ACTIVITY LOG

WEEK OF June 02, 2022 to June 08, 2023

June 02 (25 Calls for Service)

- Traffic stop of vehicle with shoplifting suspect. Suspect was arrested for theft. Car was impounded pending search warrant after observing narcotics present.
- Non-injury collision at 6th and Sheridan involving 2 vehicles. Involved parties exchanged information and drove away.
- Theft reported at the 400 block of Wine Country Rd. Investigation ongoing.
- Officers assisted with a fire at the range/hillside.
- Officers responded to a report of two males fighting in the 100 block of Merlot. Officers were unable to locate the males upon arrival.
- Report of animal left in vehicle at the 1300 block of Meade. Officers arrived and found that the owners were in the car with the animal.
- Suspicious person reported in the 900 block of Meade Ave. RP stated that a suspicious male on a bicycle was trying to locate her brother. Officers were unable to locate the male upon arrival. RP was advised to contact officers if he returns.
- Officers responded to the HS for a theft report of the school ATV vehicle. The theft was caught on camera, but the ATV was recovered without damage just off of school property. RP advised that perhaps this was part of a school prank and will handle the incident with school discipline.
- BCSO assist with a firearms complaint at Rainbow Court Cabins. Report of gunshots heard. Neighbor admitted to shooting ground hogs.
- BCSO assist with Domestic Violence complaint at Rainbow Court Cabins. No injuries were found and individuals agreed to remain separated.
- Officers were dispatched to the 600 block of Ellen Avenue for complaints of multiple shots being fired. Upon arrival, officers discovered a residence in the area had been struck multiple times by gunfire. There were no reported injuries. A dark colored sedan that was possibly involved was last seen westbound on Bennett Avenue. Investigation is ongoing.
- Suspicious vehicle reported in the 200 block of Canyon. RP noticed a car parked oddly in the area. Officers checked the vehicle and found it to be someone dropping people off.

June 03 (24 Calls for Service)

- Welfare check for female in the area of 7th and Meade. Female stated that she is enjoying music and refused medical attention.
- WSP, BCSO assist on Hwy 22 with a domestic violence report involving 2 males and one female. The female was arrested for violation of a non-contact order. No injuries reported.

- Officer responded to a weapons complaint at Crawford Park. RP reported that a male was displaying knives and appeared to be on narcotics. Officer found no criminal activity taking place and male was not located.
- Suspicious vehicle reported in the area of Yakima and 6th. RP advised of an unfamiliar black Camaro in the area slow driving by while recording. Officers were unable to locate the vehicle.
- GVPD assist with eluding vehicle in the area of CR12. GVPD lost sight of car near CR12 and King Tull Rd. Vehicle was not located.
- BCSO assist with noise complaint on OIE near Pioneer Rd. Owner was contacted and turned the music down.
- Officer assistance requested at Bern's Tavern. Staff requested removal of large group from the property. Group was verbally uncompliant but eventually left.
- Officer assistance at Bern's Tavern. One member of group previously removed from establishment repeatedly called to complain about the establishment. Officer advised caller the matter was civil.
- Officers managed multiple follow ups concerning 06/02 weapons incident.
- Agency assist on I82 with a report of driver going the wrong way on the freeway. RP stated the vehicle was going eastbound in the westbound lanes. Officer was unable to locate vehicle.
- BCSO assist with reckless driver complaint on Hwy 12. Officer was unable to locate driver.
- Officers responded to a vehicle accident in the Burger King parking lot. The accident was a non-reportable accident. The drivers exchanged information.

June 04 (27 Calls for Service)

- Officer observed an unlicensed motorcycle driving on OIE. Upon seeing the officer, the motorcycle sped away at speeds in excess of 150 mph, eluding the officer. Officer was unable to get close enough to attempt a traffic stop. GVPD was advised.
- Traffic stop conducted in the 300 block area of Wine Country Rd. Driver was found to have a warrant and was arrested and taken to Benton County Jail.
- Offer assist for PPD. While returning from the Benton County Jail, officer was requested for an assist with a stolen vehicle in the I82 /I182 area. Several agencies worked together but were unable to locate the stolen vehicle at that time.
- Officer assistance requested for an intervention. RP stated that she is planning an intervention on her niece. RP was advised that this is a civil matter.
- Multiple reports for a traffic hazard on Gap Rd and Merlot. RPs stated that there is a subject selling items out of a van. The subject is asking for money and running into the intersection to collect money, which is causing hazardous driving conditions. When officers arrived, the vehicle could not be located.
- Officers called to 400 block of North River Road for a disturbance. RP was trying to force niece into rehab. RP was told that she cannot force anyone to go into rehab. RP said she understood and both parties separated.
- Officer responded to a request for assistance on obtaining a restraining order. RP was referred to district court.

- Private property collision at Harvest foods. Vehicle slipped out of park, rolled, and hit a stop sign that was on store property. No injuries reported.
- Welfare check. RP is transient female sleeping in the grass. She was seeking assistance for a place to stay. RP was advised that we cannot help her with a sleeping arrangement but offered to transport her somewhere. RP declined the offer.

