ACTIVITY LOG

WEEK OF July 28 to August 3, 2023

July 28 (34 Calls for Service)

- BCSO/WSP officer assist with a traffic accident resulting in an injury.
- Officer responded to a traffic hazard at the 100 block of Merlot Drive. A semi with trailer decided to use the center turn lane as a parking spot while getting Starbucks. He was moved along.
- Officer responded to a complaint at the 600 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated that a hotdog vendor was blocking the pathway. Officer checked and it was not blocking the pathway.
- Officer assist for a request for information at the 900 block of Myrtle Street. RP wanted information on helping her relative get assistance for drug abuse.
- YSO officer assist for a vehicle location request. Officer was unable to make contact with the owner of the vehicle.
- Officers responded to a request for assistance at the 300 block of OIE. RP stated that she had locked her keys and phone in her car and requested officers assist with opening her vehicle. Officer advised RP that he is unable to conduct entry for lockouts.
- Officer responded to a report of an alarm at the 700 block of 6th Street. RP thought the business was open (as the door was unlocked), and upon entering the facility, set the alarm off. The owners were contacted.
- Officers responded to a report of a theft at the 1900 block of Benson Avenue. RP stated that some items on his carport had been stolen by someone in a red Cobalt. RP will share the videos of the theft with the officer. Investigation ongoing.
- EMS officer assist with a medical emergency on W CR 12.
- Officers responded to a report of lost property at the 300 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated that they had lost a black case containing a bb gun.
- Officers responded to a non-assault domestic disturbance at the 300 block of Casi Court. RP and spouse had a verbal disagreement. No crime was committed and the couple were advised to stay apart for the night.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

July 29 (25 Calls for Service)

- BCSO officer assist with a report of suspicious circumstances on King Tull Road. Officers checked location and did not find anything suspicious upon arrival.
- Officers responded to a two vehicle traffic accident with injury at Merlot Drive and Wine Country Road.

- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

July 30 (31 Calls for Service)

- Officers located an open business door at the 2000 block of Lee Road. Officers secured the building.
- Officers responded to a suspicious circumstance at the 1200 block of Meade Avenue. RP stated that a suspicious male was sticking his head in the drive-thru window, as well as pacing in front of the business. No crime was committed at that time.
- Officers responded to a request for a welfare check. RP stated that a male had been sitting at the same picnic table for 5 hours, arguing with himself. Officers spoke to the male and he was fine.
- BCSO Officer assist with a 2 vehicle, non-injury accident at McCreadie Road/N. Gap Rd.
- BCSO Officer assist with a domestic assault on West Johnson Rd.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint at Alice St/Evans Avenue. RP stated that there is a dog that has been wandering around for quite a while and seems very hot. Information forwarded to the CSO.
- Officer responded to an information report. RP stated that she had possibly seen the vehicle involved in the theft report that was made concerning the red Cobalt. Officers were unable to locate the vehicle upon arrival.
- GPD officer assist with an attempt to locate a suspect for a domestic violence case. No arrest was made.

- Officers responded to a report of a suspicious circumstance on Wamba Road/Port Avenue. RP stated that there was a vehicle parked on Wamba Road and they thought they had seen a person

coming out from the weeded area. Due to the thefts at the business, the RP was concerned about the individuals being in that area. Officers checked area but were unable to locate anyone.

