ACTIVITY LOG

WEEK OF July 07 to July 13, 2023

June 07 (38 Calls for Service)

- Officer questioned a male at the 200 block of 3rd Street (Crawford Park) after hours. Subject was asked to move along, which he did.
- Officer responded to a report of reckless driving at Gap Road/Wine Country Road. Male driver was taken into custody for Negligent Driving in the 1st degree.
- Officer responded to a report of narcotics at the Prosser Memorial Hospital. RP stated that a male was refusing to allow the hospital to search his bag. RP requested that officer seize and search the bag but RP was reminded of male's 4th amendment rights.
- Officer responded to a disturbance complaint on Merlot Drive. RP stated that a male was upset about not getting money returned on a purchase that was not correct for his needs. Male left after the officer spoke with him.
- Officers responded to a report of a theft at the 1600 block of Patterson Road (Prosser Cemetery). RP stated that a John Deere tractor has been stolen. Investigation is ongoing.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint at the 1200 block of Playfield Avenue. RP stated that they feel that their neighbor has poisoned their cat, and that the same neighbor has a pitbull dog that may have been involved in an incident where the RPs child was bitten.
- Officer responded to an abandoned vehicle at the Market Street Park. RP stated that the abandoned vehicle has been at this location for over 2 weeks. Officer has attempted contact with the owner.
- Officers responded to an animal complaint at the 1600 block of Grant Avenue. RP stated that husband accidentally ran over their chickens and she needed advice on proper disposal of said chickens.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint. RP stated that there is a dog in her yard that is not hers. Dog is large and friendly.
- Officers responded to a complaint at the 1200 block of Playfield Avenue. RP stated that she wanted it documented that there are having issues with neighbors on both sides of their address. One neighbor enters their property without permission and the other is accusing her of killing their cat (see previous entry). RP was advised that their information will be documented and that perhaps she should seek legal assistance.
- Officer responded to a reckless traffic incident at the 900 block of Margaret Street. RP stated that a vehicle had driven past their house after a brief road rage incident. Reported for information only. No crime.
- Officers responded to a complaint of reckless traffic. RP stated that a vehicle was driving all over the road and had ran multiple traffic lights and had made some very near miss collisions. Officer was unable to locate and due to the direction of travel as suggested by the RP, information was passed on to Grandview PD.
- Officers responded to a multi-vehicle accident at Merlot Drive/Wine Country Road. While a car and a semi were stopped at the stop sign, another semi coming up from behind, colliding with the semi, which then collided with the automobile. Driver of the offending semi was taken into custody on suspicion of DUI.
- Officer responded to an information call for Ellen Avenue/Kinney Way. RP stated that they saw a male subject who was jumping the fence into the Riverview play area. Male not located.
- Officers performed multiple traffic stops throughout the day.
- Officers performed follow up activities for multiple ongoing investigations.

July 08 (22 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to a welfare check request at the 1000 block of Colena. A call came in about an accident. No accident had happened. Car owner's cell phone fell from the car roof, which then sent a distress message to 911.
- BCSO officer assist for attempted containment for a wanted subject on Missimer Road. Subject not located.
- Officer responded to a report of an abandoned vehicle at the 700 block of 6th Street. RP stated that there is a vehicle in the parking lot up on jacks with one tire missing. RP is unsure how long vehicle has been parked there. Attempted to contact responsible owner, but no answer. Passed information on to YPD. Officer advised RP that the vehicle can be towed as it is parked on private property.
- Officers responded to a parking violation complaint at the 900 block of Kinney Way (Public Pool). RP stated that there are two vehicles not parked in provided parking spaces that are prohibiting traffic from leaving the parking lot. Blocking vehicle owners were contacted and both vehicles were moved to proper parking spaces.
- Officer responded to a traffic hazard on SR22 and Surrey Lane. A vehicle had pulled off to the side of the road, but had not pulled off enough to be out of the way and was blocking traffic. Driver was told to move, which he did.
- Officer responded to a welfare check at the 100 block of Merlot Drive. RP stated that a male was slumped over in his vehicle, door fully ajar, unresponsive to the RPs yelling. Male was contacted and appeared to be fine. Stated he had been sleeping.
- Officer responded to a report of a disturbance at the 900 block of Kinney Way (Public Pool). RP stated that a man was being verbal with staff. Officer asked him to leave, which he did.
- EMS officer assist at the 700 block of Memorial Street for a female with a medical emergency.
- Officers responded to a business alarm at the 400 block of Wine Country Road. No problem was found. It appears a cat from an earlier event on the property set the alarm off.
- Officers performed follow-up activities for ongoing investigations.
- Officers performed multiple traffic stops throughout the day.

- Officers responded to a domestic violence assault (without injury) report at the 1000 block of Fir Street. Suspect was gone when officers arrived. Both victims declined medical.

