## ACTIVITY LOG WEEK OF JULY 10, 2020 TO JULY 16, 2020

### **JULY 10** (23 calls for service)

- Officers assisted BCSO with a reported theft in the area of W Buena Vista Road. Report of a stolen Polaris Razor ATV. Reporting Party (RP) advised their husband was chasing the suspects and had found the ATV ditched near North River Road. Shortly after, another call was received in the area of Rundle Road for a report of an attempted vehicle theft.
- Officers assisted SSPD with a vehicle pursuit that came into Prosser, then back into Yakima County on SR-22.
- Report of a large crowd of people at Housel Middle School. Officers contacted a group of juvenile's who advised they had just finished playing a game called fugitive and were on their way home.

### **JULY 11** (15 calls for service)

- Suspicious circumstances reported in the area of Wine Country Road and Witkopf Loop. Report of a vehicle with heavy damage that had been abandoned in a field. The vehicle owner was contacted and advised they had lost control, had driven through a barbed wire fence and over some boulders the night prior. No injuries were reported and no permanent damage was found to the private property. The property owner was contacted.
- Theft reported in the 300 block of Merlot Drive. Officer was informed that two bicycles had been stolen. It was also reported that a fence had been cut and there appeared to be tire tracks leading away from the location.
- Young child found alone and crying, wandering around in a diaper in the 100 block of Columbia Drive. The child's parents were located, the father said the child was supposed to be home with the mother. The mother stated she did not see the child leave. Both parents were warned about the dangers of not paying attention to their child and to look at child proofing their doors.
- Disturbance report received in the 1000 block of Anna Street. RP advised of an argument that occurred one month prior involving her neighbors. RP was upset because the neighbors allow their kids to play basketball in the street and their ball goes into her yard causing damage. RP said any time she attempts to talk to the neighbors it turns into an argument. RP was told to call the PD when the problem is occurring and to take pictures of any damage the neighbors are causing to be pursued in civil court.
- Suspicious vehicle reported in the 900 block of Anna Street. RP stated it looked as if someone was trying to hide the vehicle as it was parked next to their garage where it couldn't be easily seen. Officers checked on the vehicle, which did not return as stolen. The registered owner was contacted and stated he had allowed a friend to use the vehicle and that it was not stolen.
- Traffic stop in the area of Old Inland Empire Hwy and Wine Country Road. Officer observed a vehicle driving without the headlights on. Upon contact, the officer immediately detected a strong odor of intoxicants coming from the vehicle. After field sobriety tests were conducted, the driver was taken into custody and booked into the Benton County Jail for DUI.

### **JULY 12** (11 calls for service)

- Officers assisted BCSO on CR-12 west of Missimer for a report of a recovered stolen vehicle. The vehicle was confirmed stolen out of Grandview.
- Civil issue in the 800 block of Ellen Ave. RP had questions about changing the locks to their residence. RP advised she was going through a divorce and her husband was taking items that were under dispute and she was worried about him taking more items. RP was advised it was a civil situation.
- Officers assisted BCSO in the 7600 block of SW Hamilton Road with a stolen vehicle report.
- Verbal dispute reported in the 800 block of Market Street. RP advised there were issues over child custody and that her granddaughter did not want to leave with her mother. Granddaughter was told she had no choice. Mother and daughter left without incident.
- Report of a possible disturbance within a vehicle at the Rest Area. Officer contacted three occupants in the vehicle and all stated everything was fine, they were just being loud because their radio wasn't working. Parties were advised to tone it down.

