Week of August 04 to August 10, 2023

August 04 (38 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to a report of a disturbance at the 300 block of Casi Court. RP stated that her sister and her sister's ex are having an altercation. Primary aggressor not ascertained. Involved parties were separated via a courtesy transport.
- Court officer assist with serving papers.
- Officers responded to a report of theft at the 1300 block of Stacy Avenue. RP stated that after repairs were made to a customer's vehicle, the customer decided to take his vehicle without paying for the services, resulting in a theft of services. Investigation is ongoing.
