ACTIVITY LOG WEEK OF MAY 8, 2020 TO MAY 14, 2020

MAY 08 (16 calls for service)

- Animal complaint, report of a loose dog in the area of 8th Street and Meade Ave. The Community Service Officer (CSO) was able to locate the person in charge of the dog, who did not know it had gotten loose. A verbal warning was given.
- Found debit card was turned into the police department. Officer was unable to locate contact information for the name listed on the card within local systems. Card will be entered into evidence as found property.
- Barking dog complaint received in the area of Wine Country Road and 8th Street. Officer located a German Shepherd puppy at the location that was barking at people as they walked by.

MAY 09 (21 calls for service)

- Loose dogs reported in the 500 block of New Gate Drive. Reporting Party (RP) complained about a larger dog getting out and harassing her dog. Officer was unable to locate the dogs, information was forwarded to the CSO for follow up.
- Animal complaint received in the 2100 block of Eastgate Court. RP called saying a large German Shepard dog had jumped their neighbor's fence and was roaming the neighborhood. RP was scared to let their kids outside. The owner of the dog was contacted and cited for Dogs at Large.
- Two-vehicle non-injury accident in the area of Anna Street and Evans Ave.
- Suspicious circumstances reported in the 100 block of Columbia Drive. RP called and stated a man had played and talked to her kids a few days ago and she was concerned. RP was advised that if the man came back around to call dispatch immediately so officers could talk with him.
- Reckless traffic complaint received in the area of N Gap Road and I 82. Report of a possible DUI driver. Officers were unable to locate the suspect vehicle.
- Officers responded to a DV assault reported in the 1000 block of Alice Street. Officers contacted a male at the location with visible injuries. The male advised he had exchanged words with another male and it had turned physical. The male admitted to being the primary aggressor. The victim was determined to have already left the location. Male was arrested and booked into the Benton County Jail for Assault 4th DV.
- Report of a low hanging phone line in the 1300 block of Riverside Drive. RP said there was a low hanging old phone line in his driveway. The house did not have any landlines and the hanging line was not connected to anything. The homeowner snipped the line so it was no longer a hazard.
- Reckless traffic complaint received in the area of Memorial Street and Paterson Road. Report of two motorcycles speeding around the area. Officers were unable to locate the motorcycles.
- Officers assisted Benton County Sheriff's Office (BCSO) with a missing child report in the area of W 1407 PR SW. The child was located prior to Officers arrival. Officers verified the child was okay.
- Traffic complaint in the area of Alexander Ct and SR 22, report of one vehicle following another in a suspicious manor. Vehicles were reported to have driven onto SR 221 and the call was transferred to WSP.
- Suspicious activity reported in the area of Alice Street and Evans Ave. Report of juveniles smoking marijuana in the area. Officers were not able to locate the juveniles upon arrival.
- Barking dog complaint in the 100 block of Spruce Ave. The dog owner was contacted and advised they would take care of the issue.
- Officers assisted WSP on I 82 near milepost 81 with a report of debris in the roadway. The "debris" were determined to be the remnants of a very large dog that had been struck by multiple vehicles. Fish and Wildlife responded and removed the remains.
- Noise complaint received in the 1000 block of Sadie Street. RP advised of loud talking. Homeowner was contacted and they advised they would keep it down.

MAY 10 (14 calls for service)

- Harassment complaint received in the 1400 block of Meade Ave. RP called saying she believes her ex-boyfriend could be using a fake Facebook account in an attempt to get in touch with her. RP was given information on how to obtain a no contact order and to call dispatch if any suspicious people come to her residence.
- Call regarding loud music received in the area of 8th Street and Dudley Ave. Officer spoke to a male at a house on 8th street and he turned down his music. No further calls were received.
- Reckless traffic complaint received in the area of PMH. RP stated that a vehicle had crossed over the double yellow lines and was driving recklessly towards the hospital. Officer made contact with driver who stated they were bringing a friend in to the ER. Officer advised the driver on the rules of the road.
- Officers responded to a disturbance in the area of 10th Street and Grant Ave. RP stated that there were two Honda vehicles involved in an accident and they were yelling at each other. Then RP said a male driver was yelling at a female to get back into the car and then they all drove off. Officers checked the area, but could not locate the involved vehicles. No calls came in from anybody stating they were involved in an accident or any other altercation.
- Complaint of loud music in the 900 block of Margaret Street. Officer contacted residents and they agreed to turn down their music.
- Report of a vehicle driving recklessly on Wine Country Road near Exit 82. Officers were unable to locate the vehicle.
- Complaint of a vehicle speeding in the area of Main Street received. Officers made contact with the vehicle owner who advised he was not speeding.

MAY 11 (15 calls for service)

- Theft reported in the 1300 block of Wine Country Road. RP advised his son had stolen rims off his vehicle. RP did not want to file charges, but just wanted to be notified if the rims were recovered.
- Request for a welfare check in the 1400 block of Meade Ave. Female was found to be having a mental breakdown. Her caretaker took her to PMH for evaluation.
- Officers assisted medics in the 200 block of Merlot Drive. RP believed he was having an overdose. Medics arrived and transported the male to PMH.
- Fraud report in the 700 block of Brock Court. RP claimed someone opened an unemployment file in his name. RP's employer and the Unemployment Office was advised of the fraud.
- Theft reported in the 1500 block of Grant Ave. RP advised a blue and black pressure washer had been stolen from their residence.
- Reckless traffic complaint in the area of Concord Way and Market Street. RP advised of a black VW Golf racing another vehicle. Officer was unable to locate the described vehicle.

MAY 12 (9 calls for service)

- Officers contacted four juvenile males in the middle of the night in the area of Meade Ave and 7th Street. Males had been observed wandering around town and alleyways.
- Accident, vehicle vs railroad crossing arm in the area of Lee Road and Max Benitz Road. Semi had struck the crossing arm causing it to break.
- Request for officer assistance in the 1200 block of Quarter Horse Trail. RP called advising their one year old was locked in the bathroom and they requested help with getting the door open. Call was cancelled after RP was able to open the bathroom door.
- Traffic hazard reported in the area of Old Inland Empire Hwy and Wamba Road. RP advised of nearly hitting three people standing in the roadway holding their phones with their flashlights on. Officer was unable to locate the individuals in the roadway.

MAY 13 (17 calls for service)

- Officers responded to a civil issue in the 900 block of Anna Street. RP called in saying someone was on his property that shouldn't be and was refusing to leave. Officers contacted the owner of the property and determined they had given permission to the person to be there. Parties were advised it was a civil situation.
- Citizen assist in the 1200 block of Playfield Ave. RP wanted to know laws about their neighbor having video cameras.

One male agreed to leave and not come back after work so that things could cool down.

- Officer responded to a threats complaint in the 700 block of Market Street. RP had gotten into a verbal argument with two individuals who had been staying with him when RP told them they were not welcome at his house anymore. One of the individuals threatened the RP. Case forwarded to the Prosecutor for review.

- Report of an injured cat received in the 900 block of Margaret Street. Cat was found to be severely injured and had to be euthanized to prevent further suffering.
- Vehicle theft reported in the 300 block of 9th Street. RP advised she had let a friend borrow her vehicle last year and now thought that someone other than her friend was using the vehicle and she wished to report it as stolen. RP was advised that this was a civil issue.
