WEEK OF April 28, 2022 to May 4, 2023

April 28 (19 Calls for Service)

- Welfare check requested in the 300 block of Chardonnay Ave. Report of a male who looked distressed. Officers contacted the male who declined any assistance.
- Loitering complaint received at Horse Heaven Travel Plaza, report of a female asking customers for money. Female was contacted and issued a trespass warning at the request of the business.
- Information report in the 300 block of Chardonnay Ave. Reporting Party (RP) advised their two juvenile children had been sold beer and zig zags from Big Smoke. RP requested officers conduct a juvenile sting operation. Officers advised RP to contact the Liquor Control Board regarding the alleged allegation.
- Malicious mischief report received in the area of 7th Street and Bennett Ave. RP advised officers that a group of juveniles drove by and threw eggs at the RP's vehicle. The suspect vehicle was located near Mustang Plaza and multiple juveniles were contacted. Charges to be forwarded to the Prosecutor.
