## ACTIVITY LOG WEEK OF AUGUST 07, 2020 TO AUGUST 13, 2020

### AUGUST 07 (22 calls for service)

- Warrant service in the 1100 block of Sherman Ave. Adult female was taken into custody and booked into the Benton County Jail.
- Suspicious male at the PD. Male tried to get into the secured area and then used the non-emergency phone as well as the 911 emergency only call box to call Dispatch several times stating he wanted to recover a machete from evidence. Male then left the PD and went across the street. Shortly after, a call came in of a suspicious male watering the railroad tracks saying he was watering his garden. Male was gone before officers arrived in the area.
- Report of trespassers at the High School construction site. Officer made contact with two juvenile males in the cemetery who matched the description given by the Reporting Party (RP). The males stated they did stop to look at the school, but that they were on the outside of the fence.
- 911 hang up received from the Holiday Inn. Upon call back, employee stated there were 6 men who were verbal over a fee and who were refusing to leave. Males were gone upon officer arrival.
- Traffic stop in the area of 10th Street and Grant Ave. Adult female was issued a citation for DWLS 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree. Charges for Possession of Meth were forwarded to the Prosecutor's Office.

### AUGUST 08 (13 calls for service)

- Disturbance reported in the 1000 block of Sadie Street. RP stated that her 18-year-old son was yelling at her and she wanted him to leave. Officers arrived and spoke with both parties involved, they advised it was verbal only and agreed to stay separated for the night.
- Barking dog complaint received in the 1100 block of 6th Street. RP advised the dog was tied up outside and had been barking since 5 am. Officer parked in the area and observed the dog for several minutes, the dog barked once at the officer and the owner eventually came outside and brought the dog in. Officer made contact with the owner and advised him of the complaint. The owner denied that the dog had been outside for very long.
- Officers assisted BCSO in the 800 block of Higdon Road. Adult male was taken into custody for Taking a Motor Vehicle without Permission. During transport, the male began slamming his head into the partition and had to be taken to PMH for medical clearance.
- Theft reported in the 1200 block of Playfield Ave. RP stated his neighbor had stolen some lumber from his property. The "lumber" turned out to be a stick, which the neighbor returned. Determined to be related to ongoing civil issues between neighbors.
- Officers responded to a verbal DV in the 800 block of Alexander Ct. It was determined that a female was upset because she caught her boyfriend cheating and because he was leaving. Officers confirmed that no assault had occurred. The male gathered his belongings and left.

### AUGUST 09 (13 calls for service)

- Officers assisted WBFR in the 1000 block of Anna Street with a tree that had fallen down onto two vehicles as well as knocking out the power. PUD was dispatched to the location.
- Noise complaint received in the 600 block of Guernsey Street. Report of loud construction going on. Officer found that a roof was being replaced in the area. It was determined not to be in violation of the City noise ordinance.
- Medical assist for breathing difficulty at Loves.
- Disturbance reported in the area of Wine Country Road and Mercer Ct. Report of a male and female who were yelling and throwing items into the road. Parties were gone at time of officer arrival and no disturbance was located.
- Suspicious circumstances reported in the area of Old Inland Empire Hwy. Report of a possible disturbance received. Upon contact, it was found that several individuals were just filming a mini-series.
- Suspicious circumstances reported in the 1500 block of Grant Ave. RP stated someone had taken off the lug nuts to her husband's vehicle earlier in the day. RP was concerned because there was an unknown truck parked in front of their residence. Officer determined that the truck owner was fishing in the area.

Officer made contact with a female pedestrian walking in the dark on SR-22 near milepost 35. The female stated she had been in a verbal disturbance with her now ex-boyfriend and he left her on the side of the road. Female was provided a courtesy transport to her mother's house on Ellen Ave.

