ACTIVITY LOG

WEEK OF May 12, 2022 to May 18, 2023

May 12 (27 Calls for Service)

- Request for a welfare check received in the area of 7th Street and Meade Ave. Report of a male acting strange and throwing trash on the ground. Officers contacted the male who advised he was okay.
- Reckless traffic complaint in the area of Highland Drive and Alexander Court. Reporting Party (RP) stated she had seen nine vehicles blow through the stop sign. RP was advised extra patrols would be conducted in the area.
- Traffic stop in the area of 6th Street and Dudley Ave. Male arrested on suspicion of driving under the influence of alcohol.
- Welfare check in the 200 block of Canyon Drive. Report received of a possible suicidal subject. Officers made contact with a male who advised that he was not feeling suicidal, would never hurt himself and did not require assistance from law enforcement.
- Civil issue at the Police Department. RP arrived at the PD to advise officers she had attempted to drop off her child with their father for visitation, but that he was not home at the designated time. RP was informed the information would be documented.
- Threats complaint in the 1100 block of Spokane Ave. RP advised their neighbor was making threatening remarks and complained of their cameras pointing into other people's houses.
- Officers responded to a disturbance at the Rest Area. Report of a male who was being disorderly. Officers made contact with the male and he was warned for openly consuming alcohol in public. RP did not wish to press charges for disorderly conduct.

May 13 (19 Calls for Service)

- Reckless traffic complaint in the area of Grant Ave and Wine Country Road. Report of a vehicle swerving and driving over the white line. Officers responded to the area, but were unable to locate the suspect vehicle.
- Trespass report in the 1200 block of Meade Ave. Officer was flagged down by the RP who reported a male had been asked to leave the Princess Theatre after attempting to get into a private event. RP stated they felt intimidated by the male. Officers advised extra patrols would be conducted in the area until the party ended.
- Suspicious circumstances in the 1100 block of Bennett Ave. RP observed a male looking into his vehicle and was concerned his vehicle may be prowled.
- Suspicious circumstances reported in the 1100 block of Meade Ave. Report of a male at Becky's who was asking customer's questions and making them feel uncomfortable. Male was contacted in the area. He was found searching through the trash and was asked to pick up the mess he had made. No crimes were found to have occurred.

May 14 (14 Calls for Service)

- Reckless traffic complaint in the 600 block of Court Street. RP stated four vehicles had been racing in the area. Officers were unable to locate the vehicles.
- Disturbance in the 1100 block of 5th Street. Ongoing issues between neighbors.
- Non-injury, non-reportable accident in the 100 block of Merlot Drive. RP had driven over a curb and lightly damaged the undercarriage of their vehicle.

May 15 (18 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to a disturbance at the Spin Cycle. RP advised that the owner of the business had turned off the machines that the RP was using after his son had tapped the washing machine. The business owner was contacted and he advised the child was banging on one of the machines and when he confronted the father, a verbal argument ensued. Owner of the business requested the RP be trespassed from the location.
- Fraud report taken at NW Farm Supply. RP stated two males had made a purchase for \$9,500 with a check from a closed account. Investigation is ongoing.
- Theft reported in the 1900 block of Elwood Ave. RP advised their catalytic converter had been cut from their vehicle sometime over the weekend.
- Animal complaint received in the 1900 block of Benson Ave. RP advised of an ongoing issue with their neighbor's chickens getting into their garden. CSO made contact with the neighbor who was told to keep the chickens within her property to avoid an animal at large and other zoning violations.
- Disturbance reported at the City Park. RP advised of a male and female yelling at each other in the area. Officer made contact and it was found to be a verbal only argument. The male and female were warned of disorderly conduct. They then left the area without further incident.
- Non-injury, non-reportable collision in the 1100 block of Meade Ave. Officer assisted with exchange of information.

May 16 (18 Calls for Service)

- Assist in the 400 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated they were being threatened through a dating app. RP was advised not to send the suspects any money and to report the incident through the app.
- Shoplifting report received at Lep-Re-Kon. Officer initially received a report of shoplifting with a male leaving the location on foot. It was later determined there was not enough information to prove a theft had been committed. The male was later located walking EB on I-82 and was advised he had been trespassed from the store. At his request, the male was given a courtesy ride to Grandview.
- Animal complaint in the 2000 block of Highland Drive. Report of excessive barking. Owner was contacted and advised of the complaint.
- Assist in the 1500 block of Paterson Road, RP wanted to know if a consensual piercing between students was considered an assault. RP was advised that it was not. Parent of the student also spoke with officers wanting to know what they could do about the situation. Parent was advised to contact the Department of Health if he wished to file a complaint about the unlicensed piercing.

- Request for a welfare check in the 400 block of Anna Street. RP advised he had received a ring notification for his mother's residence and wanted officers to check on her. Officers made contact and everything was found to be okay.
- Narcotics complaint received at Crawford Park. RP advised of individuals possible doing narcotics and using the sinks in the restroom to bathe. The individuals had left the area prior to officer arrival.
- Report received of several juveniles in a physical fight at the City Park. Assault investigation is ongoing.
- Traffic complaint, RP wanted to report a road rage incident that had occurred on I-82 near Granger. RP was told WSP would contact him in reference to the incident.
