ACTIVITY LOG

Week of November 22 to November 30, 2023

November 22 (22 Calls for Service)

- BCSO officer assist with a traffic stop on I 82. Driver ran on foot but was eventually caught.
- Officers issued a trespass order at the 1800 block of Wine Country Road.
- Officers responded to a report of information at the 1300 block of Sommers Avenue. RP stated that they witnessed 2 juveniles fighting.
- Officers responded to a report of a hit-and-run (no injury) accident at the 1400 block of Paterson Rd. RP stated that a vehicle had hit her car and her husband's car (both parked) and then fled. Investigation ongoing.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

November 23 (20 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to a 911 hang up call at the 2100 block of Wine Country Road. Responsible phone owner insisted that they did not make the call. No issues found.
- Officer responded to a report of vehicle theft at the 300 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated that he had left the keys inside the vehicle. He declined filing a stolen vehicle report.
- Officer responded to a request for a welfare check at the rest area. RP stated that there was a female at the location running around her car while screaming and yelling. Officers checked on the female and she was fine.
- BCSO officer assist with a two vehicle accident on Webber Canyon. RP stated that two vehicles were on fire.
- Officers responded to a single vehicle accident at the 200 block of Gap Road. A vehicle slid into a curb and the landscaping at the location. Vehicle was towed away per owner request.
- Officers responded to a request for a vehicle confirmation per GVPD. The vehicle was confirmed stolen and GVPD advised that they have located a trailer stolen from Prosser.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

November 24 (37 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to vehicle stopped in the roadway on Wine Country Road, partially blocking Claret. The driver was advised to move it.
- Officers responded to a report of a theft at the 300 block of Wine Country Rd. RP stated that she has a video of a male taking a battery from the entrance at the location. RP wanted to press charges and to have the individual trespassed (and they were).
- Officer responded to a report of a vehicle theft at the 300 block of Wine Country Road. After checking available video, it was discovered that RP's purse was not stolen from the vehicle. RP located her purse at home.
- EMS officer assist for an overdose at the 100 block of Columbia Drive.
- Officer responded to a complaint of a noise violation at the 1400 block of Dudley Avenue. This is an ongoing issue with a neighbor's dog barking. Investigation ongoing.
- Officers responded to a male and female talking in the park (after hours). They were moved along.

- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

November 25 (36 Calls for Service)

- Officer responded to an animal complaint at the 1500 block of Sheridan Avenue. RP stated that their Pomeranian dog was missing and wondered if it had been found. Officer advised that it had not been turned in, but that the officers would keep an eye out for it.
- Officers responded to a report of a disturbance at the 800 block of Alexander Court. A male and female were having an argument. Both stated it was only verbal and not physical. No crime.
- Officers responded to a report of a theft at the 100 block of Bennett Avenue. RP stated that a trailer was stolen from his property. Investigation ongoing.
- YPD officer assist with locating a vehicle which had eluded the YPD officers. Vehicle was not located in Prosser.
- Officers responded to an animal complaint at the 300 block of 4th Street. RP stated that her brother's dog had escaped and went to the neighbor's home, chasing after the neighbor's cat. The dog was injured by the neighbor who stated that they were defending their cat. This is a civil case.
- PMH officer assist for a male who was extremely uncooperative. Call for officer assistance was cancelled.
- Officer responded to a call for an out of state theft. RP stated that his tools were stolen from Idaho and were being posted for sale on social media. Officer contacted the RP. This is a civil case.
- Officers responded to a request for a welfare check on I82. RP stated that a vehicle pulled up and dropped a female off and left her standing in the cold. Officers checked the area and were unable to locate the female.
- BCSO officer assist with a request to check on a trooper. Trooper was not at location when officer arrived.
- Officers responded to a couple who were hanging out at the Sports Complex. He advised them to move along, which they did.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

November 26 (19 Calls for Service)

- BCSO officer assist with a vehicle vs semi fatal collision on I-82.
- Officers responded to a recovery of a stolen vehicle from earlier in the week.
- Officers responded to a report of theft at the 1800 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated that her license plate had been stolen. Investigation ongoing.

Additionally, the occupants were littering. Officers contacted the male driver who stated that he has a spare on the way. No plates on the vehicle, but as it was on private property, no crime.

- Officer pink tagged a boat trailer parked on N Albro Road. Officer noted it had been parked there for quite some time.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint at Sales Yard Rd/Dump Rd. RP stated that there is a cow with a broken leg at the location. The RP has noted it for several days. Split to BCSO.
- Officer responded to a complaint of an abandoned vehicle at the 2100 block of Eastgate Ct. Officer checked the vehicle which was not abandoned but had a flat tire. The responsible owner was told he could not keep it parked on the street with a flat tire. RO agreed to take care of it.
- Officers responded to a report of theft at the 700 block of Memorial Street. RP stated that she had left her purse in the waiting room at the hospital and when she went back for it after 10 minutes, it was gone. The purse was later located at the hospital and returned to the RP.
- Officer responded to a report of information at the 1300 block of Sommers Avenue. RP reported her son was hit by another juvenile on a previous day. This is an ongoing bullying issue that the school is handling.
- Officer responded to a report of narcotics at the 1100 block of Meade Avenue. RP stated a male is using narcotics in the bathroom at the location and is loitering. RP requested he be trespassed. As the male is not currently at the location, officers advised that the RP call back when and if he returns so he could be trespassed.
- Officer responded to parking violations at New Gate Drive/Columbia Drive. Vehicles were parked illegally at the location. Officer spoke to the responsible owner of the vehicles who stated he would move the vehicles.
- Officers responded to a report of a vehicle theft at the 1500 block of Paterson Road. RP stated that their vehicle was stolen from the parking lot. The RP knew who had taken it and it was a family member who had taken it without permission. Investigation ongoing.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint at the 400 block of Petra Avenue. A dog was at large. Officer returned the dog to its home and gave the owner a verbal warning for the dog being at large and for the dog being unlicensed.
- Officers responded to a report of suspicious circumstances at the 300 block of 7th Street. RP stated there is a male sitting in a car with the windows fogged up, who then left, driving up the alley. This is the same vehicle from an earlier loitering complaint. The tire was repaired, a temporary tag had been obtained, and no crime took place.
- BCSO officer assist for a 2 vehicle traffic accident with unknown injury at N Old Inland Empire Hwy/Van Buren Road.
- Officers noted a disabled vehicle on I82. Vehicle blew a tire and had help on the way.
