ACTIVITY LOG

Week of December 01 to December 07, 2023

December 01 (25 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to a request for a welfare check at the 2200 block of SR 221. RP had received reports that a female was possibly being abused by a driver of a trucking company. RP stated it was a domestic abuse situation. The truck was not located by officers but they advised the RP to call again if they hear more information about where the truck is. Later, officers were able to talk to the driver and female, who stated that they were just having an argument. No issues.
- Officer responded to an informational call from the 1500 block of Bennett Avenue. RP wanted to report a male in all black cutting through yards in the area. Officer advised the RP to call when/if it happens again.
- Officer responded to a report of a traffic hazard at Eastgate Drive and Highland Drive. RP stated that a car was parked in such a way as to be a hazard. Officer checked the vehicle and it was parked legally per RCW 46.61.570.
- Officer responded to a report of a theft at the 200 block of Gap Road. RP stated that they had a wallet stolen on the previous evening. Investigation ongoing.
- Officers responded to a report of a runaway at the 600 block of 7th Street. RP stated that a juvenile female had left the location two hours prior and had not returned and could not be located. Update: female was found two hours following the report.
- Officers responded to a request for a welfare check at the 200 block of Canyon Drive. RP stated that there is a loud verbal situation going on in another apartment at the location. Officers checked the location and an occupant stated that all is well.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

December 02 (31 Calls for Service)

- Officer detained an individual on suspicion of DUI following a traffic stop for excessive speed. Male driver was booked into BC jail.
- BCSO officer assist for a request for a welfare check following a 911 hang up on W Taylor Road. No issues were found.
- BCSO officer assist for a single vehicle unknown injury traffic accident. A Honda Accord had collided with a telephone pole. The operator of the vehicle had fled the scene. Vehicle was towed.
- Officer responded to a 911 hang up at the 2000 block of Wine Country Road. Officer contacted the caller and all was well.
- Officer assist serving court papers at the 1100 block of Prosser Avenue.
- Officers responded to a request for a welfare check at the 700 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated that there is a female in the bathroom at the location who may be hiding due to threats by a trucker. Officers contacted the female who denied hiding and denied the threats to her. The male truck driver also denied the threats. She stated she and the trucker are traveling to Seattle. No issues.
- BCSO officer assist for a non-injury traffic accident on CR12.
- Officers responded to a report of domestic violence at the 200 block of Port Avenue C. RP stated that there is a male and female at the location who are having an altercation. Officers contacted the male and female who admitted they were having an altercation but that it was verbal only.

They admitted that the male was trying to get the female into their vehicle as the establishment was closing, but she did not want to leave. No crime.

- Officer responded to a report of an attempted burglary at the 600 block of Court Street. RP stated that someone had tried to pry into his garage over Thanksgiving weekend. The garage burglary was unsuccessful. Information only at this time.
- Officer responded to an additional report at the 600 block of Court Street. Someone had broken into the RPs shed and stolen items. Investigation ongoing.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

December 03 (22 Calls for Service)

- Officer responded to a report of a civil issue at the 100 block of Merlot Drive. RP stated that her son's father was refusing to drop their child off in Prosser as previously agreed. This is apparently an ongoing issue. This is a civil issue, but the father eventually dropped the child off as agreed.
- Officers responded to a parking violation at Market Street and Ellen Avenue. A semi-truck was parked illegally for approximately 1 week. A pink parking notice was placed on the driver's side window.
- BCSO officer assist with a blocking, non-injury traffic accident on CR 12. Both vehicles were towed and one driver was taken into custody.

- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

December 04 (37 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to a business alarm at the 100 block of Merlot Drive. All doors appeared to be secured. No issues.
- Officer facilitated the transfer of an impounded dog to the Pitbull Pen.
- Officers responded to a warrant arrest at the 1800 block of Benson Avenue. 1 male was taken to BC jail.
- Officers responded to a report of theft at the 1500 block of Paterson Road. RP stated that a student had some items stolen. Investigation ongoing.

Though the RP did not see them take anything, RP did see them on the neighbor's porch. Officer was unable to locate upon arrival.

- Officers responded to a report of a disturbance at the 1300 block of Sommers Avenue. RP advised that a group of 5 teens appeared to be getting ready to fight. RP saw that they had been punching each other. Officers contacted the juveniles who were just wrestling and playing around. No crime.
- Officers responded to a report of information at the 600 block of 6th Street. RP stated someone she knows is drinking and driving currently. Officers were unable to locate the driver.
- Officer responded to an animal at large at the 1600 block of Sherman Avenue. A large black/brown Rottweiler dog was unsecured on Sherman Avenue. Officer made contact at the address and informed them of the issue. They secured the dog and the officer advised the owner to license the dog.
