WEEK OF April 20, 2022 to April 27, 2023

April 20 (12 Calls for Service)

- Agency assist in the area of W Richards Road and SR 22. Officers assisted BCSO with a roll over vehicle accident.
- Suspicious circumstances reported in the 1100 block of Concord Way. Reporting Party (RP) advised a male had approached her at her residence asking if he could fix or clean her headlights.
- Request for welfare check in the 600 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated a male appeared to be shooting a drug into his arm. Officers made contact with the male and found no indications of a crime.
- Report of a hit and run accident in the 300 block of Old Inland Empire Hwy. RP advised their mail box had been struck and damaged.

Dog appeared to be friendly, but quickly became aggressive as officer came closer. The home owner was notified and secured the dog.
