## ACTIVITY LOG WEEK OF AUGUST 28, 2020 TO SEPTEMBER 03, 2020

### AUGUST 28 (27 calls for service)

- Suspicious Vehicle reported in the 1100 block of Colena Street. Reporting Party (RP) stated that there was a strange car with a man asleep inside of it parked outside of their house. Officers made contact with a male and determined he was the landscaper, no problems were found.
- Found property report taken at Crawford Park. City workers found a bike in the bushes near the river during clean up. Bike was transported to offsite storage for safekeeping.
- Scam phone call received in the 1000 block of Alexander Ct. RP stated he received a phone call from someone claiming to be "Robert Glee" who told the RP that his granddaughter was in jail and needed bail money. Officer called "Robert" back and was promptly hung up on after identifying himself as an officer. Officer attempted the phone number again multiple times, but they went unanswered.
- Officer assisted EMS in the area of North Beers Road. Officer observed an ambulance driving through Prosser with their siren only and no emergency lights. After failed attempts to get ahold of the ambulance through dispatch to advise them to turn their overhead lights on, Officer escorted them through traffic as it was causing confusion and drivers were not stopping.
- Officers responded to a 911 hang up in the 500 block of Wine Country Road. Officers made contact with two juveniles who said they had not called 911. Officers spoke with the juveniles about the 911 system and how it should be used.
- Report of a sex offender violation received. RP called saying he saw a sex offender on Facebook. Information was forwarded to BCSO Detectives to verify registry requirements and investigate further.
- Officers responded to a suspicious circumstances call at PMH. Officers made contact with a mother and daughter who were engaged in a verbal argument. The mother advised her daughter had kidnapped her, but the daughter was sitting in the back seat of their vehicle wanting to get out. No crime was found to have occurred, daughter checked herself into PMH for evaluation.
- Trespass order served on transient male per request of WSDOT due to male staying at the Rest Area for more than 8 hours and leaving a mess behind. Male agreed to stay off the property for 1 year.
- Officers responded to a disturbance report in the 900 block of 6<sup>th</sup> Street. Upon arrival at the location, officers did not locate anyone. Officers contacted the male RP by phone. RP advised a female friend had punched him, but that he did not want to press charges.
- Officers responded to a call of shots fired in the 1400 block of Prosser Avenue. Upon arrival, Officers found a residence had been struck numerous times by gunfire. There were no injuries reported from the incident and there is no known gang activity at the residence. Prosser PD has multiple individuals of interest under investigation for the shooting.

### AUGUST 29 (20 calls for service)

- Assault reported in the 200 block of 9<sup>th</sup> Street. Officers determined there had been a physical fight between two females. Medics were called to the scene to treat one female who had been injured during the fight. Investigation is ongoing.
- Suspicious person reported at Jamin Java in the 100 block of Merlot Drive. Transient male was contacted sleeping on a bench at the location. Male was woken up and told he needed to move along.
- Reckless driving complaint received at Burger King. RP advised a customer complained of a group of juveniles almost hitting them in the parking lot. Management requested the juveniles be moved along with no trespass orders. Juveniles were contacted and agreed to move along with no issues.
- Multiple reports of hearing what was thought to be gunshots in the City. Officers were unable to find any obvious signs of gunfire. Noise was believed to have been fireworks.
- Noise complaint received in the area of Merlot Drive and Port Ave. RP advised of multiple vehicles that gather behind the wineries and play loud music. Officer observed the vehicles, which were in a public area, but did not hear any loud music.

## **AUGUST 30** (24 calls for service)

- Officers assisted BCSO with a suspicious activity call in the area of S. Lanell Drive. RP advised a female wearing a hospital gown had shown up at their residence claiming to be friends with the RP's wife and requesting to speak with her. The wife however, did not know the female. Medics were dispatched and the female was transported to PMH for evaluation.
- Request for a welfare check received in the 700 block of Memorial Street. Female that had been transported from the County earlier had reportedly left the hospital with her IV still in place. Officers located the female, but she stated she did not want to go back to the hospital. Officers along with EMS staff were able to talk the female into letting medical staff remove her IV. Female was provided a ride back to her vehicle and she left the area.
- Suspicious person reported in the 200 block of Merlot Drive. RP stated there was a female in a car parked in front of the Best Western doors. RP stated the female was refusing to leave after she had been denied a room due to past problems with her. Officers made contact with the female who was the same female involved in the previous incidents. Female stated she would be leaving town. She was last observed heading westbound on I-82.
- Suspicious vehicle reported in the 900 block of Alexander Ct. RP advised of a van parked by the trailer court and stated they thought it was suspicious because the last time it was parked there vehicles had been damaged. Officer checked the van and determined it was unoccupied and legally parked.
- Assist in the area of Mercer Ct and Wine Country Road. Motorist had turned the corner and his right front wheel came off his vehicle. Officer provided traffic control until a tow truck arrived.
- Officer responded to a motor vehicle accident report in the 400 block of Petra Ave. Vehicle had driven over an embankment striking multiple vehicles and a power pole. No injuries were reported. Accident occurred on private property and information was exchanged.
- Suspicious male reported in the area of McDonalds. RP stated he appeared as if he was on narcotics. Officers were not able to locate a male matching the description given.

