Week of November 09 to November 16, 2023

November 09 (37 Calls for Service)

- Officers participated in a Veteran's Day assembly at the high school.
- Officers responded to a report of a domestic-no assault at the 400 block of Petra Avenue. RP stated that there was a male and female who were fighting in the parking lot at the location. Officers contacted the male and female who both stated that the argument was verbal only. No crime.
- Officer responded to a report of an animal complaint at Claire Street/Paterson Road. There was a small dog at large. Officer contacted the dog owners and told them to secure their dog.
- Officer responded to a report of a noise violation at the 1100 block of Prosser Avenue. RP stated that there is an ongoing issue with a neighbor revving the engine in their Camaro. Officer noted no noise upon arrival, but advised RP that there may be no noise violation during the day but if the issue happens at night, to contact the non-emergency number.
- Officer responded to a report of assault taken at the lobby of the police department. RP stated that his son was assaulted. Investigation ongoing.
- Officer responded to a report of destruction of property at the 900 block of Kinney Way. Graffiti was found at the skate park, and has since been covered.
- Officer responded to another complaint about the revving Camaro. Officer did not locate the noise upon arrival.
- Officers responded to a report of a traffic hazard on Wine Country Road/Chapman Lane. A husky dog had been hit by a vehicle. The owner arrived and the injured dog was taken to the animal hospital.
- Officers responded to a group of juveniles fighting at the 1500 block of Paterson Road. Officers broke up the fight and the parties involved stated that they are all just "play fighting". Officers advised them to make better choices and directed them to leave the area.
- Officer responded to a male on a bicycle. He was given a warning for not having a light on his bicycle during hours of darkness (RCW 46.61.780).
- Officers responded to a report of a single vehicle traffic accident at Wine Country Road/Sheridan Avenue. One juvenile male was detained under suspicion of DUI.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

November 10 (32 Calls for Service)

- EMS officers assist at the 100 block of Nunn Road for assistance with a Lifelight crew.
- Officer responded to an APS referral at the 200 block of Hagarty Lane. Investigation ongoing.
- Officers responded to a report of a traffic hazard at SR22/Wine Country Road. A disabled semi was blocking traffic. The responsible driver was trying to get someone out to fix or tow. Split to WSP.
- Officers responded to a report of a theft at the 1000 block of Kinney Way. RP stated that a delivery had been stolen from her porch. Investigation is ongoing.
- Officers responded to a report of a theft at the 1300 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated that a few juveniles were stealing items from the location. The juveniles left the location and officers found them and detained them. Stolen vapes were recovered. As the RP did not want to be a victim, the juveniles were released.

- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

November 11 (36 Calls for Service)

- Officers assisted with the Veterans Day parade, 3 police department officers who are veterans were in the parade.
- Officer responded to a report of information at Wine Country Road/North River Road. RP stated that a glass globe on the bridge lights was falling off. Officer tried to reach the cover but was unable to. Contacted employee from City Roads Dept.
- BCSO officer assist for a suspicious circumstance on W King Tull Road. RP stated that his wife went outside to close the gate but had not returned. Prosser and Grandview were alerted. Wife was contacted and had gone to church. Her husband had forgotten that she had left for church.
- Officers responded to a business alarm at the 200 block of Chardonnay Avenue. Officers noted one unsecured door. Employee arrived and did not find any issues. Door was secured.
- Officers responded to a report of a civil issue at the 600 block of 6th Street. RP stated that customers had made an order and the RP thought that the customer might try to pay with a fraudulent check, as they had done it before. The customers never showed up to collect their order, so no crime was committed. Officers advised RP to call again if the customer shows up.
- Officers responded to an assist on Merlot Drive. RP's vehicle had broken down and he wanted to know if he could leave it parked at the location. As the location was private property, the officer advised that the RP would have to check with the establishment, as towing (or not towing) the vehicle would be at their discretion.
- Officer responded to a request for an assist at the 1000 block of Hemlock Street. RP stated that he made an arrangement to buy something on Facebook and the seller was showing up at a late hour (11:30 pm). RP wanted the officer to be present for the exchange. Officer advised the RP that he is unable to oversee the purchase (as it is a civil matter), but that if he feels uncomfortable, the RP should reschedule the exchange, or if he meets with him anyway, he should call if there is a problem.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

November 12 (27 Calls for Service)

- Officer made contact with a resident at the 1300 Prosser Avenue, whose backyard fence has blown over into the roadway.
- BCSO/WSP Officer assist near Benton City for a multiple vehicle accident with injury.
- Officers responded to a report of suspicious circumstances at Wine Country Road/182. RP stated that he was approached by a male at the location who had offered him a ring for gas money. The male was wearing a purple suit and had said that he is trying to get to California.

Officers spoke to the owner of the pet who claimed that the dog was fine and then brought the dog into the apartment they were in.
- Officers responded to a report of a suspicious circumstance at the 700 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated that there is a vehicle in the back lot that had previously tried to sell fake gold. RP was advised that they can trespass the subjects if they choose to. Vehicle was not located upon officer arrival.
- Officer responded to a parking violation at Petra Ave/Basalt Loop. Vehicle was parked in a no parking zone and was pink tagged for removal.
- Officers responded to a report of a missing juvenile at the 800 block of Market Street. RP stated that her daughter had not returned from school. After many contacts and searching, the child was found at a friend's home and went home with her family.
- Officers responded to a vehicle blocking roadway at W Johnson Road/N Albro Road. A vehicle had broken down, blocking the roadway. The driver's wife arrived shortly after to tow it.

- Officers attempted to serve papers at the 1100 block of Prosser Avenue.
- Officers responded to a report of a traffic complaint at the 600 block of Wine Country Road. The church was giving away food and there was a fair amount of traffic blocking entrances at other businesses.
- Officer responded to a 911 hang up from the 2000 block of Wine Country Road. Caller stated she was trying to turn off the blinking light on her phone and accidentally called 911.
- Officer detained a large brown dog that was following people down Wine Country Road (from Columbia Drive). The dog did not have a collar, tags, or a chip. The dog will be held by the CSO for 72 hours.
- Officers responded to a report of a domestic-no assault at the 1800 block of Benson Avenue. RP stated that daughter is being verbal with the family. RP was trying to detain daughter (and daughter's child) as he is concerned for the welfare of the child. As the RP does not have custodial rights, the RP had to allow the daughter to leave.
- Officers responded to a report of civil issue at the 1800 block of Benson Avenue. RP stated that her daughter was attempting to run away due to issues at home. Officers talked to daughter and mother. Mother and daughter came to an agreeable solution.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

- Officers responded to a report of a vehicle theft at the 200 block of Canyon Drive. RP stated that his Gray 1997 Honda Civic was taken from his residence at some point between 8am and 6pm on Wednesday, Nov 15. Investigation ongoing.

Officers spoke with the subject, who is the neighbor's daughter, who was getting something out of the truck. No crime.