## **JULY 13** (20 calls for service)

- Fraud report received at McDonalds. Employee advised a male had gone through the drive thru and attempted to pay with a fake \$50.00 bill. The male left without getting his food or change.
- A citizen found a counterfeit \$50.00 on the ground near the Cottage Court Market and turned it in. The bill was placed into evidence.
- Noise complaint received, caller who lives in Grandview was not happy with GVPD and wished to speak with a Prosser officer. RP advised her neighbor has a loud radio playing all day and she is tired of it. RP was advised to call code enforcement or the Grandview Police Chief.
- Request for a welfare check near the bus stop on 7<sup>th</sup> Street. Report of a male lying down. Officer contacted the male who was just waiting for the Transit bus to arrive.
- Warrant arrest in the 400 block of Wine Country Road. Male taken into custody on a DOC warrant.
- Suspicious activity reported in the 1400 block of Dudley Ave. RP advised of a vehicle parked in front of their house. Officer contacted a male and female in the vehicle. The female advised she was dropping the male off at the location where his vehicle was parked after getting dinner. No issues were found.

## **JULY 14** (21 calls for service)

- Suspicious circumstances reported at the Rest Area. Report of a male asleep under a sink in the male restroom. Officer made contact with a transient male who advised he was sick, but refused medical assistance. The male moved along.
- Welfare check near Verizon, report of an elderly male who seemed to be confused and did not know how to park his vehicle. The male agreed to be transported home by an officer.
- Theft reported in the 700 block of Ellen Ave. RP stated a wood carved bear was taken from his porch. The bear was described to be between 3.5 and 4 feet tall and holding a round welcome sign.
- Threats complaint reported in the 400 block of Petra Ave. RP stated that she had received an unsigned letter saying that someone wanted to punch her teeth out.
- Assist, RP wanted to report a theft of a firearm. It was determined the theft likely occurred in Kittitas County. The RP was referred to Kittitas County Dispatch.
- Suspicious circumstances reported at the City Park. RP advised a garbage can was on fire and advised he saw three females and a male running from the park at about the time the fire started. Officer was able to put out what was left of the fire.

## **JULY 15** (15 calls for service)

- Suspicious person reported in the 800 block of Ellen Ave. RP advised her sister's ex-boyfriend attempted to open her door. Area was checked, but officers were not able to locate the male. RP was advised to seek a protection order.
- Welfare check at the Rest Area. Report of two young children walking around unattended. No problems were found, mother was using the bathroom and had sent the kids out to grandpa, who had already returned to their truck.
- Fraud reported at McDonalds. RP received a counterfeit \$50 through the drive thru. Officer made contact with the individuals attempting to pay for their order. They advised they had used cash and received change at various locations within Tri-Cities and had no idea the bill was counterfeit or where they received it from.
- Theft reported at Desert Valley Powersports. RP advised a subwoofer had been stolen out of a boat.
- Verbal disturbance reported in the alleyway near 6<sup>th</sup> Street and Yakima Ave. RP stated they could hear a female screaming. Officer made contact with a male in the area who stated he had gotten into a screaming match with a female over her not being able to find her phone and that the female had left the location heading to Grandview.
- Theft reported in the 900 block of Anna Street. RP advised a statue had been stolen from his porch. The statue was described as a girl holding flowers.

## **JULY 16** (16 calls for service)

- Vehicle prowling reported in the 500 block of Cascade Ct. RP advised an unknown male was looking into a parked vehicle and when he approached the male, he left the area quickly in a black SUV. Male was described as wearing a black hood, approximately 5'10 inches and 250 lbs.
- Civil dispute in the 600 block of Wine Country Road. RP advised he was allowed to stay at a house, but had been kicked out and needed to retrieve his belongings. RP was told to call PD if he had any issues.

- Burglary reported in the 600 block of Court Street. RP found the lock had been cut from his garage and that multiple items had been taken sometime during the evening.
- Request for a civil standby in the 1400 block of Grant Ave. RP requested officers assist while she picked up a vehicle located at the residence. RP was told officers do not do civil standbys and was advised to call 911 if it became confrontational.
- Verbal disturbance reported in the 900 block of Alexander Ct. Officers made contact with multiple individuals who stated they had not been physical, but that they were having an argument over a vehicle. Parties were advised to stay separated and try to have a conversation at a later date.
