ACTIVITY LOG

Week of October 20 to October 26, 2023

October 20 (28 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to a report of a non-injury hit and run accident at the 700 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated that a black Honda type of vehicle was tailgating him and then passed him, and then locked up his brakes, causing the RP to hit him. The Honda vehicle then fled away. Investigation ongoing.
- Officers attended Career Day at Prosser High School.
- Officer assist with a vehicle repossession at the 1400 block of Wine Country Road.
- Officer responded to a request for a vin inspection. RP was referred to state patrol.
- Officers responded to a report of a non-injury traffic accident at the 1100 block of Sheridan Avenue. One vehicle was brake-checking in front of the other and the rear vehicle bumped the front vehicle. No injuries.
- Officers responded to an informational report (in the PD lobby) concerning a stalking situation. RP stated that her ex is showing up in places where she is and is interested in information regarding an NCO. She was given guidance.
- Officers responded to an alarm at the 200 block of Gap Road. An alarm was set off by someone in the building for cleaning (who was not expected). Apparently, an employee gave her cousin her key card for entry so that she could clean for her. A PUD supervise met the officers at the PUD to clear things up.
- BCSO officer assist with a report of a traffic accident on I82. Upon arrival, there was no traffic accident. A vehicle was in the median with its hazard lights on but the vehicle was unoccupied. Transferred incident to WSP.
- Officers performed a welfare check at the Prosser Rest area. An RP called crying following a domestic violence incident with her ex, whom she had an active no contact order for. One male was taken into custody.
- Officers responded to a report of a disturbance at the 2000 block of Highland Drive. RP stated that there may be a fight in the area. Officer checked the area and the local parks but did not locate any fighting.
- Officer responded to an informational report at the 100 block of Merlot Drive. RP stated that someone had come through the drive-thru and the RP had noted that the driver had an infant in a car seat in the front seat that was turned sideways and not buckled in. Officer was unable to locate the vehicle.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

October 21 (26 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to a report of an alarm at the 300 block of Wine Country Road. Officer checked the building. All doors were secure.
- BCSO officer assist for a report of a semi that is swerving and having a hard time staying on the road. Officer spoke with the driver and all was well.
- Officers responded to a report of a solicitor in the Prosser Avenue/Guernsey Street area. RP stated that there is a male in the area trying to sell home renovation services. RP stated it seemed like a scam. Officers spoke with the solicitor and advised him of the requirements for

soliciting (displaying business license, for example) per PMC 5.04.165. As the male was not in compliance with the Prosser codes, he left the area.

- Officers responded to a report of reckless driving at N Gap Road/I 82. RP stated that a male in a silver Chevy Cruz appears to be drinking and driving. He is swerving and cutting vehicles off. Officers were unable to locate the vehicle or driver upon arrival.
- Officers responded to a report of destruction of property at the school. RP reported that two juveniles were spray painting the school dug out. Officers did not locate any problems in the area indicated, so they contacted the RP again to find that the school in question was in Pasco, not Prosser. Call was split to Pasco PD.
- Officers responded to an animal complaint at W Johnson Road/N Wamba Road. RP stated that there are two dogs loose (a German Sheppard and a white dog) and the white dog had bit him. As this location is out of Prosser jurisdiction, it was split to BCSO.
- Officers responded to a CPS referral at the 1800 block of Benson Avenue. Investigation ongoing.
- Officers responded to a report of an abandoned vehicle on OIE Hwy/Grant Avenue. RP stated that the vehicle has been parked in the area for over a week. CSO officer will be informed.
- Officer responded to a weapons complaint at the 1900 block of Benson Avenue. RP was a male who arrived at PMH with a gunshot wound to the leg. Based on all the statements taken and the injuries sustained, it was determined that this was not a gunshot wound. In fact, it was determined that a firework was thrown at a group during a party at the location. The firework exploded, sending shrapnel into the leg of an 18 year old male and the eye of a 15 year old female. Investigation ongoing.
- Officers responded to a civil request at the 700 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated that he would like an officer to be present while he takes control of one of his trucks (from a current driver). Officer advised the RP that this is a civil matter and as such, we cannot be an enforcement for the activity.
- Officers responded to an alarm at the 1800 block of Wine Country Road. Responsible party called to clear the alarm prior to officer arrival at location.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

