it is occurring.
- Suspicious circumstances reported in the 300 block of Wine Country Road. RP advised of an individual observed on their security camera who was possibly prowling in the area. Officers checked the area, but were unable to locate the suspected individual.
- Assist in the 1000 block of Dudley Ave. RP advised they had drove off from the Blehyl station with the pump still in their vehicle. Officer checked the pump and did not find any apparent leaks.

April 19 (15 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to the 200 block of Merlot Drive for a report of a possible physical disturbance in progress. Officers made contact at the location and determined a no contact order violation had occurred. Information forwarded to the Prosecutor for review.
- Traffic hazard reported in the 400 block of Wine Country Road, report of a disabled vehicle received. Officer made contact and determined the vehicle had ran out of gas and the driver had help on the way already.
- Suspicious circumstances reported in the 1000 block of Alexander Court. RP advised of seeing a male leaving the location with a "baggie in his hand" and thought he was possibly involved in a narcotics deal. Officers checked the area, but did not observe any indication of a crime.
- Warrant arrest in the area of 7th Street and Wine Country Road. Male known to have a warrant located in the area and taken into custody.
- Officers assisted EMS in the 1900 block of Elwood Ave.
