## ACTIVITY LOG

**WEEK OF May 5, 2022 to May 11, 2023**

### **May 5** (20 Calls for Service)

- Suspicious circumstances reported in the area of Chardonnay Ave and Wine Country Road. Reporting Party (RP) advised of someone possibly using a grinder near the Super 8 or grocery store and thought it was odd given the time of night. The area was checked, but officers did not locate anything out of the ordinary.
- Suspicious vehicle reported in the area of Market Street and Concord Way. RP noticed a 4 door Honda with multiple occupants hanging around the area which looked suspicious. Officers checked the surrounding area, but did not locate the vehicle described.
- Welfare check in the 300 block of Old Inland Empire Highway. APS reported a possible elder neglect. Medics checked on the male who advised he was not in need of assistance.
- Suspicious circumstances reported at the Rest Area. RP advised of a female in the restroom who appeared to be using narcotics. Officers made contact with a known female who claimed she was not smoking anything in the restroom. Officers did not observe her to be under the influence and no other issues were noted.

### **May 6** (21 Calls for Service)

- Agency assist in the area of Beers Road. Officers assisted BCSO with a residential alarm call. Officers found no signs of entry into the residence.
- Officers assisted WSP with a single vehicle non-injury collision on SR22 and Market Street.
- Warrant arrest in the area of 6<sup>th</sup> Street and Bennett Ave. Male known to have warrants was contacted in the area and taken into custody.
- Theft report received in the 800 block of Myrtle Ave. RP advised their green and black Mongoose mountain bike had been stolen from their backyard.
- Traffic stop in the area of W Old Inland Empire Highway and S Missimer Road. Driver was found to have an active warrant and taken into custody.
- Animal complaint received in the 500 block of Wine Country Road. RP advised their small dog had been attacked by their neighbor's large dog. Officers made contact with all parties involved, the RP's dog did not appear to have life threatening injuries and it was decided the issue would be handled civilly amongst themselves.
- Suspicious circumstances reported at the City Park. Report of a male and female behaving strangely. Officers responded to the area, but were unable to locate the described individuals.
- Report of a possible vehicle prowler in the 1000 block of Concord Way. RP observed a male standing near their vehicle with a flashlight. Contact was made with a juvenile male and officers determined that no crimes had been committed.

### **May 7** (15 Calls for Service)

- Suspicious circumstances reported in the 600 block of 6<sup>th</sup> Street. RP stated they had attempted to make conversation with someone at Bern's who then made them uncomfortable. RP was advised to avoid talking to people that he feels are shady in the future.
- Assist in the 900 block of Alexander Court. RP advised she had locked her child in her vehicle. Per policy and because the child was not in distress, RP was referred to a locksmith for assistance.

- Animal complaint in the 400 block of Petra Ave. RP stated that a dog belonging to a residence on Basalt Loop had chased her elderly parents. Information was forwarded to the CSO for follow up.
- Officers assisted BCSO with a domestic disturbance in the area of Johnson Road. Contact was made with a female who was upset over how much a male at the location had been drinking.
- Officers responded to a disturbance in the 1200 block of Kinney Way. RP advised she had been in an argument with the father of her child. It was determined there was no parenting plan in place. RP was given information on how to obtain a no contact order. Male was trespassed from the location at the request of the RP.
- Suspicious circumstances in the area of Myrtle Street and Brown Street. RP advised of a male who appeared suspicious walking a dog in the area. RP was advised extra patrols would be conducted in the area.
- Motor vehicle accident in the area of Wine Country Road and N River Road. Prosser Officer was involved in the collision and transported to the hospital to be treated for minor injuries. WSP arrived to handle the investigation. The driver of the other vehicle involved was taken into custody on suspicion of DUI.

## May 8 (27 Calls for Service)

- Suspicious person reported in the 1000 block of Meade Ave. Report of a male wearing a green hooding riding a bike up and down the street who appeared to be checking door handles. Officers were unable to locate the described male in the area.
- Request for a welfare check received in the 700 block of Wine Country Road. Loves staff advised of a semi that had been parked in the lot for over three days. Officers checked the truck and it did not appear to have anyone inside. The driver returned as officers were still in the area and advised that the truck had simply broken down.
- Welfare check performed on a male who appeared to be under the influence at EJ Miller Park. Male declined medical assistance and departed the area upon request.
- Civil assist, RP called to advise officers that his soon to be ex-wife threatened to call his truck in as stolen. RP wanted officers to be aware that he is the registered owner and that it is not stolen.
- Officers were advised of a 911 hang up at the library. It was determined that an employee had misdialed and all was okay at the location.
- Theft reported in the 1500 block of Meade Ave. RP went to start his vehicle and discovered the catalytic converter had been stolen.
- Warrant service in the 1400 block of Meade Ave. Report of a suspicious male was received in the area and upon contact, the male was found to have an active warrant and taken into custody.
- Information report in the 900 block of Court Street. RP advised officers that he had located his stolen bike in the area. The RP thought there may be other stolen bikes at the location.

## May 9 (25 Calls for Service)

- Traffic stop in the area of Gap Road and Old Inland Empire Highway. Driver was found to have an active warrant and was taken into custody.
- Suspects involved in a recent shoplifting at Lep-Re-Kon Harvest were quickly identified after request for assistance was made to the public on Facebook. The individuals were charged with Theft 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree and trespassed from the store for one year.
- Officers assisted BCSO with a motor vehicle accident with injuries in the area of County Route 12 and King Tull Road.

## May 10 (10 Calls for Service)

- Phone scam report received in the 600 block of 9<sup>th</sup> Street. RP advised he has been receiving multiple unwanted calls from various numbers. RP stated the caller does not speak and hangs up after about 20 seconds. RP was advised that it did not appear to be criminal in nature and was given information on the steps that he can take including contacting his phone company.
- Animal complaint in the 1900 block of Benson Ave. RP complained of their neighbor's chickens coming onto their property.
- Civil issue in the area of 5<sup>th</sup> Street and Spokane Ave. RP stated that his neighbor is defaming his name by yelling out derogatory remarks in their neighborhood. RP was advised that the issue was civil and was provided with information on how to obtain a no contact order.
- Officers assisted WSP with a single vehicle motor vehicle accident on I82 near exit 80.

## May 11 (10 Calls for Service)

- Agency assist in the 1000 block of Alexander Court. Grandview PD requested assistance in making contact with a registered owner of a vehicle. Officers attempted contact, but no one appeared to be home.
- Traffic stop in the area of Bennett Ave and Fir Street. Driver was found to have a suspended license and cited for DWLS 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree.
- Request for assistance in the 1200 block of Bennett Ave. RP advised her husband who suffers from dementia had wanted off. The male was quickly located in the alleyway.
- Information report at the City Park. RP advised of a group of juveniles walking around saying inappropriate things to each other which made the RP uncomfortable. RP requested officers talk with the juveniles. RP was advised that the activity described did not constitute officer contact. Officer checked the area and did not observe any criminal activity.
- Traffic stop in the area of Wamba Road and Wine Country Road. Driver was taken into custody on suspicion of DUI and booked into the Benton County Jail.
- Suspicious circumstances reported in the 900 block of Anna Street. RP advised a male has shown up to their house multiple times looking for a male that used to live at the location. The area was checked, but officers were not able to locate the suspicious male.
- Officers assisted BCSO with a reported vehicle accident in the area of County Route 12 and Missimer Road. It was determined that no accident had occurred, the driver had just pulled pretty far off the road after experiencing mechanical problems.
