## ACTIVITY LOG WEEK OF AUGUST 21, 2020 TO AUGUST 27, 2020

### **AUGUST 21** (30 calls for service)

- Officers responded to the Prosser Rest Area for a report of an alleged assault involving a knife. Upon arrival, the suspect had fled the scene in a black GMC Yukon. Medics treated and released a 42 year old female for a superficial laceration to the neck. The incident involved a verbal altercation over the custody of a cat before escalating to an alleged assault involving a knife. Prosser PD, with the assistance of surrounding agencies attempted to locate the suspect, but were not able to. Charges have been forwarded to the Prosecutor's Office.
- Officer assisted Adams County SO with an attempt to ID a hit and run suspect. Officer determined the male lives in Grandview, information was forwarded to Grandview PD.
- Traffic stop in the area of Columbia Drive and New Gate Drive, driver was cited for No Valid Operator License w/o ID.
- Officers assisted BCSO in the 9100 block of S 1537 PR SW with a welfare check.
- Officers received information on a possible female drinking alcohol in the Altitude parking lot. Vehicle was gone upon officer arrival.
- Report of two males smoking marijuana in a vehicle at EJ Miller Park. Vehicle was gone upon officer arrival.
- Officers assisted BCSO on W Johnson Road with a DV incident. Adult female threatened to shoot officers. Female was taken into custody for DV Assault.
- Report of a possible DUI received in the area of N Albro Road and Old Inland Empire Highway. Vehicle headed onto the interstate and the call was transferred to WSP.

### **AUGUST 22** (21 calls for service)

- Loitering and loud music complaint received in the 1800 block of Wine Country Road. Male was contacted and stated he had just sold his car and was cleaning it out while listening to music. Male agreed to turn the music down.
- Malicious mischief report in the area of Wamba Road and Old Inland Empire Highway. Gang graffiti was located, property owner was notified and advised they would get it covered.

### **AUGUST 23** (24 calls for service)

- Suspicious activity reported in the 800 block of Myrtle Street. RP reported her dogs barking at something in the alleyway. Area was checked multiple times, but no one was located.
- Traffic stop in the area of N Gap Road and Merlot Drive. Driver cited and released for DWLS 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree and No Ignition Interlock Device.
- Malicious mischief reported in the 600 block of New Gate Drive. RP stated his vehicle had been keyed.
- Warrant arrest in the 1100 block of Prosser Ave, male taken into custody and booked into the Benton County Jail.
- Officers responded to a disturbance call in the 1000 block of Anna Street. Male was having issues over not being able to work and depression. Male was given information on how to contact Crisis Response.
- Suspicious vehicle reported at Desert Valley Powersports in the 300 block of Merlot Drive. Report of a male and female hanging out in a vehicle in front of the building. Officer made contact with the vehicle and advised them they needed to leave the property.
- Officers assisted BCSO in the area of N Missimer Road with a vehicle that eluded a Deputy and crashed in a vineyard.

### **AUGUST 24** (23 calls for service)

- Officers responded to a verbal DV disturbance in the 1100 block of Yakima Ave. Male and female were contacted and said they were having a verbal only argument. Both advised no assault or other crimes had occurred.
- Theft reported in the 1100 block of Spokane Ave. RP stated their black and orange Hiboy electric scooter had been stolen while charging on their back porch.
- Disturbance reported in the 1800 block of Wine Country Road. RP was very upset in regards to a female in the complex confronting her about calling the PD on the female's boyfriend for playing loud music.

Fraud reported in the 1000 block of Meade Ave. RP stated he lost his debit card somewhere in Prosser and that it was used at US Bank for a \$600 cash withdrawal.

- Parking complaint received in the 300 block of Canyon Drive. RP complained of a vehicle parked on the street in front of her residence. RP was advised that nothing could be done as long as the vehicle was legally parked on the City street.

## **AUGUST 25** (18 calls for service)

- Loose dogs reported in the area of Wine Country Road and Old Inland Empire Highway. Officers were able to herd the dogs back to their home in the 500 block of New Gate Drive. Information forwarded to the CSO for follow up.
- Welfare check requested in the 300 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated a young boy was riding his bike and was being chased by a vehicle. RP said the passenger got out of the vehicle and started chasing the boy. Officers located the juvenile on the bridge. The juvenile tried to evade officers, but eventually stopped and spoke with them. It was determined that he took off because he was scared that he was going to get into trouble because he had been caught smoking. The juvenile eventually got into his mother's vehicle and was transported home.
- Officers assisted BCSO in the 3300 block of Missimer Road. Officers assisted with locating people on the property that were not supposed to be there.
- Officers responded to a disturbance in the 400 block of Petra Ave for a report of a female who was yelling in her room and being mean to other residents calling them "tattletales". Officers spoke with the female and told her to stop talking to the other residents and that she needed to keep the noise level down.
- Theft report received in the 900 block of Anna Street. RP reported that his firearm had been stolen sometime during last summer.
- Suspicious activity reported in the 400 block of North River Road. RP called and said there was a group of juveniles playing basketball at the location and that one of them looked like a gangster. RP wished to have them moved along. Officers made contact with the group and determined that some of them lived at the complex and others were friends just playing b-ball. They were told of the situation and advised to have their parents talk to management about the rules of having friends over. No gang or criminal activity was noted.

## **AUGUST 26** (16 calls for service)

- Theft reported in the 900 block of Alice Street. RP advised a vehicle had pulled up to their neighbor's residence and that a male got out and retrieved a gas can from the back yard. The male put gas into the vehicle and then drove off taking the gas can with him. Vehicle was described a red two door convertible.
- Assist at Prosser Airport, Air Traffic Controller stated they lost contact with a student pilot. Plane was determined to still be airborne, no problems found.
- Suspicious vehicle reported at the Barn Motor Inn. RP advised of a vehicle in the parking lot occupied by a male whom he believed was doing drugs. RP wished to have the male trespassed from the location. Officer made contact with the male who stated he was there to visit a friend, but the friend wasn't there. Officer advised the male of the RP's wishes to have him trespassed and provided him with the trespass warning paperwork.
- Theft reported in the 1000 block of Margaret Street. RP advised his trailer along with a riding lawn mower had been stolen during the early morning hours.
- Officers assisted WSP with a vehicle pursuit that ended with a wreck on Witkopf Loop. Five individuals were detained by WSP.
- Traffic hazard reported in the area of Bennett Ave and Gum Street. RP advised that a male had jumped out of the bushes and into the road in front of their vehicle. Officers made contact with the male walking along the train tracks who advised he was heading into town from Gum Street to meet his girlfriend. Male was given a verbal warning for trespassing on BNSF property.

## **AUGUST 27** (25 calls for service)

- Report of loose dogs in the area of 8<sup>th</sup> Street and Grant Ave. Two German Shepherds were located and captured at Crawford Park by the CSO. Owners were later located and took possession of their dogs.
- Noise complaint received in the 1800 block of Wine Country Road. RP was contacted and said there is an ongoing issue with the upstairs neighbors being too loud and that the manager will not do anything about it. Officer explained the restrictions for PMC noise issues and advised the RP to call back if it continued to be a problem.
- Fraud report received in the 1000 block of Meade Ave. RP reported his debit card had been used to withdrawal \$1,400 at the US Bank in Prosser.

Officers responded to a disturbance at the Barn Motor Inn. RP was upset and verbal with employees at the location. Officers determined it was a civil issue, that the RP wanted his money back for a room he had paid for. RP was issued a refund and left the location per the manager's request.