## **AUGUST 10** (37 calls for service)

- Suspicious person reported at Les Schwab. RP stated a male was hiding near the wood fence and was seen looking at the tires. Officers located the male and he attempted to hide from them by lying in the bushes. The male was talking to people that were not there and asked Officers if they had heard about, "the guy being put through a grinder near the fire station." The male was acting strange, but Officers did not locate signs of any criminal activity. The male left the area stating he was heading to a friend's house.
- Officers assisted a stranded motorist in the 900 block of Sheridan Ave whose vehicle had broken down in the middle of the street. The female driver was trying to push it out of the road. Officers assisted in getting it as far off the road as possible and advised the female that she needed to have it removed in the morning.
- Request for a welfare check received at the Rest Area. Report of a male lying face down on the bathroom floor. Officers made contact with the transient male who was sleeping, the male left the location.
- Officers responded to a non-injury motor vehicle accident in the 1000 block of Sadie Street.
- Unemployment fraud reported in the 1300 block of Desert Cove. RP stated they received a benefit debit card from the State of Colorado. RP was advised to monitor his accounts and credit for any suspicious activity.
- Suspicious activity at the PD, male came into the lobby, was upset and yelling at the Dispatcher and the DOC officer about forms he needed to contact the CIA to make a complaint about the government. The male was very agitated and confrontational and did not want to speak with officers. Male left the location and continued to walk in circles around downtown.
- Fraud report in the 500 block of Cascade Court. RP advised he had two fraudulent charges on his debit card for purchases from Adidas. RP was told to cancel his debit card.
- Verbal disturbance reported in the 1100 block of Prosser Ave. RP advised his neighbor was drinking again and being loud and calling him and his friend names. It was determined that no threats had been made. RP was told he could try to obtain an anti-harassment order through District Court if he wished.
- Officers responded to a disturbance in the 1800 block of Benson Ave. It was determined that an argument and assault had occurred over an inheritance check. The female victim had been assaulted by her sister and threatened by a male companion of her sister. Adult female was arrested and booked for Assault 4<sup>th</sup> Degree and Possession of Meth. Adult male was arrested and booked for Felony Harassment.
- Suspicious circumstances reported in the 400 block of Wine Country Road. Dispatch advised of a male RP who was stating that there were people outside of his hotel room who were flashing lights into his room. Officers contacted the RP, but did not locate any suspicious activity outside of his room. Officers were dispatched to a disturbance call and while dealing with a standoff situation the RP called 911 40 separate times to report the same suspicious activity. The RP was contacted again and taken into custody for Harassment due to him calling 911 over 40 times without having an emergency.
- Disturbance reported in the 1100 block of Prosser Ave. RP stated his neighbor was on his front porch yelling and causing a disturbance. Several other calls had come in throughout the evening involving the same subject regarding his strange behavior. When Officers arrived at the location, the male made various threats and after a brief standoff, the male was taken into custody and booked for Felony Harassment.

## **AUGUST 11** (19 calls for service)

- Suspicious circumstances reported in the 19 block of Merlot Drive. RP thought he was witnessing a drug deal. Officers arrived and contacted two males in the area. The males admitted to smoking weed. Officers reminded them that they cannot smoke weed in public, no other activity was observed.
- Theft reported at the High School construction site. RP said that someone had broken into his company tool box overnight and stole several items.
- Reckless traffic complaint received in the area of Market Street and Ellen Ave. RP said an older male was driving and was all over the road. By the time Officers arrived, the vehicle was parked in its driveway and unoccupied.
- Report of three gunshots heard in the 1000 block of Parker Court, Officers were unable to locate anything suspicious in the area.
- Request for a welfare check in the area of El Caporal. Report of a male lying down with his mouth open. Officers made contact with the male who was sleeping near a bench. The male was advised not to sleep on the sidewalk in the downtown area and was given some granola bars and water before he went on his way.
- Suspicious circumstances reported in the 400 block of Wine Country Road. RP thought she could hear someone outside. Officers walked the entire property, but did not locate anyone.

## **AUGUST 12** (23 calls for service)

- Civil dispute over child custody in the 1800 block of Benson Ave.
- Welfare check request for a small child walking alone in the area of Wine Country Road and Sheridan Ave. Area was checked, but the child was not located.
- Traffic stop in the area of Wine Country Road and Grant Ave. Driver was found to have a suspended license. Female was cited and released for DWLS 1<sup>st</sup> Degree.

## **AUGUST 13** (24 calls for service)

- Suspicious activity reported in the 1800 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated that someone on the back side of the building was shining and flashlight their vehicle lights towards the building. The area was checked, but no one was located.
- Request for a welfare check received in the area of Alexander Ct and Benson Ave. RP was a passerby and saw a female who appeared to be blind who was walking within the roadway. Officers located the female and determined she was lost. Female was provided a courtesy ride back to her apartment.
- Welfare check in the area of Taco Bell. Report of a male sleeping in the grass. Transient male was contacted and advised to move along.
- Theft of trailer reported in the 1500 block of sunset drive. RP stated their black utility trailer along with a Honda push mower had been stolen. Information was entered into the statewide system.
