ACTIVITY LOG

WEEK OF July 14 to July 20, 2023

July 14 (31 Calls for Service)

- Officers assisted with a report of a burglary at the 700 block of 6th Street. RP stated that she thought someone was trying to get into the building, when in reality it was an officer who was patrolling the area making sure that the building was secure.
- BCSO officer assist for a search warrant on OIE.
- Officer responded to a parking violation at the 2100 block of Eastgate Ct. Vehicle was tagged for violation.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint at the Prosser Animal Hospital. RP stated that a customer brought in a dog they had found. Customer was gone when officer arrived.
- Officer responded to an abandoned vehicle at the 300 block of Casi Court. Vehicle was tagged for violation.
- Officers responded to a report of theft at the 1000 block of Anna Street. RP stated that she had two older lawn mowers that were stolen. Investigation ongoing.
- Officer responded to a CPS complaint. Officer contacted RP who stated that the incident did not happen in Prosser.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint at the 1100 block of Meade Avenue. RP stated that truck had been parked in the sun with a large black dog in the back of the truck for at least 2 hours. RP was concerned for the welfare of the dog. Officer tested the truck bed with an infrared thermometer and it registered at 157 degrees. Owner of truck was notified and warned of the dangers of leaving an animal in the bed of the truck in this heat. The responsible owner stated that he will go home.
- Officers responded to a report of a suspicious circumstance at the 200 block of Merlot Drive. RP stated that there is an employee vehicle outside, the lights in the business are on, but the door is locked. RP was concerned about the employee. Officers found that the employee was taking a break at the time.
- Officers responded to a concern at the Prosser City Park. RP wanted to know if it was legal for a juvenile to be playing golf in the park, as one who was playing golf in the park almost hit his dog. Officers advised that there is no law against juveniles playing golf in the park.

July 15 (33 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to a report of reckless traffic at Ellen and Market. RP stated that vehicle was speeding. Officers were unable to locate the vehicle.
- Officers responded to a domestic disturbance (no assault) on W Johnson Rd. RP stated that his son had been drinking and was acting up. Officers noted that no crime had taken place and advised individuals to stay away from each other for the night.
- Officers responded to a report of a suspicious circumstance at the 600 block of Ellen. RP stated that a male tried to contact a female on the 700 block of Ellen to no avail. He then went to the 600 block of Ellen and knocked on a door to see if the resident knew if the female he was trying to contact did in fact live at the 600 block address (this was just after 1 am). He then went into his vehicle and stayed there. Officers contacted the male who appeared to be intoxicated and offered him a ride to a local motel, which he refused. He was advised not to drive.

- Officers responded to a traffic hazard on W OIE. Two cows were in the roadway. The owner had returned cows to field before officers arrived.
- Officers responded to a report of a hit and run accident at the 300 block of Casi Court. RP stated that their parked vehicle was hit by another car and that they knew who was responsible. RP did not want to press charges, but wanted to have the individual return to exchange insurance information. Officers advised individuals to call and complete collision information upon return of the other vehicle.
- Officers performed a warrant arrest during a traffic stop at Gap Rd/Merlot. Driver was taken into custody and transported to Franklin County.
- BCSO officer assist for a residential alarm on Wamba Road. Officers checked the residence and found it to be secure.
- Officers responded to a report of an alarm at NW Farm Supply. An employee showed up and the officers were requested to check the interior of the building. Plastic wrapping was seen flapping around which likely caused the alarm to go off.
- Officers performed patrols at PHS for a Benton REA event.
- Officers responded to a report of a vehicle prowler at the 900 block of Burgandy. RP stated that she saw 10-13 year old juveniles shining lights into vehicles. One vehicle was found to have been entered, but the owner did not want to press charges.
- Officers responded to a report of a runaway. Child later returned home.

July 16 (28 Calls for Service)

- BCSO officer assist on W Buena Vista Road/S Steele Rd. for a report of a man walking down the middle of the road.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint at the 1300 block of Grant. Officer tried to return dog to yard with no luck.
- BCSO officers assist for a suspicious circumstance at the 7400 block of Wilgus Road. RP stated that an unknown male was standing in the road in front of his property acting angry and throwing things. RP had planned to leave his property but noticed the male acting strangely and did not want to leave until resolved. The male advised that he was merely out for a walk.
- Officer responded to an informational call about an incident on the 700 block of 6th Street. RP stated that he was out riding his electric bicycle down the center of his lane of travel when a vehicle honked, revved their engine, and accelerated towards him. Vehicle was no longer near the RP when he called.
- Officers responded to a two-vehicle non-injury accident at Chardonnay Ave and Wine Country Rd. Both parties exchanged information and left the location.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint at the 400 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated that she had received a complaint of an animal left in a hot car. Officers did not find any animals in any car present at the location.
- BCSO officer assist with a report of a male walking with a cane in the middle of the roadway on OIE Hwy and N Hinzerling Rd. The male was contacted, given a vitamin water, and a courtesy ride to Loves.
- BCSO officer assist with a home alarm on Wamba Rd. Officers checked residence and found it secure.
- Officers responded to a report of a suspicious circumstance at the 1300 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated that an old retired police car that had been spray painted black had red and blue lights going off as it headed to the freeway. Officers were unable to locate vehicle.
- Officers responded to a report of suspicious circumstances at the 1200 block of Meade Ave. RP stated that they had stopped to do some shopping but had set the alarm off when she attempted to enter the unlocked door. It appears that the closing employee had set the alarm but had not secured the building. Employee showed up a few minutes later and completed securing the store.

