## ACTIVITY LOG

WEEK OF SEPTEMBER 18, 2020 TO SEPTEMBER 24, 2020

### SEPTEMBER 18 (29 Calls for Service)

- Report of a wrong way driver received on I-82 near Gibbon Road. Vehicle was observed traveling the wrong way near exit 80. Officer was able to successfully deploy their strike strip, causing the front passenger tire to deflate. The vehicle continued westbound in the eastbound lane, nearly going head-on with an oncoming vehicle. As a second officer approached to stop the vehicle, the driver pulled to the inside shoulder and stopped. Officers contacted the female driver and detained her. She was eventually arrested for suspicion of DUI and custody was transferred to WSP.
- Officers responded to a disturbance in the 400 block of N River Road. Reporting Party (RP) had tracked his stolen tablet to an apartment in the area. Residents allowed officers to check for the tablet while RP turned on the ring tone however, the tablet was not located.
- Officers responded to a verbal disturbance at Cottage Market. Individuals were upset and vulgar with each other over not being able to get out of a space at the gas pumps.
- Traffic accident in the 500 block of Wine Country Road. Vehicle was traveling northbound on Wine Country Road when their tire came off and struck a residence causing damage.
- Theft of a license plate reported in the 1000 block of Sherman Ave. License plate was entered into the statewide system as stolen.
- Traffic stop in the area of Brown Street and Prosser Ave. Upon contact, Officer observed an open bottle of Corona beer and suspected drug paraphernalia in the vehicle. The driver was found to have a suspended license and was cited for DWLS 3rd Degree. The vehicle was seized for a search warrant.
- Reckless traffic complaint received in the 900 block of Kinney Way. Report of a dark gray Acura traveling 60 Mph in a 25 MPH zone. Officers were unable to locate the suspect vehicle.
- Reckless traffic complaint received in the area of Market Street and Yakima Ave. Report of a possible DUI. Officers later located the vehicle parked and unoccupied in the 600 block of 6<sup>th</sup> Street.
- Suspicious activity reported in the 1200 block of Prosser Ave. RP advised of multiple subjects dressed as ghosts at the Tennis Courts. Officer made contact and found a mom taking pictures of her kids.
- Officers assisted BCSO with a report of a semi-truck engulfed in flames on N Bunn Road.

### SEPTEMBER 19 (18 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to a domestic disturbance in the 1300 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated her husband was punching holes in the walls. Officers made contact and determined there had been a verbal only argument. Male admitted to punching the wall, but the RP did not want him arrested. Male agreed to leave for the evening.
- Theft of license plate received in the 200 block of Emick Ln. Plate was entered into the statewide system as stolen.

- Narcotics complaint received at EJ Miller Park. Report of a group of males smoking marijuana near the Skate Park. Suspects left in a vehicle just prior to Officer arrival and officers were unable to locate the vehicle.
- Traffic stop in the area of Gap Road and I-82. Driver was found to have a suspended license and was cited for DWLS 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree.

- Animal complaint received in the 200 block of Old Inland Empire Hwy. RP complained of an aggressive dog in her yard. Officers were able to locate the dog in the Bethel Church field, but were unable to capture it. Call was transferred to the Community Service Officer.
- Suspicious person reported in the 1200 block of Playfield Ave. Elderly male with dementia had again gotten lost and couldn't remember where he was at. Male's daughter was called to pick him up and take him home.
- Officers responded to an alarm call in the 300 block of Merlot Drive. Officers arrived on scene and found the landscaper out in the area of the motion sensor with no one else was around. The landscaper said he had experienced the same problems with the motion sensor over the weekend.
- Disturbance reported in the 1900 block of Elwood Ave. Officer was in area when the call kicked out and he did not observe or hear anything. RP said she did not see anything either, but had heard a man yelling. There was a group of older kids playing on Elwood Ave and one was a male. They also advised they did not hear anything.
- Criminal trespass in the 200 block of 9<sup>th</sup> Street. Officer observed a male at a condemned residence. Male was cited and released for Criminal Trespass 1<sup>st</sup> Degree.

## **SEPTEMBER 22** (18 Calls for Service)

Officers checked the area for any other damage, but did not find any. RP was advised he may face charges for discharging a firearm. RP handled the damage to the window with hotel staff.