- Officer responded to a report of a suspicious circumstance at the 200 block of 3rd Street. RP stated that an individual was acting suspicious. Officer made contact with the subject. No crime.
- Officer responded to a complaint of a Phone Nuisance/Scam. RP stated that when they called an insurance agency, they took his information and then hung up. When he called the number back, RP stated that they claimed not to have talked to him. Individual disconnected the phone call from the officer.
- Officers responded to a report of forgery at the 700 block of Memorial Street. RP stated that they had issued a check to an individual and they had not received it. Another person, unknown by the RP had cashed the check. Investigation is ongoing.
- WBFR officer assist for a structure fire at the 700 block of Wine Country Road.
- WBFR officer assist with a flooding event for a residential structure at the 300 block of OIE.
- Officers responded to a non-assault domestic disturbance at the PD. A mother and son were having a heated verbal disagreement. The son agreed to leave the residence.
- Officers responded to a report of a vehicle taken without permission at the 600 block of New Gate Drive. RP stated that her son took her car without permission. Son was contacted and returned the car. No crime.
- Officers responded to an information report at the 700 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated that a woman was walking back and forth between the gas pumps (not getting gas) and appeared to be on narcotics. She was checked and found to be ok.
- Officers responded to an information report at the 1100 block of Sherman Avenue. RP stated that a transient person was wandering around the area and the RP is suspicious that they are looking for things to steal. No crime at this time.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint at the 100 block of SR 22. Officer found a dog, who was scanned for a microchip. The owner was located and the dog was returned to them.
- Officers present at National Night Out at the Prosser City Park.
- GPD/BCSO officer assist with a kidnapping suspect out of Grandview (suspect was detained in Prosser).
- Officers responded to a report of a theft at the 200 block of Gap Road. RP stated that he believes that his wallet was stolen possibly from the Club 24 location, but admits that was the last place he remembered having it. RP was advised to work with Club 24 to see if there is video footage of the theft.
- Officers responded to a request for a welfare check at the 700 block of Memorial Street (PMH). RP stated that security requested the call to PD for a male in a van who was yelling at the security officer and causing a scene. The male was contacted and stated that he just wanted to be seen in the ER. All parties agreed that he could be seen and he advised he would not cause any problems.
- Officers responded to an alarm at the 3000 block of Wittkopf Loop Rd. All was clear.
- Officers responded to a report of a disturbance at PMH. A male was observed being aggressive, being verbal with employees, and swinging a pole around. Male spoke with officers and stated that he was reciting Shakespeare while waving his wand around. RPs requested male be moved along. Male stated that he would have someone come and get him.
- Officers responded to another report of the (same) male at PMH. RP stated that the male had not left earlier and is now refusing to leave. After officers advised the male that he needs to move along, he got into his vehicle and left.
- Officers responded to a vehicle parked at the 200 block of 3rd Street. Occupants were advised to move along as the park was closed.

- Officers responded to another alarm at the 3000 block of Wittkopf Loop Rd. All was clear.

RP was concerned about the individual driving. Officer contacted the individual and found that he was legally parked in the parking lot and did not appear to be in distress. No crime.

Officers were able to discern that the break appears to have been caused by a stray rock. RP stated that they had landscapers working in the yard that morning.

- Officers responded to a report of narcotics at the 200 block of 3rd Street. RP stated they witnessed a male smoking drugs in the park. Male admitted to activity and was trespassed from the park.
- BCSO officer assist with a report of lewd conduct at the Rainbow cabins.
- Officer responded to a report of a theft at the 1400 block of Meade Avenue. RP stated that his bike was stolen from in front of his residence between 7:45 am and 5:00pm.
- Officers responded to a report of property found at Bennett Avenue and Larch Street. RP stated that a bike was left in his yard that appears to have been painted (this is not the bike stolen in an earlier incident).
- Officer responded to a request for a welfare check at OIE and Wine Country Road. RP stated that there is an individual walking along the road, limping. Officers contacted the walking individual who stated that her foot hurt, but that she did not need assistance.
- Officers responded to a request for a welfare check at the 1800 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated that a male had been sitting in his vehicle at the location in excess of 4 hours. The RP had knocked on the window of the vehicle and had shone a flashlight into the vehicle but received no response. A medical unit checked the male and he appeared fine. He stated he was sleeping.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

- Officers responded to a report of fireworks at Yakima Avenue and 6th Street. RP stated that fireworks were being set off in the location. Officers were unable to locate persons or fireworks.

- Officers served a warrant on Merlot Drive, detaining the individual.