October 22 (25 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to a report of a no-assault domestic incident at the 1100 block of Sheridan. Two brothers were having a heated verbal incident. Individuals separated. No crime.
- Officers responded to a report of a missing person at the 1900 block of Benson Avenue. RP stated that she and her friend went to a party and had been drinking. RP stated that her friend left on foot without her phone. RP has been driving around looking for her to no avail. Officers advised that she have the parents of her friend call in a missing person report, if necessary.
- Officers responded to a report of a traffic hazard at I82/Wine Country Road. RP stated that the stop sign at the location had been broken off and was on the ground. WSP was advised of the incident.
- Officer responded to a report of a found item at the 100 block of Merlot Drive. The RP stated that there is a case in the dumpster that he thought may contain a rifle. Officers checked the case but no rifle was present. No issues.
- Officer responded to a report of a theft at the 700 block of Memorial Street (PMH). RP stated that items from her locker were stolen. The locker had been left unsecure, but theft has been an ongoing issue at the location.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint at the 300 block of Wine Country Road. RP found a dog in the area and have not been able to find the owner. Will forward to CSO.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

October 23 (36 Calls for Service)

- Court officer assist with attempting to serve paperwork at the 800 block of Brown Street (attempt was unsuccessful).
- Officers responded to a hit and run traffic accident at the 800 block of Bennett Avenue. Video showed that RP was illegally parked in the truck turnaround area. It appears the back tire of the truck struck the vehicle's front bumper.
- Officers responded to a report of a burglary at the 800 block of 6th Street. RP stated the storage unit at the location was broken into and a gas can with the gas was stolen. Investigation ongoing.
- Officer responded to a report of a loose dog at the 400 block of Petra Avenue. Officer collected the dog who had no tags, no collar, and no chip. The happy pooch was posted on FB, and was eventually reunited with his owner. Pooch's owner was found and pooch went home.
- Officer responded to a disturbance at the 700 block of Memorial Street. A patient was causing a disturbance, but settled down. No crime.
- Officer responded to a report of a vehicle taken without permission. RP states that his daughter took his car without permission. He did not want to press charges but wanted an officer to contact the daughter and tell her to return the vehicle.
- Officers responded to an animal complaint. A female German shepherd mix dog with a brown Carhartt collar was found and taken to Prosser PD. The phone number on the tag was unavailable. CSO will attempt to contact registered owner of the dog.
- Officer responded to a request for a welfare check at the 200 block of Merlot Drive. RP stated that a male at the location was angry because his card was declined and he was causing a disturbance.
- Officers responded to a violation of a court order following a traffic stop at the 700 block of Wine Country Road. The driver was a protected party in a No Contact Order (NCO) while a passenger in the vehicle was the one he was being protected from in the NCO. Female passenger was taken into custody for violating the NCO.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

October 24 (32 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to an alarm at the 2000 block of Highland Drive. The location was checked and no issues were found.
- Officers responded to a weapons complaint at the 100 block of SW Kelandren Drive. RP stated that they had heard approximately 5 gunshots near the canal. RP also stated that they saw a person in the area walking on the canal road. Officer was unable to locate the individual. No other neighbors had seen the person.
- BCSO officer assist for a warrant arrest at the police department.
- BCSO officer assist with a traffic stop at the 300 block of Wine Country Road.
- Officer responded to an informational report at the 1300 block of Mustang Court. RP stated that when her dog went into the neighbor's yard, the neighbor's dog bit her dog. The RP's dog had no visible injuries. RP was advised to keep her dog in her yard to prevent a defensive dog attack from the neighbor's dog.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted extra patrols where requested.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

- BCSO officer assist with answering questions about building permits.
