ACTIVITY LOG

Week of November 17 to November 21, 2023

November 17 (42 Calls for Service)

- Officer delivered unclaimed puppies (previously found) to a shelter facility in Benton City.
- Officers responded to a report of lewd conduct at Stacy Avenue/6th Street. BFT bus driver stated that a male has been stepping off the bus and urinating on the street at the bus stop. Male was currently at the bus stop sleeping in a sleeping bag. No crime at this time, but male was advised not to urinate at the bus stop. Male declined medical assistance.
- Officers responded to a report of theft at the 1200 block of Riverside Drive. RP stated there was a male in a hoody and red pants on a bicycle who was trying to steal items from his property. The male dropped the items when he left. Officers checked the area but were unable to locate the subject upon arrival.
- Officer responded to a report of fraud at the 1800 block of Benson Avenue. RP stated that there were charges on her credit card (in Missouri) that she had not made. Investigation ongoing.
- Officers responded to a request for a welfare check at the 900 block of Myrtle Street. RP requested officers to check on sister. Officers contacted sister who was fine and stated that the RP is her brother and that he sometimes acts like this when off of his medication. No crime.
- Officer responded to a parking violation at Wine Country Road/OIE Hwy. Officer noted that two vehicles were parked in the bike lane. Officer made contact with one of the vehicle's owner who stated the vehicles will be moved shortly.
- Officers responded to a report of a trespass at the 400 block of 7th Street. A subject had broken a window and crawled inside of the location to sleep. Call split to medics. Officers will follow up after subject is medically cleared.
- Officers responded to a report of a traffic hazard at the 1300 block of Stacy Avenue. RP stated that there is a vehicle parked in front of the location blocking traffic. No problems were found.
- Officers responded to a report of reckless traffic on I82. RP stated that a vehicle was driving on the wrong side of the freeway. Call split to WSP who stopped the vehicle at Gap and Merlot.
- Officer responded to a 911 hang up. Officers contacted caller who stated they have no issues and did not call 911.
- Officer responded to a request for a welfare check at the 200 block of Canyon Drive. RP stated that they had talked to a caller on the phone who had made some concerning statements. Officer contacted the caller who stated that he was upset when he made the statements and that all was well. No crime.
- Officer assist at PMH for a patient.
- Officer responded to a request for an assist at the 1200 block of Sheridan Avenue. RP requested a check to see if a person was at their home as they were unable to contact them. Officer was unable to contact the person in question.
- BCSO officer assist at N Wamba Rd/N Gap for a non-injury traffic accident. Driver had driven into a vineyard and gotten his truck stuck.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

November 18 (31 Calls for Service)

- BCSO/WSP officer assist for an occupied vehicle parked on the side of the freeway. Officer contacted the vehicle. The occupant advised he was trying to sleep and was advised to find somewhere besides the interstate for napping.
- Officers responded to a report of a suspicious fire at the 400 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated that a male had started a warming fire in the parking lot. Officer put the fire out. Male stated that he was 'freezing to death'. EMS arrived and transported the male.
- BCSO officer assist with a child abuse report on Taylor Rd. BCSO investigating.
- EMS officer assist on Shelby Rd. One adult male released to Sunnyside EMS.
- Officer responded to a report of an animal complaint at the 300 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated that there is a German shepherd loose in the area. RP stated they posted the dog on FB and was going to take him to the home listed on FB but could not get the dog in their vehicle. RP returned the dog prior to officer arrival.
- Officers responded to a report of a burglary (attempt) at the 300 block of Canyon Drive. RP stated that someone kicked in her front door and then ran away when they saw her. She did not recognize the individual and the officers were unable to locate the individual. Investigation ongoing.
- Officers responded to a request for an assist at the 300 block of Casi Court. RP stated that her friend left her at the location. Officer gave the RP a courtesy ride to the PD where a friend picked her up.
- Officer responded to a report of a noise violation at the 1300 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated there is loud music coming from a nearby home at the location. Officer checked the area but did not hear any loud music.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

November 19 (30 Calls for Service)

- Officer responded to a report of a noise violation at the 1300 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated that there was loud music playing in the area. Officer did not note any music at all at the location.
- Officers responded to the recovery of a stolen vehicle, located in the parking lot at the 100 block of Merlot Drive. Driver was actually the owner of the vehicle. He stated that he had recovered his vehicle shortly after reporting it stolen and had contacted authorities to let them know. Driver was released.
- EMS officer assist in accessing a home for medical reasons.
- Officers responded to a report of a missing person. RP stated she thought perhaps her friend was arrested. In fact, her friend was at to PMH.
- Officers (attempted) to respond to a report of loud music at the 900 block of Anna Street. RP complained about being woken up by loud music. However, RP did not leave any information to contact them.
- Officers responded to a request for a welfare check at the Prosser rest area. RP stated that there is a female who is screaming and hitting the stalls in the restroom. No damage observed in the restroom. Female left on foot. No crime.
- EMS officer assist at the 2100 block of Wine Country Road.
- Officer responded to a request for an assist at the 100 block of Columbia Drive. RP stated that she does not like her daughter's bf and does not want him at the location. This is an ongoing situation. She was advised (again) that her daughter is allowed guests and that she (the RP) can file paperwork to keep them from coming on the property if she desires.
- WSP officer assist with a traffic stop at Wine Country Road/Gap Road.

- Officers responded to an informational report on 1366 PR. RP stated that there is a vehicle in the field at the location. A check of the area was requested. No vehicle was discovered at the location.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

November 20 (37 Calls for Service)

- Officers performed warrant services following a traffic stop. Passenger and driver were detained and taken to BC jail.
- BCSO officer assist on King Tull Road with a report of a vehicle driving in a pasture after knocking down a fence. BCSO case.
- Officers contacted a car owner after finding a vehicle partially blocking the road at Dudley Avenue/Court Street. RO's grandson had been loaned the vehicle and it had stopped running. RO was going to have it towed.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint at the 1300 block of SR22. The RP stated that a residence in the area had multiple puppies that run out in front of her vehicle each time that she is there and she was concerned for their safety. Officer took animal licensing paperwork to the property manager to give to residents.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint at the 400 block of Wine Country Road. Staff at the location were concerned that an animal owner was not going to retrieve their pet (and pay for services) following treatment of animal. Investigation ongoing.
- Officer responded to a parking violation at W Old Inland Empire Hwy/Gap Road. A vehicle was parked on a bicycle lane. Officer contacted the responsible owner who was on his way to move it.
- Officers responded to a 911 call disconnect. Caller called back and stated there is no emergency.
- Officers responded to a report of burglary at the 1000 block of 6th Street. RP stated that there are children entering the building near the practice field. Officers contacted the juveniles who said it was unlocked, so they went in. Officers sent them on their way and checked the building. Nothing seemed out of place or damaged. School personnel came and secured the building.
- Officers responded to a report of suspicious circumstances at the 100 block of Bennett Avenue. RP stated that individuals were taking items from her father's house without permission. Individuals were taking pallets from the residence and told the RP that the roofers had told them they could have them. Responsible party of the home declined pressing charges as long as the pallets were returned.
- Officers responded to a request for assistance in the lobby of the police department. RP was requesting to know information about ownership on a vehicle license number. Officers declined his request as that information is restricted.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

November 21 (40 Calls for Service)

- Officer responded to an abandoned boat/trailer at W CR12/N Albro Rd. It had no plate and appeared to have been gutted a while ago.
- Officers completed a transfer of a lost dog (found previously in the week) to the Benton Franklin Humane Society.
