ACTIVITY LOG

WEEK OF May 19, 2022 to May 25, 2023

May 19 (24 Calls for Service)

- Suspicious circumstances reported in the 300 block of Merlot Drive. Reporting Party (RP) advised of a female going around the RV park asking guests for money and telling them not to call law enforcement on her because she had warrants. Officer determined the female described had already been taken into custody on the warrant.
- Traffic stop in the area of N Gap Road and I-82. Driver found to have a suspended license and cited for DWLS 1st Degree.
- Suspicious circumstances reported in the 1200 block of Prosser Ave. RP advised of juveniles doing ditching, causing a nuisance.

May 20 (12 Calls for Service)

- Traffic hazard reported in the 300 block of Wine Country Road. RP advised the vehicle counter cables were flapping in the wind. Officer checked the cables and determined they were secure.
- Loitering complaint at the Rest Area. Report of a female walking around asking for money.
- Request for a welfare check received at the Rest Area. Report of a male laying in the grass. Male was contacted and advised he was not in need of assistance.
- Agency assist in the 7000 block of N. Pleasant Drive. RP advised seeing several people in their yard via their ring camera.
- Animal complaint received in the area of Lincoln Grade. RP advised they found a dead dog in the area and it appeared it had been shot. Incident was determined to be outside of the city limits and passed on to the Sheriff's Office for follow up.
- Agency assist, Officers assisted BCSO with a report of shots fired. RP advised of a large party with approximately 200 people in the Paterson area and reported hearing multiple shots fired.

May 21 (12 Calls for Service)

- Assault reported in the 100 block of Columbia Drive. RP advised she had seen her daughter's boyfriend hit her. Officers made contact with a male and female at the location. The female advised officers she and the male had broken up and she was upset, but that no assault had occurred.
- Civil issue reported in the 500 block of Wine Country Road. RP advised officers that she had lent her vehicle to someone that she met through an online app and that the person had not returned her vehicle. RP was advised that the incident was civil and warned against lending her car to someone she doesn't know.
- Agency assist in the area of N Crosby Road. Officers assisted BCSO with a DV assault report.
- Agency assist in the area of N River Road and Missimer Road. Dispatch advised of an iPhone emergency call indicating the possibility of an injury collision. It was determined that the phone owner had left the phone on top of their vehicle and drove off, causing the phone to alert dispatch of an accident, however, no accident had actually occurred.
- Suspicious circumstances reported at Yellow Rose Nursery. RP advised of a white sedan driving around the business late at night on multiple occasions. RP advised the vehicle was just in the area, but departed upon seeing the RP. RP was advised that officers would conduct extra patrols and to call if the vehicle returned.

- Suspicious circumstances reported in the 900 block of Anna Street. RP stated she had seen flashlights near her vehicles. Officers responded to the area, but were unable to locate anyone.
- Narcotics complaint at Starbucks. RP advised of a driver that came through the drive thru who was possibly smoking marijuana. Officer located the vehicle parked in the Chevron parking lot, but did not observe any crimes or detect any odor of marijuana.
- Officers responded to a motor vehicle accident in the area of 7th Street and Wine Country Road.
- Harassment report received in the 900 block of Florence Street. RP advised of unwanted contact from ex's new girlfriend being received on social media. RP was provided with information on how to obtain a no contact order if the problem persists.
- Shoplifting report received at Lep-Re-Kan Harvest Foods. RP advised a male was seen placing unpaid items in his pocket. Officer made contact with a male and female in the parking lot and served them with no trespass orders at the request of the store.

- Agency assist, Grandview PD requested officers assist with a building search in their jurisdiction.
