## ACTIVITY LOG

### Week of October 27 to November 02, 2023

#### October 27 (24 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to a report of an assault at the 100 block of Merlot Drive. RP stated that he was in the store at the location when he was confronted by a female who began harassing him. He stated that he ignored the female, but when he went outside, a male (with the female) pushed him up against his vehicle. The female then began to strike the RP and the male broke his front window. The male and female were known by the offender. Additionally, there is video surveillance of the incident. Investigation ongoing.
- Officers responded to a report of narcotics at the 100 block of Merlot Drive. RP stated that there are people in a black vehicle at the location using drugs. The car then left. Officer checked the area but was unable to locate the vehicle.
- Officers responded to an Adult Protective Services (APS) referral that came into the Police Department. Investigation ongoing.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint at the police department (airport property). There was a black shepherd dog running on the airport property. Officer was unable to catch the elusive dog.