June 05 (28 Calls for Service)

- Welfare check at Grant Street Park. RP observed a Chevy Tahoe parked at the bridge with what appeared to be someone slumped over in it. Officers made contact with vehicle. One male and one female were in the vehicle. No crime observed.
- Welfare check on the 1400 block of Wine Country Road for a 5 year old child seen going in to the street and hiding behind a vehicle on the street. RP stated that no adult appeared to be present. Child was in the home with an adult when the officer arrived. Adult stated that child likes to escape the house and that she will try to mitigate his escape in the future.
- Officers responded to a call about individuals burning fires under the bridge. Officers contacted the individuals who said that they would put the fires out.
- Officer responded to a theft call at Love's. RP was getting gas and went inside store, leaving his car unsecured. Upon returning, he noticed that a red and silver van was parked very close to his car. RP stated that his debit card was found to be missing from his car, where it had been unsecured in the cup holder. He then had two unauthorized purchases made on his card. Officer will request camera footage and follow up. Investigation ongoing.
- Officer responded to a report of an uncontrolled fire in the area of Wine Country Road and N. Albro Road. Homeowner at the address was burning debris in a controlled burn. Officer advised that he was creating a smoke hazard and the RP was asked to put it out.
- Traffic complaint at 1100 block of Meade Ave. Pick-up trailer was blocking the drive-thru. Vehicle was gone upon officer arrival.
- BCSO officer assist with contacting an individual about a possible identity theft.
- Suspicious circumstance call to the 900 block of Parkside Drive. RP stated that her daughter found a plastic straw tied to her vehicle door handle. RP was concerned about sex trafficking targeting. Officer advised that as there is no property damage and no crime at this time.
- Officer responded to a 911 hang up that was found to be a medical issue and was transferred to EMS.
- Traffic accident at 1400 block of Sheridan Ave. While attempting to parallel park individual struck another vehicle. Individuals exchanged information. No injuries involved.
- Suspicious activity/person at 300 block of Canyon Drive. RP stated that an unknown male tried to open front door at her residence. When RP questioned him, he stated that he did not know that anyone was at the location. Officer checked apartment bldg. and surrounding area but was unable to locate the male.

- Weapons report on Meade. RP stated that a white Honda Civic with 4 individuals were driving around town brandishing a large gun out the window as well as flashing gang signs. Officer was unable to locate white Honda Civic.
- Complaints of egging near Loves. RP stated that passing subjects threw soda or other substance (eggs) all over his mirrors and windows. No damage to vehicle.
- Complaints of egging for the second time in one night in the 1400 block of Riverside Dr. RP reported seeing the suspected person leaving in a white Chrysler.

June 06 (13 Calls for Service)

- Officer attended a school event at Prosser High School.
- Multiple traffic stops were made with various warnings given.

June 07 (29 Calls for Service)

- BCSO assist for a welfare check of a female along Hwy 22. RP stated that the woman was swinging a stick and picking up items as cars drove by. RP was concerned that she was preparing to throw items at passing cars. Woman did not appear under distress and stated that she was walking to her aunt's house.
- Officer responded to a report of an aggressive dog at Yakima Ave and Court St. Dog's home was located and the information will be passed on to the CSO.
- Officers performed follow up activities concerning weapons incident from June 2nd.
- Officer responded to a report of a threat to a student at the High School. School administration will be managing the threat on their end.
- Officer responded to an Adult Protective Services referral.
- Officers responded to a vehicle vs pedestrian accident at Bennett Ave and 6th Street. Male driving the vehicle was unharmed. Pedestrian who had been riding the scooter was taken to PMH. Investigation in ongoing.
- Officer responded to a welfare check on 6th and Meade. EMS was contacted.
- BCSO assist on Kelandren Dr. with possible assault between resident and people he confronted who were walking on the road. RP advised that people were trespassing on his property.
- Welfare check at City Park. RP stated that she observed a female hanging out of a Jeep Cherokee yelling for help while two male car occupants were laughing. Officer was unable to locate the Jeep Cherokee upon arrival at the park. Following social media posts, it was suggested that it was a false claim.

June 08 (21 Calls for Service)

- Officer escort of the Franklin car club.
- Officer responded to the 400 block of Wine Country Rd, where an RP wanted to report phone threats to his family. It was discovered that threats had actually occurred in Granger.

- Officer responded to a complaint from an RP concerned about the fire hazard on a lot near her home with overgrown weeds, etc. RP was advised that she needs to contact code enforcement.
- Officer assist WSP for a rollover traffic accident on Gibbon Rd. Minor injuries only.
- BCSO officer assist on Johnson for a recovery of stolen items from a Kennewick business.
- Officer responded to a disturbance at the 1200 block of Prosser Ave. RP reported that a female was throwing clothing out of the home into the yard. Officer did not witness or hear anything going on upon arrival.
- Officer responded to a report of a male crying and yelling in the 1200 block of Bennett Ave. Officer observed the male and did not note any unusual behavior. Officer spoke with male and he stated that he was waiting for the bus.
- Officer responded to a disturbance at Meade and 7th St. between two males. RP stated that they have a history from work. He stated that he saw the individual at the convenience store and that the individual became aggressive towards him and threatened to fight him. RP was advised to apply for an NCO at the court house if he did not want him contacting him.
- Officer responded to a possible domestic violence at the 1200 block of Prosser Ave. One party at the address was being asked to move and she was upset. It was found to not be domestic violence.
- Officer responded to a complaint about a barking dog at the 1900 block of Benson. Upon arrival, officer did not find a barking dog.
- Officer responded to a suspicious vehicle driving back and forth at the Yellow Rose Nursery. RP was concerned due to recent thefts. Officer observed vehicle leaving the scene, but not crime was observed or reported. Vehicle did not return.