- KPD officer assist for a report of theft. Was advised that KPD has an active investigation for the theft.
- BCSO officer assist with a disturbance call on W. Buena Vista. Two males were arguing over a missing dog (one accused the other of taking the dog). BCSO incident.
- Officer responded to the 100 block of Merlot Drive for a report of a trespass. Employee thought that male was still trespassed. Trespass had expired. No crime.
- Officers responded to a narcotics complaint at the 700 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated that a male was smoking a narcotic from a can on the property. Male was trespassed per request of management.
- Officers responded to a report of a hit and run accident at the 700 block of Memorial Street. RP is an employee at the location and her vehicle was hit while she was at work.
- Officer responded to a non-injury traffic accident at the 400 block of Wine Country Road.
- BCSO officer assist for a report of assault at W CR 12 (Rainbow Cabins). BCSO incident.
- BCSO officer assist with a report of suspicious vehicle at the 600 block of Wine Country Road. Vehicle was unoccupied.

- Officer responded to a suspicious circumstance report at the 400 block of Petra. RP stated that a car with 2 males was sitting in the car listening to loud music. Males were contacted and agreed to move along.
- Officers performed follow-up activities for ongoing investigations.
- Officers performed multiple traffic stops throughout the day.

July 10 (28 Calls for Service)

- BCSO Officer assist with a warrant on Missimer Road. Subject not located.
- BCSO officer assist with a report of a stolen vehicle from Benton City. Suspect (and vehicle) were apprehended.
- Officer responded to a complaint of fence graffiti at the 1000 block of Spokane, which was later covered.
- Officer responded to an Adult Protective Service complaint at the 100 block of N. Wamba Road. Investigation ongoing.
- BCSO assist with report of Domestic Violence at the 500 block of Albro. RP stated that a male assaulted his girlfriend. Male fled on foot but after combined efforts of several PDs, subject was taken into custody. Male was the same individual that had a warrant from earlier in the day.
- Officer responded to a parking violation at Eastgate Drive/Highland Drive. Vehicle is unregistered and has been tagged for removal.
- Officers responded to a narcotics complaint at the 100 block of Nunn Road (Airport). RP stated that individuals are using the restroom at the airport for drug use. RP also stated that it is an ongoing issue. This was previously reported by an airport employee who was advised to change the door code.
- EMS officer assist at the 100 block of Columbia Drive for a medical emergency.
- BCSO officer assist on W. North River Road for a report of a domestic disturbance.
- WSP officer assist for a deer vs vehicle collision. No injuries to the driver, but vehicle was not drivable.
- Officers performed follow-up activities for ongoing investigations.
- Officers performed multiple traffic stops throughout the day.

July 11 (37 Calls for Service)

- Officer performed a warrant arrest at Gap/Merlot following a traffic stop. Male was transferred to SSPD custody.
- BCSO officer assist with a report of suspicious persons on W. OIE Hwy. RP stated that were several occupied cars parked at the location for an extended period of time. Additionally, occupants would get out and appeared to be looking for something. Officer was unable to locate anyone upon arrival at the location.
- BCSO assist on Richards Road for a complaint of an individual walking around in the field with a flashlight. Officer was unable to locate the individual, nor see any light from a flashlight.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint at the 600 block of New Gate Drive. One small brown dog and a small poodle type dog, both wearing vests, were running around at the location. A note was left at the home of the responsible owner.
- Officers responded to a report of theft at the 1500 block of Bennett Avenue. RP stated that he observed a male going through the store carrying padlocks, but only purchased candy. Male stated that he put the padlocks back, but upon checking, RP noted that two padlocks were missing from the inventory. RP did not press charges but asked that the individual be trespassed, which he was.

- Officer responded to a traffic hazard complaint at Wine Country Road/7th Street. A vehicle was left at the pump (broken down) and it was blocking the movement of a semi fuel tanker, who was partially blocking road traffic. Vehicle was eventually moved.
- Officer responded to complaints about weeds at the 1300 block of Rohman Drive. RP is concerned that with all of the fires of late, excess weeds may be fire hazard. RO of the lot was contacted about weed maintenance.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint. RP stated that a male pheasant was in her yard near her front door and she desired it to be relocated. Officer captured the pheasant and released it elsewhere.
- Officers responded to a disturbance at the 700 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated that he was backing into a stall when another trucker tried pulling into it stating he was there first. There was a verbal argument that quickly resolved when RP called law enforcement. The RP was able to finish parking. RP was advised to stay clear of the other driver and to call if further problems arose.
- BCSO officer assist for a report of a residential alarm. Everything appeared secure.
- Officers responded to a welfare check request at the 900 block of Brown Street. RP stated that she had not heard from her parents all day which was unusual. Additionally, parents had planned to stop by RPs home and had not done so. Parents arrived at the home while officer was on scene and stated they would call RP.
- Officers performed follow-up activities for ongoing investigations.
- Officers performed multiple traffic stops throughout the day.

- Officers performed a warrant arrest during a traffic stop on Wine Country Road. Additionally, a passenger in the vehicle was arrested for identify theft.