- Officers performed follow-up activities on current incidents.
- Officers performed multiple traffic stops.

July 17 (39 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to a 3 vehicle, non-injury accident at Paterson and Claire. A white Chevy 2500 hit a trailer, which in turn caused the trailer to hit a tan Chevy 2500. One driver was cited. All parties exchanged information.
- Officers responded to a report of a theft at the 1400 block of Scenic Drive. RP stated that the catalytic converter was stolen off of his vehicle. Investigation is ongoing.
- Officers responded to a destruction of property complaint at the Prosser Post Office. RP stated that one of the USPS vehicles had been damaged at some point during the night. It appears that the right side door window was heavily cracked/damaged. Investigation ongoing.
- Officer responded to a report of a theft at the 300 block of Merlot Dr. RP stated that a circular saw and an impact wrench were stolen sometime between 06/13 and 07/12. Investigation is ongoing.
- Court officer assist with serving papers.
- Officers responded to a complaint of a trespasser at the 200 block of 10th Street. RP had video of a male entering her property and taking cuttings from her plants. Officer located and spoke with male who stated he thought that the cuttings were a weed tree. RP declined pressing charges.
- Officers responded to a request for a welfare check at the 200 block of Ladera Street. RP was not able to contact his son at the residence. Officer found son to be fine.
- Officers responded to a request for a welfare check at the 1300 block of Wine Country Road. RP heard multiple males yelling and swearing at each other. Officer was unable to locate males.
- Officers responded to a report of a disturbance at the 1400 block of Sheridan (Prosser Family Fitness). RP stated that a male who has been trespassed by the company has been yelling and threatening people at the location. Officers were unable to locate the yelling male, but advised RP to call again if he returns.

- Officer responded to an animal complaint at the 1200 block of Riverside Drive. RP stated that there was a loose pit bull dog. With the assistance of social media, the dog was returned to its owner.
- YSO officer assist with locating a hit and run vehicle. Officer was unable to locate the vehicle.
- Officer responded to a request for a trespass order at the 200 block of Ladera. RP stated that via camera he saw several unwelcome males entering his home (with his son). He requested they be trespassed.
- Officer responded to an information call from the 400 block of Wine Country Road. A dog owner (who lives in West Richland) was not returning to fulfill their dog's medical needs. Information was passed on to a West Richland officer.
- Officer responded to additional complaints about the trespassed person at Prosser Family Fitness.
- Officer responded to a report of loitering at the 1800 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated that a female has been sleeping in her car, on the property, since previous day and the RP would like her to leave the location. The female was contacted, stated that she is having mechanical issues with her vehicle. She was advised that she needed to be moving along. The property owner was advised that they could have the vehicle towed and the female was advised that this may occur.

- Officers responded to a noise complaint at the 1900 block of Benson Ave. RP stated that there is an ongoing problem of animals barking in the area. Officers were unable to locate any barking dogs upon arrival. RP was advised to contact PD when the barking is taking place again.
- Officers responded to a disturbance complaint at Cottage Court Market. RP stated that a male is being verbal with customers and an employee. Officers were unable to locate male upon arrival.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint at the 1300 block of Grant Ave. RP stated that she has a German Shepherd/Chow Mix dog in her gate. It was a loose dog and she was concerned for its welfare in the heat so she brought it into her yard. Officers advised her to contact the animal control officer in the am.
- Officers responded to a civil complaint at the 900 block of Anna Street. RP stated that she had kicked out a known male in March. However, the male was unlawfully removed from the residence and still had items at the resident. RP was advised that this is a civil issue and that they would have to go through an eviction process.

- Officers responded to a report of weapons at the 100 block of Columbia. RP heard possible gunshots. Officers were unable to locate any gunshots.

- Officers found an unsecured door while performing building checks at the 2100 block of Wine Country Road. Building was checked and cleared. Officer secured the door.
- Officers found an unsecured building at the 200 block of Port Avenue. Officers performed a building search, secured the building and left a voicemail for the owner.
- Officers responded to a 911 hang up from the 700 block of Wine Country Road. Officers contacted an employee at location. Call was an accidental dial.
- Officer responded to a suspicious circumstance report at the 600 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated a male had been wandering around the area for several days, asking weird questions of the employees and talking to customers. RP would like the individual trespassed. Officer was unable to locate the male upon arrival but advised RP to ask him to leave if he shows up again and to contact PD to have him trespassed.
- Officers responded to a welfare check request at the 100 block of Merlot. RP stated that at least one individual was slumped over in a convertible vehicle at the location. Upon arrival, a female passenger was taken into custody for multiple warrants. Female was later transported to PMH for medical treatment and was later transported to BCSO Jail.
- Officers responded to a request for a welfare check at 6th and Bennett. RP stated that they heard a teenager screaming for help and an older male screaming before that. Officers were unable to locate individuals in the area.
- Officers responded to a male causing a disturbance in the waiting room of PMH. Officers assisted security with contacting him. He apologized and calmed down.
- Officers responded to a request for a welfare check at the 800 block of 6th Street. Officers knocked on the door to no avail. Officers then contacted home owner who confirmed that she is fine.