## **AUGUST 31** (25 calls for service)

- Noise complaint received in the 1100 block of Prosser Ave. Music had already been turned down upon Officer arrival.
- DV assault information received by phone. RP who is a social worker at a hospital in Seattle advised of a patient who reported being assaulted in Prosser. RP was told to encourage their patient to obtain a no contact order and to file a report.
- Vehicle prowler reported in the 100 block of Merlot Drive. RP advised the seal to his refrigerated trailer was missing and that boxes of frozen French fries had been scattered about. RP was unsure of any fries had been stolen or they had just been moved.
- Reckless traffic complaint in the 1100 block of Meade Ave. RP advised he was on his bicycle and had nearly been ran off the road by an elderly driver. Officer was unable to locate the driver.
- Malicious mischief reported in the 1000 block of Sherman Ave. RP stated it appeared as if someone had shot their window with a bb gun sometime during the evening.
- Disturbance reported at PMH. Staff advised of a belligerent patient who was being verbal and threatening. Officer escorted the patient off the property.
- Theft reported in the 300 block of Casi Ct. RP advised a flag was removed from their property and they had found it tossed near the end of the street.
- Private property accident reported in the area of N. Gap Road and Wine Country Road. SEMI vs SEMI, drivers exchanged information.
- Dangerous dog report taken in the 400 block of Petra Ave. RP was scratched by another resident's dog when the dog lunged toward RP's dog. Information was forwarded to the CSO for follow up.
- Officers assisted BCSO regarding the recovery of a stolen trailer out of Prosser. Trailer was recovered at a residence located near N. River Road and S. Moore Road. Registered owner was advised of the recovery.

## **SEPTEMBER 01** (27 calls for service)

- Lewd conduct complaint received at the Rest Area. RP advised a male was pleasuring himself in a bathroom stall and then left while the RP was calling dispatch.
- Weapons complaint received in the area of Court Street and SR-22. Multiple callers reported hearing what they thought were gunshots. Area was checked, but nothing suspicious was located.

Theft of bicycle reported at Wine Country RV Park. Bicycle was later located at the McDonald's bike rack. Transient male had been seen with the bike by an Officer on the day the bike went missing. Male was located and cited for Theft 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree.

- Theft reported in the 1100 block of 6<sup>th</sup> Street. RP advised his Toro lawn mower bag had been stolen.
- Officers responded to a DV disturbance in the 1300 block of Sommers Ave. RP reported seeing two males being physical. Officers made contact with the two males and a female at the location. All parties advised that one male was upset and started hitting himself in the face before the other male tried to hold him in a bear hug in an attempt to get him to stop. No crime was found to have occurred. Males were provided with DV resource cards.
- Loitering complaint received at the Holiday Inn. RP stated they removed a male from a room and he was refusing to leave the property. RP requested Officers trespass the male. Officers made contact with the male and served him with a trespass order.
- Hit and run reported at Vapehead. Employee stated a blue truck had hit his vehicle in the parking lot and then took off. Investigation is ongoing.
- Non-injury accident reported in the area of 5<sup>th</sup> Street and Yakima Ave. Vehicle struck a power pole. Minor scuffmark was found on the pole and the vehicle had a scratch. Accident was determined non-reportable.
- Officer responded to a disturbance report at the Chevron. RP advised a male was blocking him from pulling into the location, was making rude gestures and yelling at him. Officer made contact with the male who was pacing back and forth and appeared to be under the influence of narcotics. Male claimed he did not intend to block anyone and was not aware of the disturbance he was causing.

## **SEPTEMBER 02** (19 calls for service)

- Theft report received in the 1100 block of Playfield Ave. RP advised his daughter had been kicked out of the residence and that she came by with a male to pick up an item that was hers, but proceeded to take multiple other items that did not belong to her.
- Scam call reported in the 1200 block of Quarter Horse Trl. RP advised she received a call from a male who was trying to get her to buy prepaid cards at Walmart.
- Complaint of kids playing in Rotary Park received. RP was concerned they may get hit by a car. No problem was observed and the kids were approximately 50 feet from Wine Country Road.
- Private property collision at Prosser Motel. Driver backed into a light pole. No damage was found to the pole and the vehicle received a dent to the rear bumper. Driver was advised to take photos of the damage and notify her insurance company.

## **SEPTEMBER 03** (29 calls for service)

- Officers assisted BCSO with a reported assault on Steele Road.
- Report of an aggressive Pit Bull in the 2000 block of Benson Ave. RP stated the dog was aggressive and on the loose outside of her residence. CSO arrived as the owner was securing his dog. Owner stated he would be putting his dogs inside for the day. Owner was made aware that the Pit Bull would be declared a potentially dangerous dog.
- Malicious mischief reported in the 1500 block of Sheridan Ave. RP advised they own the mobile home park and had located graffiti on one of the homes as well as the sidewalk. While investigating, a female contacted the responding officer and advised that her young children were responsible for the graffiti and that she was going to contact the landlord about it. Officer contacted the RP and told her the information. RP stated she would handle it as a civil matter and have the kids help clean it up.
- Officers conducted a welfare check in the 1200 block of Kinney way for a report of a suicidal subject. Officers contacted a female at the location who requested to be transported to PMH for evaluation.
- Theft report received at the fire station. RP advised that some very expensive fishing gear had been taken from a boat parked at the location.
- Theft reported in the 2100 block of Benson Ct. RP advised a 5 gallon fuel tank had been stolen from their boat.
