ACTIVITY LOG

Week of November 03 to November 08, 2023

November 03 (32 Calls for Service)

- BCSO officer assist on S 1545 PR for a welfare check. RP stated they heard gun shots and a woman screaming. Officers checked the area of the call but were unable to locate anything out of the ordinary.
- Officer responded to a report of a suspicious circumstance at the 500 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated that there is a suspicious person lurking around and looking into cars at the location. Officers were unable to locate the person upon arrival.
- Officer responded to a lobby contact report of fraud. Case was split to Benton County as resident lives outside of Prosser jurisdiction.
- Officer responded to a report of an animal complaint at the 900 block of Florence Street. RP stated that there is an aggressive pit bull loose in the area. Officer attempted to contact the owner, who eventually secured her dog. Officer will follow up with the owner concerning her loose dog.
- Officers responded to a request for a welfare check at Wine Country Road/Merlot Drive. RP stated that there was a male laying in the grass not moving. They did not want to approach the male but were concerned about him. Officers checked the surrounding area but were unable to locate the male. A short time later, the subject male called and the call was split to medics.
- Officers responded to a report of a theft at the 100 block of Merlot Drive. RP stated that a male came in and stole several small candies and then left. The store employee will forward the video to the Police department. Investigation ongoing.
- Officers responded to an animal complaint at the lobby of the Police department. A citizen had brought in a dog that they had caught that had been running loose. The officer advised the male that he was unable to take in the lost pooch as the CSO would not be in until Monday.
- Officers responded to a report of a car getting egged at the 1000 block of Sheridan Avenue. RP stated that her father's car had been egged and that she believed it was the same individuals that her father had chased after when they ding-dong-ditched earlier in the day. Officers advised RP to NOT chase after persons engaged in such activities and instead to call the non-emergency number.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

November 04 (32 Calls for Service)

- Officers noted individuals in the park after dark during regular patrolling. Individuals were just hanging out, but were moved along.
- Officer responded to a report of a disturbance at the 400 block of 6th Street. RP stated that a male was standing in front of the store yelling at her. RP feels that male was perhaps on drugs. RP wanted him trespassed from the location.
- EMS officer assist at the 2100 block of Wine Country Road.
- Officers responded to a non-injury traffic accident in a parking lot at the 300 block of Chardonnay Avenue. Involved parties were advised to exchange information.
- Officers responded to a report of reckless driving on Paterson Road. RP stated that a truck had flashed its lights at him and then started following him. The RP had driven towards the police department and the truck had eventually stopped following him.

November 05 (36 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to a request for assist at the 700 block of Memorial Street. RP stated that she had brought her boyfriend (who had been drinking) to the hospital who fell asleep in the waiting room. The RP could not find him when she returned to collect him. Boyfriend was found to have wandered into a different area of the hospital.
- Officers responded to a report of a Domestic violence report at the 700 block of Eastgate Dr. RP stated that her husband (who had been drinking), threw a drink bottle, striking her head. When officers attempted to locate the RP, she had left the location and refused to answer the phone or the door. No report filed at this time.
- Officers responded to an alarm at the 1400 block of Scenic Drive. Accidental alarm that was not shut off in time. No issues.
- Officer responded to a request for assist at the 1000 block of Anna Street. RP stated that a known female was hanging out in her shed eating food. The RP had asked her to leave, which she initially refused to do. However, she collected her items and left prior to officer arrival.
- BCSO officers assist for a report of a disturbance on N Wilgus Road. RP was crying and there was a lot of yelling and name calling going on. Male and female had a verbal only argument. The male and female separated. No crime.
- Officers responded to a report of domestic-no assault at the 1000 block of Anna Street. RP's daughter was causing issues, being verbal and screaming. Officers advised her not to return per the RP and the RP was advised to stop letting her come by.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

- Officer responded to an alarm at the 100 block of Merlot Drive. No entry into the building was found.
- Officers responded to a 911 hang up. Officer contacted the number that called and all was well. 911 call was an accident.

The pickup was occupied by 2 persons. Officers contacted the driver of the vehicle in question, who was in the area to purchase a vehicle from a tenant.

- Officer responded to an animal complaint at Lillian Street/Evans Avenue. Two dogs were wandering loose in the roadway. One dog was returned to Lillian Street. The other dog is possibly from Ellen Avenue. Attempts to contact owner were unsuccessful.

Officer pinked tagged the vehicle for removal and will attempt to contact the owner. UPDATE: as there did not appear to be an attempt to move the vehicle, and several attempts to contact the owner of the vehicle were unsuccessful, the vehicle was towed.
- Officer responded to a civil report at the 200 block of Canyon Drive. RP stated that a step grandparent was being mean and aggressive to the RPs children, and threatening to take the RP to court to take them away. Officers advised RP to stay away from him.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

November 07 (39 Calls for Service)

- Officer responded to a report of an APS referral. The RP stated that a known person had made reports to APS about his well-being that were not accurate. RP stated that the reports were false. The RP called APS to let them know.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint at Bennett Avenue/Margaret Street. A raccoon had been injured by a vehicle. Injured animal was taken to Prosser Animal Hospital.
- Officer responded to a request for a welfare check on her brother, whom she thought could be located in Prosser. She had not heard from him in several weeks. Officers reviewed the video that the sister had from him and recognized the surroundings to be at a location in Union Gap. RP was given information on contacting the Union Gap police department.
- Officer responded to a report of destruction of property at the 600 block of 7th Street. RP stated that there was graffiti found on the building. Graffiti was painted over.
- WSP officer assist with a single, non-injury traffic accident on I82. A Toyota Corolla had hit a guardrail.
- Officers responded to a vehicle repossession at the 700 block of Market Street.
- Officers responded to a complaint of noise violation at the 500 Wine Country Road. RP stated that there is loud music coming from the area and also someone was revving a vehicle very loudly. Officer checked the area and did not note any loud music or vehicles.
